India complains of militant training camps in Pakistan

Islamabad assures Delhi of cooperation on terror

AFP, New Delhi/ Islamabad

India's defence minister said yesterday there were dozens of Islamic militant training camps active near Pakistan's border with India that had not been dismantled by authorities there.

"As long as the terrorist camps are functioning in the border areas in Pakistan soil, certainly there is a threat to India, and it is a fact," AK Antony said in the southern state of Kerala, PTI news agency reported.

On Monday, Indian Prime Minister Manmohan Singh had said that militants in Pakistan were plotting new attacks on India and urged security forces to stay on high alert.

Singh underlined that cross-border terrorism remained a "most pervasive" threat.

In response, Pakistan assured India of its "fullest cooperation" in preventing fresh acts of terror and asked India to share specific infor-

mation about threats.

India's deputy high commissioner was called to Pakistan's foreign ministry and told Singh's remarks "warrant serious and prompt attention," the ministry said in a statement.

The deputy high commissioner was informed that "the 'government of Pakistan would like to extend its fullest cooperation to pre-empt any act of terror."

India has boosted its security to prevent assaults after November's attacks in the country's financial capital Mumbai, in which gunmen killed 166 people.

"In all sincerity, we would request India to share information that they have and for our part we stand ready to cooperate fully in preempting any act of terror," the Pakistan statement said.

It said that terrorism could only be combated by serious, sustained and pragmatic cooperation.

Russia's largest hydroelectric plant Tuesday for 64 missing workers after an accident during repairs killed at least 12 others at the massive plant in southern Siberia.

The cause of Monday's accident at the Sayano-Shushenskaya plant was unclear. Federal investigators said a transformer exploded during repair works, destroying walls and the ceiling in an engine room where turbines are located and causing the room to flood.

Two of the plant's 10 turbines were destroyed and a third was seriously damaged, said Vasily Zubakin, acting chief executive of the plant's owner, RusHydro. He said the company was still assessing There are 12 confirmed the state of the remaining seven turbines.

Shoigu said the repairs would be difficult.

"We're probably talking about years rather than months to restore three of the 10 turbines," he said on staterun television.

The world's largest aluminum producer, Rusal, was operating as usual, with its smelters being powered from other plants, company spokeswoman Yelena Shuliveistrova said.

Says state minister

Members of Ansar-VDP are being trained to eradicate militancy from the remote areas in the country, State Minister for Home Shamsul Haque Tuku yesterday said in a meeting with Ansar-VDP high-ups at its headquarters in Khilgaon.

Since Ansar-VDP (Village Defence Party) personnel mostly work in their native villages, they can identify strangers in their locality and if suspicious, they can gather information about the newcomers and inform the law enforcers, the state minister said.

It has been observed that militants and JMB men prefer remote villages for their lair and create network in these areas, Tuku said, adding that involvement of Ansar-VDP members in tackling militancy will be very effective.

He said if Ansar-VDP members became active, it would be impossible for foreign criminals to use our country as a hideout and local criminals to avoid arrests. They can also contribute to raising awareness against militancy as they live very close to people, he added.

He said his government believes in empowering women and for this they would recruit equal number of females against the male members in the force in each village. In response to different

demands raised by the Ansar-VDP high-ups in the meeting, the state minister said he would convey them to the prime minister.

Director General (DG) of Ansar-VDP Maj Gen Rafiqul Islam, Deputy DG Brig Gen ABM Taibul Islam and several other high-ups of the force attended the meeting.

Unauthorised shops and offices of different political parties have been using the car parking space for decades with DCC nod. DCC allowed 160 makeshift grocery shops to run their business there.

The joint forces recovered the car park from illegal occupants in the last week of January 2007 during the caretaker government evicting several hundred illegal structures.
