Ruet admission test

Rajshahi University of Engineering and Technology (Ruet) will hold the admission test for first year students for 2009-10 academic session on November 21. According to the admission rule this year, only the students who have passed Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) Examination-2009 or equivalent certificate can apply for admission. There will be 50 marks out of total 100, in Multiple Choice Questions (MCQ) in mathematics, physics, chemistry and English. Only 425 students will be admitted under three faculties this year, Ruet sources said. The admission seekers can get further admission related information on Ruet website at www.ruet.ac.bd. The admission form distribution and collection will start on October 11 and continue till November 5.

Brother, sister drown

A boy and his sister were drowned in a canal adjacent to Brahmaputra flood control embankment at Purbo Barobaldia under Gaibandha Sadar upazila yesterday afternoon. Locals said Mona, 10, daughter and Babu, 7, son of Moinul Mia of village Purbo Barobaldia went to take a dip in the canal. Babu suddenly fell in the canal. To rescue her brother, Mona jumped into the water and both were drowned. Locals later recovered the bodies of the boy and the girl.

One killed in land dispute

One person was killed and four others were injured yesterday in a feud over a disputed land in Mehendiganj upazila. Rahman Molla, son of deceased Malek Molla lodged a murder case with Mehendiganj police station and police arrested Fazlu Molla, Faruk Molla, Bellal Molla, Saiful Molla, four accused siblings and cousins of the victim. Police said families of two cousins of Malek and Fazlu of Mollabari in Lata Goraghat village under Andharmanik union of the upazila had a long-standing dispute over land of their grand father. On Saturday afternoon, one group led by Fazlu Molla attacked their rival cousins led by Malek Molla during a feud over taking possession of a disputed land. Malek Molla, 50, his wife Jasmin Begum, 35, and brother and sister Rob Molla, 40, Razia Begum, 45, were beaten up and stabbed. Locals sent them to Barisal Sher-e-Bangla Medical College and Hospital in a critical condition where Malek Molla succumbed to his injuries.

Fire damages Tk 4 lakh eggs

Eggs worth about Tk 4 lakh were damaged in a fire at Patbari of Benapole yesterday morning. Sources said, the fire that gutted at least 63,000 eggs in a godown, originated from an electric short circuit. GM Enterprise recently decided to import 14,70,000 eggs through Benapole land port. After taking delivery of 63,000 eggs on October 1, he kept them in the local godown. Fire fighters rushed to the spot and doused the fire in a struggle for over an hour.

3 youths electrocuted

Three youths were electrocuted at Kashar in Bhaluka upazila on Saturday when they came in contact of live electric wire. They were identified as Rasel, 17, son of Abul Hossain of Akua in Mymensingh town, Akkas Ali, 24, and Joyanal Hazari, 25, of Faridpur district. Police said the victims died instantly when they were working at a textile mill at around 1.30 pm. Their bodies, recovered by police, were sent to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital (MMCH) for autopsy. A case was lodged with Bhaluka police station in this connection.

30 injured in clash

Thirty people were injured in a clash between two rival groups at Haripur village under Sadar upazila yesterday. Police said, Saban Hossain and Moniruzzaman of Haripur village had deep tube well business. On Sunday morning, they sat together to examine the expenditure of their joint business. But at one stage they locked in an altercation and started to beat each other. After a while their supporters equipped with batons and iron rods joined the clash. During the clash, Abdur Rashid and Israil Hossain received serious injuries. They were rushed to Khulna hospital.

JMB chief's property in Habiganj attached

Rab arrests one in Nilphamari

A Habiganj court yesterday issued arrest warrants against outlawed Jama'at ul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) chief Maulana Saidur Rahman and two other cadres and ordered attachment of their property, while Rab arrested a member of the outfit in Nilphamari on Saturday night.

District and Sessions Judge Md Mahbub-Ul Haque passed the order as Maulana Saidur and two others charge-sheeted in five cases relating to serial blasts on August 17, 2005 have been absconding since filing of the cases, reports our staff correspondent from Sylhet.

The two other accused are

JMB cadres Shafiqul Islam and Saleh Uddin.

As the prosecution sought time for executing the property attachment order, the judge extended the time for attachment of the property until November 23.

Eight JMB men, including its chief Maulana Saidur, have been accused in five cases for exploding bombs on the premises of Habiganj DC's office, district Bar Library, Poursava market, Kotwali Police Station and police superintendent's office on August 17, 2005.

Police yesterday produced five of the accused in the court. They are AHM Shamim, son of Maulana Saidur, Azizul Islam Gazi, Hafez Huzaifa and Belal

Hossain Tamim and Salehin.

Our Nilphamari correspondent adds: Members of the Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) arrested a JMB member at Sholmari Munshipara village under Jaldhaka upazila on Saturday night.

Acting on a tip-off, a team of Rab-5 raided the village and arrested.

Nazrul Islam, son of Tamizuddin, at their house. After preliminary interrogation, the elite force handed him over to Jaldhaka Police Station the same night.

