Criminal killed in 'shootout'

BSS, Chuadanga

A listed criminal, identified as Bahar Rashid Mollah, son of Fatuzzuddin Mollah of village Alokdia under Sadar upazila was killed in a 'gun battle' with police near Bujukgari brick field on Friday night. Police said Rashid was wanted in about a dozen cases including six murders. Sources said, a police team raided Bujukgari brick field area where Rashid Mollah and his accomplices were holding a meeting at midnight. Sensing police presence, the criminals opened fire on the lawmen and at one stage of exchange of gunfire Rashid was hit by a bullet and died on the spot. Police recovered one shutter-gun and three bullets after the incident.

RU employee held

Motihar police arrested an employee of Rajshahi University (RU) yesterday afternoon on charge of attacking a Chhatra League (BCL) activist on the campus. Officer-in-Charge of Motihar police station Tofazzal Hossain told this correspondent that Mizanur Rahman, an employee of Language Department, was held from Tukitaki area of the campus for alleged attack on Ferdous Ali on August 13. "There are also some other cases against Mizanur with the police station", he said. Police said Mizanur was later sent to the Rajshahi Metropolitan Magistrate Court (RMMC).

One held with heroin

Members of the Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) yesterday arrested one person with heroin worth Tk 80 lakh at frontier village Alatali under Sadar upazila. BDR sources said, a patrol team at Poladanga border outpost (BOP) arrested Rafiqul Islam, 25, of Kodalkati village and recovered 800 grams of heroin from his possession. Rafiqul was returning from India with the heroin at about 8:20 am.

Godown gutted

A paddy and jute godown owned by a retired army man was gutted in a fire on Friday night at Kumriri Hat village of Aditmari upazila. Nine people were injured while trying to put off the fire. Fire service team from Lalmonirhat rushed to the spot and extinguished the fire in a struggle for about two hours. Fire service men said the fire originated from an electric short circuit. According to a preliminary estimate, goods worth Tk 10 lakh were damaged.

Punish the rapists

Pirojpur people demand at human chain

Bangladesh Mahila Parishad Pirojpur district unit organised a human chain on Club Road in the town on Friday demanding arrest and punishment of the perpetrators responsible for raping a schoolgirl, recording the scene and trading on the pornography.

People from all walks of life participated in the programme where leaders of different socio-cultural-political organisations and NGOs addressed.

Following a case against five people on September 28 in connection with trading CD containing video footage of the rape by a BCL leader of Pirojpur town, police arrested Suman Talukdar, owner of Shoukhin Audio-Video Corner, Shahin Hossain, apprentice worker of Digital Mobile Servicing Centre, and Faisal Gazi, buyer of the porno CD.

But the main accused Ahsan Kabir Mamun

alias Mamun Hawlader and his associate Monir Hossain alias 'Ganja' Monir have remained absconding.

Law enforcers arrested 13 more people and seized huge porno CDs, computer drives and accessories in Pirojpur district and Nazirpur upazila towns in last six days.

Police also filed five cases with Pirojpur Sadar and four with Nazirpur police stations against the arrestees on charges of distribution of the obscene video footage, circulating and trading pornography, said officers-in-charge of Pirojpur Sadar and Nazirpur police stations.

Everyone responsible for the rape, its recording and trading of the porno CDs will be arrested, said Pirojpur Superintendent of Police Md Shahidullah Chowdhury.

Police also continued drives to seize all the records of the video footage from the market, he added.

Jaldhaka rape, killing of schoolgirl sparks protest

The students of Jaldhaka Pilot Girls' High School brought out a procession in the town yesterday demanding arrest and punishment of the rapist and

killer of Eti Moni, a class ten student of the school.

On Wednesday evening, Eti Moni was raped and strangled allegedly by timber trader Mahmud Rahman, 25, who usually stays in the sawmill adjacent to Eti's house at LSD Para in Jaldhaka municipality, said the victim's family members and police.

Mahmud Rahman hails from Dundibari village in the upazila.

The victim's father said when he returned home from market, he saw Mahmud Rahman hurrying out from the house. As he challenged, the latter left the place by overpowering him. Entering the house, he found Eti Moni lying senseless on the floor with scurf around her neck. She was rushed to Jaldhaka Upazila Health

Complex where on-duty doctors declared her dead.

The victim's father filed a rape and murder case with Jaldhaka Police Station accusing Mahmud Rahman the next day.

