

## RU student leaves campus in face of Shibir threat

An activist of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), Rajshahi University unit, who was given death threat by Shibir cadres on Thursday night and on Friday, left the campus yesterday on receiving a fresh threat.

Shibir (ICS) cadres threatened BCL activist Golam Mostafa with death on Thursday night as they branded him as one of the killers of their leader Shariful Islam Nomani on the campus on March 13 this year.

Following the threat,

Mostafa lodged a general diary (GD) with Motihar Police Station against five Shibir cadres of the hall.

He was again threatened with death on Friday for filing a GD against five Shibir men and asked to leave the campus.

Campus sources said a group of Shibir cadres gathered in front of the hall at around 11:00pm on Saturday. They later entered the hall, came to Mostafa's room and asked him to quit the campus immediately or face dire consequences.

Mostafa told this corre-

spondent that he has been compelled to leave the campus as the university authorities failed to ensure his security on the campus.

He alleged the university authorities and police are yet to take any step to arrest the Shibir cadres who gave him death threat twice.

When contacted, RU Proctor Prof Chowdhury Zakaria said he was not aware of Mostafa's departure from the campus.

"I urged the law enforcers to immediately investigate the matter and arrest the persons responsible," the proctor said.

## Mother accuses cops of killing son in Khulna

Three sub-inspectors of Sathkira Sadar Police Station have been accused of killing a trader named Lutfur Rahman of Shahpur village under Tala upazila of the district.

Aleya Khatun, mother of the slain trader, made this accusation at a press conference at Khulna Press Club yesterday.

She alleged that her 32-year-old son Lutfur Rahman was gunned down by the policemen at Choghariya under Sathkira Sadar upazila at 9:00pm on August 18.

The murder was committed at the instigation of drug peddlers Abdus Samad, Abdul Gafur Golder and Abdul Hakim of Tala upazila, Aleya Khatun alleged.

She said the three police sub-inspectors later wove a story of crossfire incident as reason for the death of her son.

Aleya Khatun in her statement read out at the press conference said her son was implicated in seven 'false' cases filed by police in connivance with drug peddlers, as he always stood firm against drug trade.

Six of the seven cases were proved false after thorough investigation by police while another case filed under Explosive Substances Act against him is under trial at Sathkira Special Tribunal. My son was not wanted in connection with any case of Sathkira Sadar Police Station, she said.

The three policemen were bribed by the drug peddlers for killing my son in the name of crossfire incident, she alleged.

Aleya Khatun has sought prime minister's intervention into the incident. She urged the home minister, the IGP and all human rights organisations to probe the killing of her son allegedly by three policemen.

## Addict kills daughter

A drug addict man killed his nine-year-old daughter at Barupara village in Tebunia under Pabna Sadar upazila on Saturday night.

Matur Pramanik, a poor labourer, often tortured his wife and family members for money to take drugs, police and locals said.

As his wife Shafali Khatun declined to give him money for drug, Matur started beating her mercilessly on Saturday night.

When Shila Khatun rushed to save her mother, Matur got crazy and hacked his daughter. Both the mother and daughter were taken to Pabna General Hospital where Shila died.

Police arrested Matur yesterday morning.

## Last days of an unsung freedom fighter

Left without proper medical treatment for two days after serious burn injuries, an insolvent freedom fighter of Sreepur upazila in Magura district died shortly after his admission into Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) on Friday night.

He was denied any state honour during his burial on Saturday as his name was not included on the latest list of freedom fighters prepared during the rule of four-party alliance government in 2003.

The ill-fated freedom fighter, Quazi Abu Bakar of Khamarpara village in Sreeol union under Sreepur upazila received serious burn injuries while trying to save his cattle from a fire at his cowshed on Wednesday night.

Neighbours rushed him to Magura Sadar Hospital but he could not get proper treatment due to financial problem.

His sons, who do petty jobs in Dhaka, rushed to Magura on Thursday and shifted him to DMCH. But his condition had seriously

deteriorated by the time and he succumbed to his injuries on Friday night.

"Bakar was my co-fighter during the Liberation War and I know that his name was included in the 'national list' prepared in 1983. He had also a certificate as a freedom fighter," said former deputy commander of Magura district unit Muktiyoddha Sangsad Mian Abdul Halim Miraj.

"I informed Sreepur upazila social welfare officer about the tragic death of valiant freedom fighter Quazi Abu Bakar, but he did not take any initiative to give him state honour saying that Bakar's name was not in the latest list of freedom fighters," said Amirul Islam Babu, former commander of Sreepur upazila unit Muktiyoddha Sangsad.

When contacted over telephone, Sreepur Upazila Nirbahi Officer Mina Masuduzzaman, also the acting commander of upazila unit Muktiyoddha Sangsad, said, "Bakar was not given state honour as we were not aware of his death. Nobody gave me any written or verbal information about the tragic end of his life."

### One killed in land dispute

One person was killed and 35 others were injured in a fierce clash over a disputed land at Boaliarchar in Raiganj upazila yesterday. Deceased Tarikul Islam, 35, was son of Sakawat Hossain of the village. Police and locals said that there was a long-standing dispute over a piece of land between Abdul Mazid and Abdul Hamid. The clash erupted yesterday morning when Mazid's men swooped on Hamid's men who went to the land to install a shallow machine. Within minutes, the clash spread and the clashing groups equipped with lethal weapons attacked each other, leaving Tarikul dead on the spot and 35 others of both sides injured. During the clash, they also vandalised and ransacked five houses in the village.

