Prof Anu Muhammad, member secretary of the national committee, read out a written statement at the

programme. Other demands of the committee include demarcation of maritime boundary, generating power from Barapukuria coal mine rather than exporting coal, realising Tk 20,000 crore as ransom from Chevron and Niko, formulation and implementation of a fuel policy to ensure power to the countrymen.

The national committee will also observe a five-day programme from August 26 in observance of the Phulbari Day.






