College girl abducted

Police could not rescue the girl as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.

Robber held after gunfight

Police arrested a robber after he sustained bullet-injury yesterday in a gunfight at Baradi village in Sadar upazila and recovered arms and ammunition. According to police, a team led by assistant superintendent of police (ASP) Alamgir Hossain cordoned a den at about 3.30: am and asked the robbers to surrender. But the robbers ignored the police call and opened fire. Police retaliated injuring Rezaul Islam, 30. After the gunfight, six bullets were recovered from the spot. Rezaul is an accused in several criminal cases filed with Sadar police station.

Woman militant arrested

Medicines seized at Teknaf

BDR yesterday early morning seized at Teknaf a huge quantity of different types of medicine while being smuggled to Myanmar. Sources said, BDR team raided Ali Khali Khal area in Leda village under Hnila union of Teknaf upazila and seized 3,997 ampules injection, 2,14,900 Ventolin and 8,61,3000 Stemetil tablets and different contraceptives. The drugs were later deposited to customs department. However, none could be arrested. Deputy commander of 42 Rifles Battalion at Teknaf Major Shahinur Rahman said the value of the seized drugs has been estimated around Tk 2 crore. BDR also filed a case with Teknaf than a in this connection.

Police to probe police brutality!

Justice in question as victim groans in pain at hospital

A one-member probe committee comprising Magura Assistant Superintendent of Police (ASP) Mihir Kumar Das has been formed to investigate Friday's brutal police act on retired army man Tayebur Rahman.

With serious injuries caused by merciless beating and uprooting of nails of two toes by the policemen led by Babukhali police camp in-charge assistant subinspector (ASI) Lutfur Rahman, the victim is groaning in pain at Magura Sadar Hospital.

Authorities yesterday suspended ASI Lutfur on charge of torturing Tayebur, a resident of Babukhali village in Mohammadpur upazila under Magura

Earlier on Friday, ASP Mihir Kumer Das said that primary investigation found the ASI guilty of the brutal torture on the retired army man.

Terming the incident 'unfortunate', Magura Superintendent of Police (SP) Mohammad Shahrier said ASI Lutfur had already been suspended and the onemember committee comprising an ASP is investigating the incident.

At around 8:00am on Friday, ASI Lutfur Rahman went to a house adjacent to the camp uncalled-for and interfered in a quarrel between house owner Tayebur Rahman, a retired army person, and his wife, locals said.

As Tayebur protested Lutfur's unwanted interference, the ASI got furi-

Crimes in six Khagrachhari

Upazilas rise

People of eight upazilas of Khagrachhari district feel insecure as incidents of killing, abduction and extortion are on the rise.

According to police sources, four people were killed and 40 others were injured in 12 clashes in the last 30 days (from August 10 to September10) while four abduction and six extortion cases were recorded with different police station of the upazilas during the period.

Those killed in clashes were Pervez Al Mamun of Matiranga upazlla, Saleha Begum of Dighinala upazila, Nasima Begum of Panchhari upazila, and Panay Mala Tripura of Mohalchhari upazila.

Pervez was killed on August 10, Saleha Begum on August 17, Nasima on August 18 and Panay Mala on September 3.

BOGRA SECOND BYPASS ROAD

for 9 yrs, still awaits fund for last 15pc work

Nine years after starting, the five-year project for construction of 'Bogra town second bypass road' from Betgari to Matidali Moar on the outskirts of Bogra town still remains incomplete.

The project period has been extended three times and over Tk 46.01 crore has been spent for constructing the 15.80 kilometre long and 7.32 metre wide road under 'Bogra Town Second Bypass Road Project', said sources at Roads and Highways Department (RHD) Bogra Division.

As 15 percent of project work remains incomplete, Tk 4.16 crore more will be needed to complete the work in one year, RHD sources said.

"If the authorities allocate Tk 4.16 crore according to revised estimate, the construction work is likely to be compete within this financial year.

The government has allocated only Tk 2 crore but the money is yet to be released," Md Abul Hossain Pramanik, executive engineer of RHD Bogra Division said. Started in 2000, the Tk 27.95 crore Bogra Town Second Bypass

Road Project was scheduled to complete within 2004-2005 financial year, RHD sources said.

The department also spent Tk 60 lakh for maintenance of the incomplete road.

The RHD has constructed two bridges in front of my house but the approach road is yet to be complete, said Md Moslim Uddin of Sujabad village in Shahjahanpur upazila.

38 fishermen held in India for 11 months back home

Thirty-eight Bangladeshi fishermen, who have been languishing in an Indian jail for 11 months, were released on

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) handed over the fishermen to Bangladesh Rifles through Benapole check post at Of the fishermen, 16 reached their respective homes in

Barguna on Friday. They are Abul Kalam, Al Amin, Halim, Siraj. Quayyum, Shahin, Bachchu, Sagir, Miraj, Zakir, Milon, Shahid, Anwar, Mostafa, yunus and Badal. The Indian navy and coastguards arrested 40 fisher-

men as they reached Indian maritime boundary after being hit by a cyclonic storm in the Bay in November The detained fishermen were first sent to a police station

under North 24 Parganas of West Bengal. They were later produced in a court that sent them to a jail. Two of the fishermen--Alamgir Hossain and Mohammad Ali--were sentenced to six months' imprisonment for illegal

entry into the Indian territory, while the rest acquitted of the Following acquittal of 38 fishermen, the Indian and Bangladesh sides exchanged letters on return of the fisher-

men. But the matter remained unresolved for two months after the judgment of the case, said Jhangir Hossain, owner of fishing trawler FB Shahjahan.

The matter was, however, resolved and the Indian authorities injured in clashes, sources said. handed them over to Bangladesh border guards.