### Power office attacked

Angry mob attacked the local power office and residences of its employees in Ramu upazila yesterday Saturday night protesting power outage. Local people, especially those who went to offer Tarabi prayers suffered due to load shedding from iftar till Tarabi prayers. After the prayers, devotees from four local mosques came out and attacked the power office and nearby houses of its employees and ransacked them. The employees, however, fled office and houses during the attack. A case was lodged in connection with the attack.

### Rickshawpuller killed

Criminals yesterday killed a rickshawpuller at Kalinathpur village in Mirpur upazila. Police identified him as Abdur Rahim, 50, son of late Banat Ali of Chhatian village in the upazila. His body was recovered from Kalinathpur field. According to family members of the victim and police, Rahim went out of home on Saturday noon and since then he was missing. Yesterday locals found his body in the field and informed police. A case was filed with Mirpur police station.

### Man kills younger brother

One person killed his younger brother and injured another in a dispute over a piece of land at Hasbaria village under Lalpur upazila on Saturday evening. The dead was identified as Abdul Khaleque, 18, son of Abul Fazal of Hasbaria village. Police and villagers said, three brothers Year Ali, Zia and Khaleque locked in a quarrel over a parental land. At one stage elder brother Year Ali hacked to death his younger brother Khaleque. Another brother Zia who tried to resist him was severely stabbed by sharp weapon. A case was filed with Lalpur police station in this connection.

### Jubo League man attacked

Rivals attacked and severely injured Nawapara municipality unit president of Jubo League on Saturday. Sources said Shahin Khan came under attack in Rajhat area under Nawapara industrial town while returning home at night. Two groups of Jubo League were at loggerhead for the last few days. The victim was rushed to the upazila health complex and later sent to Dhaka for treatment as his condition deteriorated. Immediately after the incident, a group of Jubo League activists ransacked a number of business houses in Rajhat area and blocked Jessore-Khulna Highway for about half an hour.

### One arrested with fake notes

Natore police yesterday morning arrested one person with 143 pieces of fake 500 taka notes from Chalkbaddynath area in the town. Arrestee Jahangir Alam, 40, is son of Mobarak Ali of Hugulbaria. A police team raided the Dhaka bound passenger train--Nilsagar Express. When Jahangir tried to flee by jumping out of the train, police arrested him with the help of local people and recovered the fake notes from his possession. A case was filed with Natore police station.

SYLHET ATTACK ON AL Charge framing date deferred to October 6

District and Sessions Judge Md Momin Ullah yesterday deferred the date for charge framing in the murder case filed in connection with the grenade attack on AL men at Gulshan Centre in the city on August 7, 2004.

The judge fixed the date on October 6 as the accused were in the capital and police could not produce them in court yesterday. The date was deferred earlier on July 21 and August 3 for the same reason.

Sylhet city AL publicity secretary Mohammad Ibrahim Ali was killed while 50 others sustained injuries in the grenade attack after a meeting of the city AL. Police and others said, it was aimed at killing Sylhet City Corporation mayor Badar Uddin Kamran, also the city AL chief. Kamran escaped the attack as he had left the scene minutes before the blast.

Hasan Ferdous, the death toll in the incident rose to four. Ferdous, secretary of Barar Union Parishad (UP) went to attend the Iftar programme at the youth club at Urakanda bazar in Sadar upazila on the day where the attack was made. Son of women affairs secretary of Rajbari district unit Awami League (AL) Fatema Kaniz Hira, Zahir received severe bullet injuries during the attack.

He was admitted to Faridpur Medical College and Hospital (FMCH) and on Saturday shifted to DMCH as his condition deteriorated.

The attack left three people including two local AL leaders and a night guard of Barar UP dead on the spot. They are general secretary of Barar union unit AL Abdus Salam Mollah, 42, vice president Chhatra Dal (JCD) from the town's Sher-e-Bangla Road in connection with Jubo League leader Bithar murder.

Arrestee Abul Bashar is general secretary of Khulna Sadar unit of the party. Assistant Police Commissioner Abu Sayem of DB said that the JCD leader had been shown arrested as a suspect in the murder of Jubo League central leader and ward councillor Shahid Iqbal Bithar. He was being interrogated at the DB office at KMP headquarters till filing of this report yesterday afternoon.

Besides, DB police arrested an extremist from Dharmatala Road under Jessore Sadar police station yesterday morning.

## BITHAR MURDER JCD leader arrested on suspicion

He was being interrogated at the DB office at KMP headquarters till filing of this report yesterday afternoon.

Besides, DB police arrested an extremist from Dharmatala Road under Jessore Sadar police station yesterday morning.

## BNP office, shops ransacked

Activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jubo League yesterday ransacked BNP office and some shops belonging to BNP men at Lalmoheon uazila headquarters under Bhola district.

The incident occurred at noon when the activists of the ruling Awami League's associate organisations took out a procession in the upazila town protesting damage to the party posters with photos of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina allegedly by BNP men.

Local sources said the BCL and Jubo League activists ransacked furniture at local BNP office and desecrated the portraits of Ziaur Rahman and Khaleda Zia. They also locked six shops owned by BNP men at the upazila headquarters

for 'tearing' AL posters.

Later Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO) and Upazila Chairman Principal Nazrul Islam opened the locked shops.

At a press conference in the afternoon, local BNP claimed that AL cadres ransacked BNP office, desecrated the portraits of Ziaur Rahman and Khaleda Zia, and locked the shops of their activists.

Local AL Lawmaker Major (retd) Jasimuddin said he was not present in the town during the incident. Upazila AL leaders pacified the tensed situation created for dishonouring father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, he added.

"We asked the law enforcers to take action if any office or shop or transport was damaged by anyone," the MP said.