Police produced the JMB man in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate here yesterday, seeking a seven-day remand, but the court granted five days' remand for him.

PCJSS leader abducted, former PCP man shot

Body of UPDF leader recovered

A leader of Parbatya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity (PCJSS) was abducted allegedly by the armed cadres of United People's Democratic Front (UPDF) from his house at Kengrachhari village under Balaichhari upazila on Friday night.

The kidnapped leader is Bimal Nanda Chakma alias Gulliver, 62, vice-president of PCJSS Balaichhari unit.

Police quoted locals as saying that a group of armed men came to Bimal's house at around 11:00pm and picked him up at gunpoint.

The law enforcers could not rescue the PCJSS leader as of filing of this report at 6:00pm yesterday.

Meanwhile, a former leader of Pahari Chhatra Prishad (PCP), student front of the PCJSS, was shot by unidentified gunmen in the town on Saturday night.

The victim, Sumet Chakma, 35, son of Jamini Mohon Chakma, received bullets in the head and chest. He is now undergoing treatment at Chittagong Medical College Hospital.

In a press release issued by Sajib Chakma, assistant secretary of PCJSS central committee, yesterday strongly condemned the incident and demanded immediate arrest of the culprits.

Our Khagrachhari correspondent reports: Police yesterday recovered the body of an indigenous person from jungle near Battali under Laxmichhari upazila of Khagrachhari district.

The dead was identified as Rukhoyi Marma, a member of the United People's Democratic Front (UPDF) central committee.

Police sent the body to Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital for autopsy.

UPDF blamed Chittagong Hill Tracts National Front (CHTNF) for the killing and demanded arrest of the killers.

Students confine VC to office for 2 hours

The students of the Comilla University yesterday kept Vice Chancellor Prof Dr AHM Zehadul Karim confined to his office room for one hour demanding his removal.

Students went to the vice chancellor's room to submit their seven-point demand including punishment of the armed intruders who earlier involved in clashes on the campus, ban on outsiders' entrance, setting up a police camp for students' security, providing better facilities in the dormitories, police and witnesses said.

Finding no 'satisfactory response' from the vice chancellor, the agitated students confined him to his room.

Following request from teachers and officials, the students left after one hour. Later they burnt effigy of the vice chancellor and brought out a procession on the campus demanding his removal.

"We submitted seven-point demand for benefit of the general students. But the vice chancellor did not pay heed to our demands. Now we want his quick removal for betterment of the university," said Mahmudur Rahman Masum, a leader of the university unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League.

Homestead of a physically and mentally challenged family grabbed in Panchagarh

A land grabber at Bordingpara village under Debiganj upazila in Panchagarh district has forced a hapless family to leave their ancestral land without fully paying the price of the land.

Yanus Ali, 35, his wife Hazera Begum, 30, daughters Ofsin, and Yasmin, and son Hazirul, had been living in their six-decimal ancestral land in Bordingpara village.

All of them except Ofsin are physically and mentally challenged.

Their neighbour Tajul Islam, who eyed the land in the upazila town, cajoled Yanus to sell his three-decimal land for Tk 70 thousand per decimal, said locals and victim's relatives.

Tajul gave Yanus Tk 50,000 and got registration of the three-decimal land several months ago saying that the remaining Tk 1,60,000 would be paid in a short time.

But Tajul continued buying time on different pretexts.

At one stage, Yanus's elder brother went to Tajul and asked him to give the amount to

meet the expenses for wedding of his niece Ofsin, but Tajul told him that he had paid the total price of the land before registration.

Tajul also asked him to vacate the land.

After an inconclusive arbitration on last Monday, Tajul and his accomplices attacked Yanus and his family and forced them out of their house.

They are now living in a neighbouring village.

This correspondent tried to take Yanus' version about the incident, but the physically and mentally challenged man was unable to speak in communicable language.

With the help of local NGO Disability Development Centre, Yanus filed a complaint to district superintendent of police (SP) the next day.

SP Shaharier Rahman said he has ordered the officer-in-charge of Debiganj Police Station to investigate the matter and take legal action.

As Tajul was not available, his son Zahedul said, "Yanus did not hand over the three-decimal land that we bought from him. So we took up the land."

Rapist's men threaten victim's family

A teenage tailor worker was raped allegedly by a local youth at Bhuli village in Thakurgaon Sadar upazila on Monday last.

The rapist and his accomplices also threatened her family members not to file any case or tell the matter to anyone, said the victim who filed a case accusing Zakir Hossain, 24, of Kesharbari village in Sadar upazila on Saturday evening.

The victim, worker of a tailoring shop at Bhuli bazar, was returning to her Kachubari village house under Sadar upazila on Monday evening.

When she reached near Bhuli Chashi Club, Zakir forced her to go beside a crop field at knife-point and raped her, leaving her injured.

Hearing her scream, one Abdul Latif helped her to go home.

Thakurgaon Police Station Officer-in-Charge Sohrab Hossain said they sent the victim to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital for medical test yesterday.

Strike put off
