

RMG workers clash with cops over arrears

20 policemen, 100 workers injured

At least 20 policemen, including an assistant superintendent of police (ASP), and over 100 garment workers were injured in a series of clashes during the workers' demonstration over due salaries at Fatullah yesterday.

The injured workers include Hasina Begum, Halima Begum, Sayeda, Assia, Deham, Bazlu, Sohag, Mostafa, Tahmina among others.

ASP Mir Touhid, ASI Amjad, Hedayet, Abul Kalam Azad and Shah Alam of Fatullah Model Police Station are a few among the injured policemen.

More than a thousand workers of Auto Textile Garments staged demonstration in front of the factory from morning demanding their two months' due wages. Clashes ensued when police tried to calm them down.

The whole area turned into a battlefield with chases and counter chases between the workers and police. The workers threw bricks at the police and they retaliated with 10 canister of tear gas to bring the situation under control.

The agitating workers also flashed red cloth and stopped a Narayanganj bound train for half an hour at Bottola area of Fatullah.

The workers said yesterday was fixed for the salary payment but Haji Abu Saeed, owner of Auto Textile Garments, closed the factory without paying them two months' dues. They alleged that the owner took loan from bank but instead of paying their salaries he flew abroad.

Frustrated and enraged workers tried to bring out workers from about 10 other factories in nearby Bottola, Lalpur, Lamapara and Shibu Market when the police tried to tranquil them. Police resorted to truncheons to control the angry workers. The workers in retaliation surrounded them and rained

brickbats on the law enforcers. Police later took shelter into different shops and panic spread in the area.

As the news of workers' agitation spread, about 4,500 workers of Micro Fibre, Midland and Liberty Garments at Katherpool area stopped working and detained the owners and officials in their offices for five hours.

Additional police and Rab members were deployed at the site and the situation came under control around 2:30pm.

Narayanganj Police super Biswas Afzal Hossain said it was inhuman on the owner's part to leave his poor employees without paying their salaries.

BNP plans demo against price hike

The main opposition BNP yesterday declared a two-day programme to protest the price hike of essentials and law and order slide across the country.

Party Secretary General Khandaker Delwar Hossain, at a press briefing held at party's Nayapalton office, announced the programmes urging all to make it successful.

BNP will stage demonstration and hold rally at all divisional headquarters including the capital on September 6 and at the district headquarters across the country the next day.

"The government promised to control the essentials' prices during the Ramadan but failed," Delwar said.

He lambasted the Awami League-led grand alliance government saying its failure to control both the market and law and order made the peo-

ple's life miserable.

"The government's own men are now engaged in killing people, grabbing residential halls and manipulating tenders openly," the BNP leader alleged.

Party's joint secretaries general Mirza Abbas and Goyeshwer Chandra Roy, office secretary Rizvi Ahmed and former Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) president Habib-Un-Nabi Khan Sohel, among others, accompanied Delwar during the briefing.

Besides, BNP will also hold a rally and a discussion on September 3 to observe 'Tarique release day'. The party and its associate bodies including JCD and Jubo Dal will also arrange different programmes on September 10 in the capital and hold a discussion meeting the next day to mark Khaleda Zia's release anniversary.

Brokers rule

To understand the meaning of that smile and other almost untraceable non-verbal communication between the broker and the BRTA official, The Daily Star correspondent after watching the whole thing approached another broker in the guise of a person needing a fitness certificate for his vehicle.

"The meaning of the smile is struck between them," said the broker. The broker nicknamed Shamim also said the official usually takes around Tk 1,250 to issue fitness certificates for such taxis.

He said sometimes the amount varies depending on how close a broker is to the official.

To reinforce the camouflage and glean more information out of the broker, the correspondent asked whether he could help manage a fitness certificate for a car without bringing the vehicle to the BRTA from a remote district. Shamim said he would be able to do it for Tk 2,000.

"Now the 'price' is a bit high as the officials take photos of the vehicles during examination," said Shamim, one of the leading and influential brokers at BRTA Mirpur office.

As crackdown on unfit vehicles in the capital began to ease congestion, owners and drivers of such vehicles thronged the BRTA offices during the last couple of days to get their papers in order.

The rush of vehicles has made the scope for bribery even wider. A large section of unscrupulous BRTA officials and staff maintaining an unholy nexus with the brokers have been in this illegal practice for a long time, said a number of vehicle owners standing in long queues.

During the visit to the BRTA office yesterday, The Daily Star

correspondent found different types of vehicles, including buses, taxis, microbuses, cars and CNG-run auto rickshaws standing in long queue on the road.

"My fitness certificate expired around a month ago but I did not come to renew it out of laziness. But now I had to come as you know a crackdown is going on against unfit vehicles," said the owner of a car wishing anonymity.

BRTA Assistant Director Mohsin Hossain said usually around 250 to 300 vehicles enter the compound for different purposes. Now the number has almost double.

"Don't call them brokers, call them party leaders. Do you know how powerful they are? Go and do something about them if you have the courage," said a top BRTA official at the Mirpur office.

A BRTA office staff said, "Now all the brokers are local unit leaders of the ruling Awami League and its wings."

"Not only us, sometimes even our inspectors do not get any money (bribe share). They (brokers) take all the money from clients saying that they have to give it to the officials but they keep it all sometimes," said the BRTA staff requesting anonymity.

The Daily Star correspondent yesterday saw that a number of brokers were entering the offices of inspectors and asking them to sign documents. The inspectors sign the documents without protest.