The 'inquest' report suggests that the girl was raped, Jaldhaka Police Station Officer-in-Charge Arman Hossain said, adding that police were trying their best to arrest the culprit.

Eti's post-mortem was done in the district hospital the next day.

5 held on rape, killing charges sent to jail

Five arrestees including two alleged rapists and killers of ten-year-old schoolgirl Shahnaz Begum of Digalbagh village in Dhobaura upazila were sent to jail after they were produced before a Mymensingh court yesterday.

The arrestees are rape and murder accused Manik Miah, 35, and his brother Sujon Miah, 25, their sisters Fatema Khatun and Halima Khatun and mother Marazi Begum.

Daughter of late Abul Kashem of village Digalbagh, Shahnaz was killed allegedly after violation at neighbouring Nayapara village at around 8:00pm on Thursday night.

Manik and Sujon of village Nayapara kidnapped Shahnaz from the bank of Netai River, took her to their home and killed her after rape, police said.

Police arrested Manik and Sujon on Friday morning and later recovered the victim's body following their confessional statement.

Wild elephant found dead in Bandarban

A wild elephant was found dead in a rubber garden at Baishari forests under Naikkyangchhari upazila of Bandarban on Thursday.

Being informed, police and forest officials visited the rubber garden at Alihyong. The elephant might have died due to malnutrition and lack of food, said an official of the Sangu Forest Range, Zahirul Haque, who prepared the inquest report.

Earlier, two more wild elephants died at Fashikhali and Yancha under Lama upazila of Bandarban in September last year, said officials.

Three children drown as 2 boats capsize

Three children were drowned in separate boat mishaps in two water bodies on Friday evening. The victims are Junaid, 7, and Anki, 3, son and daughter of Asanul Haque of Urokhia village under Nabibagar upazila and Purna, 4, daughter of Abdul Basid of Bagalpur village under Sadar upazila.

Police and eyewitnesses said, a boat with 40 passengers capsized in Monipur Beel (water body) due to stormy weather while going to Urokhia village from Nabibagar upazila headquarters. All the passengers but Junaid and his sister Anki survived the mishap by swimming ashore.

In the other mishap, a boat with 25 passengers overturned in Hathkula Beel while going to Singerbeel village from Brahmanbaria Sadar. All but Purna, 4, swam ashore.

IU classes resume

The academic and administrative activities of Islamic University (IU) in Kushtia resumed yesterday after a 36-day vacation on the occasion of Ramadan, Eid-ul-Fitr and Durga Puja.

Earlier on Thursday, residential halls of the university were reopened. Classes and examinations of various departments were held on the opening day.

8 sued for bid to grab govt land, assaulting official

Eight people have been sued on charges of taking control of a government land meant for construction of district press club building and assaulting a land official in the town.

Assistant land officer ATM Shamsul Islam filed the case with Sadar Police Station on Thursday night.

The accused with the help of some local youths grabbed 25 decimal land in the town's Shahi Para area on the night of September 27 to construct a commercial building on it.

Local journalists immediately brought the matter to the deputy commissioner who sent land officials to the spot the following day. The land with the help of police removed a fence erected by the grabbers and freed the land.

Angered by the action of the district administration local administration, the grabbers attacked the makeshift press club built on the land and assaulted club secretary Ratan Sarker on September 28. They also asked the journalists to leave the place or face dire consequences.

When the newsmen filed a general diary (GD) with Sadar

Police Station, the land grabbers changed their strategy. They again took control of the land and this time started building a mosque on it.

Hearing the news, Sadar Upazila Nirbahi Officer (UNO), Khorshed Alam went to the spot and urged the grabbers not to build any illegal structure on the government land.

As the grabbers did not pay heed to UNO's request, Sadar upazila Assistant Commissioner of land (AC Land) Farzana Sharmin along with a contingent of police went to the spot and asked the occupants to leave the place.

At one stage, the grabbers with the help of some local youths assaulted the AC Land, kept her under siege and spread a rumour that the land official had ordered police to demolish the under-construction mosque. They also swooped on the law enforcers who tried to rescue the AC Land.

Police rescued the AC Land who along with the law enforcers left the place.

Meanwhile, 25 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups over ownership of a land in Jadur hat village under Sadar upazila yesterday.

Eight of the injured were admitted to Sadar hospital.
