# WB's pledge for Padma may go up

Dhaka to seek additional assistance during Turkey meet

The World Bank (WB) alone may provide \$460 to be built on the river Padma connecting Mawa in Munshiganj with Jazira in Madaripur.

When the WB Managing Director Ngozi N Okonjo-Iweala meets with Finance Minister AMA Muhith at Istanbul Congress Centre, Turkey on October 7, the WB is likely to convey to the government about the commitment on the sidelines of the meeting.

At the meeting, the Bangladesh side would project the impact of world recession and climate change on Bangladesh and seek additional assistance in this regard. The assistance for constructing the Padma Bridge would figure prominently during the discussion.

Sources said, the WB would convey Bangladesh government about the enhanced commitment. Earlier the WB said it would provide \$300 million and now it is going to would be benefited. provide \$460 million.

According to primary estimate, about \$2 million for the proposed Padma Bridge project billion would be spent to construct the Padma Bridge. Alongside the WB, Asian Development Bank, Japan and Islamic Development Bank would also provide assistance.

The WB has made a study on the positive impact of the Padma Bridge. It said the bridge would boost the country's GDP by 1.2 percent. It would enable 41,000 vehicles to cross over the bridge daily.

The Padma Bridge project is about 6km long with a four-lane roadway and railway connecting Southwest region. Gas and power transmission lines would be set up along the bridge. It would include 12km of approach roads and bridge end facilities.

The WB in its study said when the bridge is constructed about 27 percent area of the country and a quarter of the country's population

### Explosion, fire at BCIC building

1 killed, 10 inured

One person was killed and 10 others were injured in a devastating fire at the BCIC building (Sadan) in the city's Motijheel commercial area yesterday.

The dead was identified as Noor-e-Malek Mujibur Rahman, 42, CBA general secretary of Ghorashal Urea Fertiliser Factory. The injured were rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital

and later shifted to the City Hospital, said hospital sources. Following the fire incident traffic on Motijheel-Jatrabari road was interrupted for over four hours in front of the BCIC

Witnesses said the accident started with a huge bang around 9:35am. They saw an air conditioner and other electronic equipment at the BCIC building blow up and hit the glass-wall on the first, second and third floors of Alico building, which is just opposite the BCIC building across the road.

They added that following the incident they saw huge black smoke emitting from the second floor of the BCIC building engulfing the entire five-storey building.

Deputy Director (DD) of Fire Brigade Abdur Rashid told The Daily Star, "The fire might have originated from a gas pipeline or an air conditioner explosion. The wave of the explosion and heat of the fire damaged glass of adjacent buildings.

· The explosion occurred at the office of The Padma Fabric (Pvt) Ltd on the second floor and soon the entire floor caught ( fire, he added.

Though the fire was restricted on the second floor, smoke and heat damaged office equipment of other floors except the ground floor of the building, he said, adding that fire fighters using ladder rescued the people trapped in the BCIC guest house on the fourth floor around 10:30am.

The rescued fell unconscious due to smoke and were sent to DMCH where Noor-e-Malek died, sources said.

Dr Shamonto Lal Sen, project director of DMCH burn unit, told The Daily Star that of the injured, eight were in a critical SEE PAGE 15 COL 3

### Pakistan vows to act on Mumbai suspects India urges quicker probe

Pakistan's foreign minister assured his Indian counterpart here Sunday that Pakistani militants blamed for last year's deadly Mumbai attacks would be tried soon but urged a broader dialogue on all bilateral issues.

After nearly two hours of talks with SM Krishna of India, Shah Mahmood Qureshi told reporters: "the formal trial (of the seven Pakistani suspects) will start on Oct 3. Pakistan

wants to see the trial to its logical conclusion." Earlier Krishna told a separate press conference: "The (Mumbai probe) process must gather further momentum."

The seven suspects are accused by India of carrying out the Mumbai attacks that left 166 people dead.

"The process must gather further momentum," SM Krishna told reporters after meeting here with his Pakistani counterpart Shah Qureshi. SEE PAGE 15 COL 7

#### Coroner terms Sutopa's death as suicide

The post-mortem report of the forensic department of Dhaka Medical College and Hospital (DMCH) has described the death of Dhaka University student Mafruda Huq Sutopa as suicidal in nature.

However, the victim's family rejected the report terming it a 'partial' one.

The report says, "the death was due to asphyxia as a result of hanging which was antemortem and suicidal in nature." It was sent to Mirpur police on Sunday evening.

Talking to The Daily Star, Sutapa's brother-in-law Hafiz Akbar alleged that doctors concerned have given a 'partial' report to save Sutapa's husband Imrul Sadat alias Abeer an accused. He also demanded a fresh

post-mortem examination as police inquest report found the body bore several marks of injuries. Sutapa, a master's