"Three quarters of us here are from Gopalganj. We are unemployed and just earning some money to live as we have no jobs," said broker Mahfuzur Rahman, who hails from Kashiani upazila. He used to work at a government pharmaceutical company but lost his job during the BNP-led government's tenure.

Inform cops if anyone demands toll

Tuku asks RMG owners

State Minister for Home Shamsul Haque Tuku yesterday urged the garment factory owners to notify the law enforcement agencies when extortion takes place.

"You (factory owners) should come forward with courage so that we can take actions against extortion or any other occurrences in the sector," he said at a function organised by Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers and Exporters Association (BGMEA).

The BGMEA handed over two pick-up vans to Gazipur police at the function. It has so far handed over 22 pick-up vans to adjacent police stations of the country's different garment hubs. Gazipur is one of the biggest industrial areas, occupied with 814 garment units and more than 8 lakh workers.

The state minister also assured the factory owners of saving the sector from any kind of unrest during the Eid time. He said, "We will not tolerate anymore violence in the sector."

Shamsul Haque said this as the BGMEA leaders pointed out silent extortion in the sector even the government claims improvement of law and order in the country.

Swine virus 100 times lethal than seasonal flu

Says scientist

People who die after getting swine flu are 100 times more likely, compared to seasonal flu, to have been killed by the virus itself rather than secondary causes, a top French researcher said Monday.

The findings -- published on a research-sharing platform, PLoS Currents: Influenza, vetted by flu experts -- could help health officials manage critical care resources if infection rates climb in the autumn and winter.

It could also provide important clues as to the new swine flu's potential virulence, said author Antoine Flahault, a leading epidemiologist and director of France's School for Advanced Studies in Public Health.

"The direct lethality due to viral pneumonia probably gives the best estimate of an influenza strain's virulence, since it may vary from strain to strain and is not due to a country's level of health development," he said.

With regular seasonal flu, which claims up to 500,000 lives each year worldwide, most deaths are attributed either to secondary bacterial infections such as pneumonia, or pre-existing chronic condi-

Musharraf to return soon

Prepares to talk to politicians

Former Pakistan president Gen Pervez Musharraf has said he would return to Pakistan soon and initiate talks with country's political leaders.

"I will soon return to Pakistan and begin consultations with political leaders of the country," The Daily Times quoted Musharraf, as saying.

According to a private television channel, Musharraf, who is currently in London, said he was keeping a close eye on the country's political and social scenario.

He urged both factions of the Pakistan Muslim League-Quaid (PML-Q) to unite and bury their differences.

Musharraf said he was not perturbed by the volley of cases being registered against him in Pakistan and would soon return to the country to face the challenge.

He said there is a conspiracy being hatched to defame Pakistan's Armed forces and stressed that is should end immediately.

Meanwhile, Pakistan Prime Minister Yousuf Raza Gilani has said that the National Reconciliation Ordinance (NRO) and the trial of former president General Pervez Musharraf under the Article Six of the Constitution are two separate issues and should not be interlinked.

"These are two separate issues," Gilani said when asked whether the NRO was preventing the government from initiating a high treason case against Musharraf.

MOBILE COURT Restaurants, food shops in city fined

As many as 15 food stores, restaurants and fruit shops in the capital were fined a total of Tk 5.49 lakh by five mobile courts for violation of food and hygiene standards yesterday.

The teams to monitor the food and hygiene standards included Dhaka district's executive magistrates, officials from the Bangladesh Standards and Testing Institution (BSTI), Dhaka Metropolitan Police, Rapid Action Battalion and Consumers Association of Bangladesh.

Rajdhani Hotel in Gulistan was fined the highest, Tk 1.5 lakh, for keeping food uncovered in an unhygienic environment, said a BSTI press release.

Al Razzak Hotel and Restaurant in North South Road, Khabar Dabar Hotel and Hotel Raj in Gulistan were fined Tk 1 lakh each for the same. Khazana Restaurant in Uttara was fined Tk 10,000.

The mobile courts fined Super Bonoful restaurant at Aziz Super Market in Shabbagh Tk 5,000 for keeping expired food items.

They also fined Family Needs Ltd in Uttara Tk 20,000 for selling after-shave lotions without BSTI seals, Sohel Foler Dokan and Alamgir Foler Dokan in Uttara Tk 3,000 each for using scales without standard seals.

Sumoner Macher Dokan and Khokonor Macher Dokan in Uttara were fined Tk 2,000 and Tk 3,000 respectively for

cheating customers in weights.

Rash Limited and Palki in Bailey Road were fined Tk 20,000 and Tk 5,000 respectively for using scales without BSTI seals, selling expired curd and keeping food in unhygienic conditions.

The mobile courts also fined New Bhaggyakul Sweetmeat Store and Ananda Bakery in Shabbagh Tk 8,000 each for selling fruit juice without license.

Floods ravage Majuli islands in Assam

Around 60 villages have been devastated by floods in Majuli islands of Assam in India.

The world's largest river island is facing the nature's fury for the second time this year as the Brahmaputra River breached an embankment in Matmora region.

The floods were caused by incessant heavy rains for five days when it breached an embankment in Matmora, which channels the entire water of the Brahmaputra into the Luit River.

Heavy rainfall, upstream caused the second wave of flooding on the whole Upper Majuli area and displaced around 30 thousand people, and destroyed thousands of hectares of crop.
