Musicians ushering in puja get a raw deal

Traditional instruments add to the festivity of the five-day Durga Puja. However, the honorarium given to the artistes is not anywhere near adequate in many cases.

Some 4000 artistes who play dhak, dhol and flute perform at around 525 puja mandap here, come here every year on the occasion of Durga Puja from different parts of the country --Dhaka, Bikrampur, Rajendrapur, Sirajganj, Brahmanbaria, Comilla, Kishoreganj, Netrakona, Jamalpur, Tangail, Bogra and Rangpur.

Md. Nasim Khan, a dhol player from Sirajganj, said that he came here with a group of six, and was on contract for five days with the Swadeshi Bazar Puja committee for Tk 18,000. "We will have to spend Tk 500 per person, for travel and other expenses," said Siraj Khan, another musician. He said that the amount they receive is not reasonable.

Shyamol Das, another artiste, told this correspondent that sometimes they do not fuss about the money, as it is the peak season for

Basudev Moni Das and his younger brother Pradip Moni Das who hail from Bikrampur also have a contract with a puja committee for five days. "We will get Tk 11,000 to play dhak, the main instrument of this celebration," said including 42 in the district town. The artistes Basudev. He also informed that he is a furniture maker and occasionally plays dhak as the art runs in his family. Basudev said that the remuneration should be increased, as the artistes cannot survive in this profession now.

Debesh Das and Satya Ranjan Das hail from Sadar upazila. At the Durgabari Temple, they said that they have a group of three and made a contact for Tk 9,500. "As we regularly play dhak here, we can not bargain with the committee for more money," said Debesh Das.

The musicians however said that they enjoy the celebration. The puja committees make all arrangements for their food and accommodation they said.

Michael Moore leaving documentaries?

Michael Moore said he made his latest documentary, "Capitalism: A Love Story," as though it were his last. And it might be.

Could the George W. Bush antagonist of "Fahrenheit 9/11" and gun-control champion of "Bowling for Columbine" be closing up shop? The General Motors jouster of "Roger & Me" and health care trouper of "Sicko" no longer in the documentary business?

I'm saying it's a possibility, yeah," Moore said in an interview at the Toronto International Film Festival, where "Capitalism" played in advance of its nationwide rollout on Friday. It also was screened at the Kansas International Film Festival on Sept. 18.

"I've done this for 20 years," he said. "I started out by warning people about General Motors, and my whole career has been trying to say the emperor has no clothes here, and we better do something about it. I've been having to sort of knock my head against the wall here for 20 years saying these things.

"Two years ago, I tried to get the health care debate going, and it did eventually, and now where are we? We may not even have it. What am I supposed to do at a certain point?"

Moore, 55, whose nonfiction projects include the television shows "TV Nation" and "The Awful Truth," is thinking he wants to return to fiction.

He wrote and directed one fictional film, the 1995 comedy "Canadian Bacon," starring John Candy in his next-tolast role as an American county sheriff who goes on the warpath after the U.S. president (Alan Alda) tries to boost his sagging image by provoking hostilities with Canada.

The movie was a critical and commercial dud, but Moore said he was anxious to do more narrative flicks. Moore said he has been working on two fiction screenplays while making "Capitalism," a documentary in which he pegs corporate inroads into the federal government during the Reagan years as a key factor in today's economic meltdown.

"Look, I love the movies, I love going to the movies, and I love making movies," he said. "I think making a good movie is about telling a good story, and you can do that through fiction or nonfiction. I've made a body of work of nonfiction that I'm very proud of, and like any filmmaker, I'm looking for different challenges, and things that will keep me interested and excited about what I'm doing."
