

## Glitterbug: Nokia's night of glamour

It was glitter galore at the Radisson Water Garden Hotel last Thursday night, as Nokia presented their 'Glitterbug' event -- an Eid fashion extravaganza that showcased exclusive Nokia devices as well as the work of three leading fashion designers. The event began with Prem Chand, general manager, Nokia Emerging Asia, taking the stage for an interactive Q&A session, explaining the reason for a fashion show to showcase the phones. "Style is an expression of individuality and mobile phones have become an essential style statement," he told the audience. "The design philosophy of Nokia is centred on the theme 'Beautiful to Use.' Design has to deliver objects and services that are not only beautiful to look at, but also work just the way people want them to."

He went on to add that the campaign offered premium gifts for purchase of the models that were part of the campaign. After a light-hearted round of surprise gifts for a few lucky audience members, the show began. It kicked off with models taking the catwalk with the Nokia phones that form the 'Beautiful to Use' campaign. Sporting

outfits in bold shades of red, white and black, and bearing the distinctive style of Aneela Haque, the models displayed the Nokia 880 Carbon Arte, Nokia 660 Slide, Nokia 660 Fold, Nokia 3600 and Nokia 7610. The fashion show part of the event kicked off with Kuhu's collection, which was inspired by people of different ethnicities and cultures. This was expressed not only by the clothes, but by the choice of music. With the late Michael Jackson's popular tracks "Don't stop till you get enough" and "Black or White" belting in the back-

ground, Kuhu managed to incorporate both the themes of diversity as well as consumerism. Her clothes had a palette of peach, black, white, pink, and yellow, emulating skin colours of different races, and details like Greco patterns on the sari borders, tribal-esque motifs, and peasant blouses were a nod to different cultures. Up next was the collection by Shahrukh Shahid, partnered up with Razim Ahmed, with makeup by Munnii, which featured two queues. The first was a collection of tunics and slacks in bright sorbet colours, or metallic

shades, with a bold medley of detailing such as asymmetrical cuts, ribbing, and peasant-inspired bodices and sleeves. The second featured saris, which tried to capture the Glitterbug theme of glitz as well as variety, in an unholy mix of '70s-inspired disco shine and the Flower Power of the '60s, all channelled into the contemporary Bollywood-chic look. With sequined blouses, and floral and paisley motifs worked on with zardosi and other embellishments, each new outfit had something unexpected. Finally, there was Aneela Haque who drew from her diverse experience of travel, ghazal, karate, and more to create a wealth of diversity within a colour scheme of turquoise, black and white, and her signature calligraphy and floral motifs, translated on local fabrics such as khadi, jamdani etc. Hemlines rose and fell, sleeves fluttered at asymmetrical angles, layers of detail peeped from under saris or crop tops, and faces, sporting make-up by Farzana Shakil, peered behind Venetian masks as the models, decked out in all their fantasy-themed and yet refreshingly coherent glory. This most successful event ended with dinner and a live performance by acid-jazz band Groovetrap.

## Les Paul, father of the electric guitar, passes away

Les Paul's Gibson Guitar, created in 1952, became one of the most widely used guitars in the music industry, with The Who's Pete Townshend, Led Zeppelin's Jimmy Page, Jimi Hendrix and former Guns N' Roses lead guitarist Slash, among those who played it. Originally a jazz guitarist, his experiments with multi-track recording were seen as key to the birth of rock and roll. The musician, who was still performing regularly in Manhattan not long before his death, died on August 13 of complications relating to pneumonia while at a New York hospital. His family and friends were by his side. Born Lester William Polsfuss, in Wisconsin in 1915, Paul invented the "The Log," a four-by-four solid piece of wood strung with steel strings, in 1941. After modifying the instrument's shape to make it look more traditional, the guitar began to gain fans, with Gibson Guitars producing the Les Paul guitar in 1952. Paul was also a successful artist from the 1930s to his twilight years, while he continued to create new recording methods. With his wife Mary Ford on vocals, Paul had a number of hits in the late 1940s and 1950s, gaining 11 number ones in the USA. He was inducted into the Grammy Hall of Fame, the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame, the National Inventors Hall of Fame, and the National Broadcasters Hall of Fame. In February 2006, while in hospital, he learned he had won two Grammys for "Les Paul & Friends: American Made, World Played," an album

released after his 90th birthday. Paying tribute to the guitarist, Slash said: "Les Paul was a shining example of how full one's life can be. He was so vibrant and full of positive energy. I'm honoured and humbled to have known and played with him over the years, he was an exceptionally brilliant man." Dave Berryman, President of Gibson Guitar, said: "I don't think any words can describe the



Les Paul (1915-2009) man we know as Les Paul adequately. The English language does not contain words that can pay enough homage to someone like Les. "As the 'Father of the Electric Guitar,' he was not only one of the world's greatest innovators but a legend who created, inspired and contributed to the success of musicians around the world." 
