Reaching Out-of-School Children Project (ROSC, 2004-2010) is a project aimed at reducing the number of out-of-school children through improved access, quality and efficiency in primary education, especially for the disadvantaged children, in support of Government of Bangladesh's EFA goals. PEDP-II focuses largely on Government Primary Schools (GPS) and Registered Non-Government Primary Schools (RNGPS). The ROSC project provides non-formal primary education to out-of-school children in the 7-14 age-group, who would remain deprived of formal education primarily because of poverty or remoteness.

ROSC uses a community-driven approach to focus on establishment of learning centers through a functional Center Management Committee directly accountable to parents and students, as well as the Ministry of Primary and Mass Education, with support from upazila education officers and non-government organizations as implementation partners. To date, some 15,000 learning centers – called Ananda Schools – have been established under the ROSC Project, catering to half a million children of 7-14 years old who have never been to school or been out of school for more than a year. Operational program delivery differs from the norms in primary schools in order to cater to specific needs of students (e.g. flexible school timing, multigrade teaching, entry at an older age-7-14 years old). The Project features on the one hand a combination of grants to schools and educational allowance to students, and on the other, only grants to school: (a) Education Allowance and Grants in 37 upazilas, and (b) Grants only in the remaining 23 upazilas.

Each Ananda school is managed by a Center Management Committee (CMC) composed of 5 parents or guardians, 1 female ward member of Union Parishad, 1 Upazila Education Office (UEO) representative, 1 Education Service Provider (described below), 1 Head Teacher of a formal primary school in the locality and 1 person interested in promoting education in the community with the Ananda school teacher as the member secretary to the CMC.

CMC, which is responsible for initial establishment and management of the LC, including initial student enrolments, teacher management, provision of education materials and management of grants and allowances. Education Service Provider (ESP), a local NGO selected by the CMC, provides support in the setting up and operating the LC. Education Service Provider (ERP), NGO or educational institution with multi-district/national presence and experience in primary education, provides technical support to LC to improve the quality of teaching and learning in those LCs. Sonali Bank is another implementation partner tasked with disbursement of grants and allowances to LCs and students. ROSCU at Directorate of Primary Education (DPE) is responsible for overall implementation of the project, and alongwith support from Upazila Education Offices (UEO) and ROSC monitoring cell, monitors management activities of Ananda School, and other agencies involved in the entire ROSC operation.

The main objectives of the ROSC project are to improve access, quality and efficiency in primary education. In order to assess the expected impact of ROSC interventions on key outcome indicators, it is critical to carry out a comprehensive and independent evaluation. The objective of this quantitative evaluation is to determine the learning achievement of students completing Grade 5, and estimate the transition rate of students to secondary education. The evaluation would be based on a survey of representative sample of ROSC learning centers (LCs) from both the Grant only and Grant and Allowance Upazilas and the survey would include (i) competency testing of Grade-5 students in those LCs, and (ii) tracer study of students who completed Grade-5 from those LCs in the past.

Given that this study involves administration of student tests and fielding of complex tracer survey on a large scale in a rural setting, it is imperative that the consultant must have a well established track record in undertaking such tasks in Bangladesh. It is essential that the consultant have experience collecting data on children, households, communities, schools, and teachers. Equally important criterion for the consultant it needs to have experience in designing and administering child learning tests.
