



AUG 21 ATTACK, HASINA'S JEEP

Gunshots muted by probe

The Criminal Investigation Department's charge sheet in the August 21 grenade attack case does not explain convincingly the dents on the bullet-proof jeep that drove Sheikh Hasina out of the blast site.

The investigators seem to have muddled up the vital issue in the charges pressed in June last year.

The immediate past investigation officer of the case, CID's senior ASP Fazul Kabir, cited contradictory findings about the much-reported bullet scars on Hasina's four-wheel drive.

Five years after the carnage that left 23 AL leaders dead and scores maimed, now there's room for unravelling the mystery with a new IIO assigned to the case.

Akand, who has been tasked with further investigation, told The Daily Star that besides tracking down the source of the grenades used in the attack, they will seek to undo the contradictions and anomalies of the previous probe and also solve

the gunshot riddle.

"If I find anything new in my investigation, I will include it in the charge sheet," he added.

A few days after the attempt on Sheikh Hasina's life on August 21, 2004, INTERPOL experts came to help the local investigators with the probe.

Fred J Bradford of INTERPOL, the international police organisation, sent a report to the Bangladesh authorities that year.

The report states that the vehicle whisking away Hasina indeed came under fire.

"There was some shooting around the vehicle, more than 10 rounds perhaps. The window on her [Hasina] side was shot at twice and the back window five times. The vehicle was also struck by grenade

Rental terms revised

Ministry relaxes power project implementation period, but sticks to hard penalty provision

The energy ministry yesterday finalised some terms and conditions for upcoming tender on eight rental power projects with a total capacity of 530 megawatt, relaxing the deadline for implementing the projects.

The ministry however has kept the option for strong penalty against contractors for failing to launch power plants in line with the contract.

A ministry meeting, chaired by State Minister for Power and Energy Enamul Haque, set the timeframe for implementing four diesel-fired rental power plant projects within 120 days of signing of the agreement and the other four heavy fuel oil (HFO)-based plant projects within 270 days against the previous practice of 90 days and 180 days.

Prime minister's energy Adviser Dr Towfiq-e-Elahi Chowdhury was also present.



Sale of drug at reduced price

Govt to regulate market to ensure it

The anti-viral drug 'Oseltamivir' used for treatment of swine flu will be sold now at a reduced price under the government 'regulated market' across the country to stop misuse of the drug and control its price.

The government has also reduced the price of the drug as each capsule will be sold at Tk 150 instead of Tk 180, said DG of the Directorate General of Health Services Prof Shah Monir

SWINE FLU OUTBREAK

District hospitals lack preparedness

Most of the district hospitals in the country are not yet ready to treat swine flu patients although the number of infected people with the virus has been swelling every day.

Some hospitals, however, have set up separate flu units but are yet to open any separate corner at the outdoor department from where patients with flu-like symptoms can get ticket and suggestions, patients alleged.

Even testing facility is limited in the capital and that is why the samples taken with swab are sent to the Institute of the Epidemiology, Disease Control and Research (IEDCR) in Dhaka from different hospitals across the country for confirmation of swine flu.

Reports from different districts also blamed lack of coordination between the government and hospitals in making preparations for combating the virus.


A suspected swine flu patient was admitted to Rajshahi Infectious Disease Hospital on Friday afternoon and the swab collected from the patient has been sent for testing.

A swine flu ward is set up at Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College Hospital (SBMCH) but it is not isolated and also part of the emergency ward of the hospital. The space of the hospital, used earlier as motorcycle and bicycle parking place of on-duty staff, was turned to four-bed isolation ward for the swine flu patients.

The ward has been found unhygienic and glasses and windows of it are broken. Patients coming to the emergency section
