Don't induct criminals into dist committee

Demands Bogra BNP

Leaders of the convening committee of Bogra BNP yesterday urged the party high-ups not to induct controversial people and identified criminals into the district committee of the party.

One killed in clash over land dispute

A man was killed and 30 others were injured in a clash between two groups of villagers over a land dispute at Bhadrachar Bazaar in Sirajganj yesterday morning.

The dead was identified as Ruhul Amin, 38. The injured were admitted to Sirajganj Sadar Hospital and local clinics.

Quoting local people, the police said Jamal Khan and Julmat Khan have a long-standing dispute over a land at the Bazaar.

The clash erupted around 10:00am when Jamal and his men tried to resist Julmat and his men who

came to the land to build a house there.

Both the groups equipped with lethal weapons attacked each other and vandalised two houses and two shops in the Bazaar.

Some 31 people were also injured during the melee. Of them, Ruhul Amin succumbed to his injuries at a hospital in the town.

On receiving information, the police and Rab forces rushed to the spot and resorted to baton-charge to bring the situation under control.

A tense situation has been prevailing in the area. Additional policemen have been deployed to avert further untoward incidents.

Ban lauds Dhaka's role in peacekeeping

UN Secretary General Ban Ki-moon has lauded the way Bangladesh is marching forward after establishing democracy through the general election in last December.

He also commended the role of Bangladeshis in UN peacekeeping missions.

He said this on Thursday when the new Permanent Representative of Bangladesh to the United Nations Dr Abul Kalam Abdul Momen went to present his credentials to the UN secretary general.

The UN secretary general said Bangladesh's growth has been significant despite vari-

ous natural disasters. He termed Bangladesh's experience in disaster management unprecedented.

Dr Momen conveyed the UN secretary general greetings from the president, the prime minister and the foreign minister of Bangladesh and expressed his gratitude to UN for its support to prepare voters' list and sending election observers' team to Bangladesh during the election.

Prior to his appointment, Momen served as chairman of the Department of Economics and Business Administration, Framingham State College, Massachusetts, according to a UN press release.
