

Comilla University closed as BCL, Shibir men clash

Authorities yesterday closed Comilla University until October 15 after clashes between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League and Islami Chhatra Shibir left at least 25 students injured in the morning.

The students were also asked to vacate their dormitories yesterday noon.

Both BCL and Shibir brought out separate processions on the campus demanding resignation of Vice Chancellor Dr Zihadul Karim but activists of the two rival organisations got locked in a clash at one stage of their demonstrations.

They attacked each other with sticks and stones, leaving 25 students injured.

Eleven seriously injured ones were admitted to hospitals.

Among the injured are Shovon, Ruhul Amin,

Iman Hossain, Shahidul Islam, Saiful Islam, Sariful Bari and Abu Musa of BCL and Sojib, Tofayel, Mahabub Miazee, Habibur Rahman, Anwar and Shahadat of Shibir.

The agitated students also ransacked several classrooms and office rooms and damaged windowpanes, doors, furniture and computers.

On information, police rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control.

Following an emergency meeting of the university Syndicate, authorities announced the decision to suspend all the classes and examinations until October 15.

However, the university offices will remain open.

A large number of police have been deployed to stave off further violence as a tense situation is prevailing in the area.

12 get life for BCL leader murder

Additional district and sessions judge Ekramul Haque Chowdhury yesterday sentenced 12 people to life term imprisonment and fined Tk 30,000 each, in default to suffer one more year in jail for killing a local BCL leader.

The convicts are Rupton Mia, Polash, Mukhlesur Rahman, Sadek Mia, Abul Kashem, Bazlur Rahman, Jahan, Saiful Islam, Rial, Milon, Jamaluddin and Nayan Mia of village Muktir Bazar under

Netrakona Sadar upazila.

According to the prosecution story, on February 21 in 2004, the aforesaid people killed BCL leader Sujon, son of Ali Haider of the same village with sharp weapons.

Kulsuma Akhter, mother of Sujon filed a killing case with Netrakona Sadar police station accusing 12 people.

On investigation, police submitted charge sheet against all the accused.

The judge after examining the witnesses and evidences, found them guilty and pronounced the verdict.

Jubo League leader held while making false ID card

Police arrested a local Jubo League leader and a Myanmar citizen in Ali Kadam upazila of Bandarban district, on charge of preparing a false national identity card for the foreign national.

The arrestees, local Jubo League leader Samar Ranjan Barua and Myanmar citizen Mohammad Fazal Karim Yusuf, a Rohingya, were held when Barua was laminating the false ID card after preparing it at his computer shop on Sunday night, police said.

Police also seized a camera and computer from Barua. Barua, however, said he took order for laminating the card brought by Yusuf but was not involved in preparing it.

Ali Kadam upazila Awami League leader Nasirul Alam alleged that police filed a false case against Samar Ranjan Barua after staging an 'ID card drama' and arrested the Jubo League leader to harass him.

On the other hand, Bandarban district Awami League Organising Secretary Laxmipada Das said, "Samar was once a Chhatra League worker but now he is not involved in any political activity."

Diarrhoea situation in Pabna alarming

Around a hundred diarrhoea patients were admitted to Pabna General Hospital from Tuesday to Wednesday noon as the water-borne disease sees alarming spread in the district, especially Pabna Sadar upazila.

Over 800 diarrhoea patients were admitted to Pabna General Hospital in last 15 days, hospital sources said, adding that accommodation problem coupled with shortage of doctors and nurses in the diarrhoea ward is hampering treatment.

"We have admitted 92 diarrhoea patients in last 24 hours. Some 20 more patients are waiting," Shefali Khatun, senior nurse in the diarrhoea ward of Pabna General Hospital said yesterday noon.

"Only two nurses working in the diarrhoea ward are struggling to tackle the patients," she said.

This correspondent yesterday saw over 70/80 patients lying on the hospital floors because of lack of seats in the diarrhoea ward.

Many patients complained of poor service.

"We are staying on the floor. Hospital authorities do not have proper arrangement for us. Even we don't have enough toilet facility," said Md Tezlem Ali, 26, of Nurpur village.

"My diarrhoea-affected mother was admitted to Pabna General Hospital. I came to attend her but I have also become affected. Now both of us are lying on the hospital floor," said Rita, 22, of Dubla village.

"The number of diarrhoea patients is on the rise. The situation deteriorated badly in last 24 hours. Over 800 diarrhoea patients took treatment at Pabna General Hospital during the last 15 days," said Resident Medical Officer Dr Md Tarikul Islam.

Admitting inadequacy of health service for a large number of diarrhoea patients, he said, "The water-borne disease easily spreads from affected people to others."

"The diarrhoea situation has recently deteriorated in Pabna Sadar upazila, especially in the municipality area. The situation is under control in other upazilas of the district. We are trying our best to provide necessary medical treatment for the diarrhoea patients in Pabna General Hospital," Pabna Civil Surgeon Dr AHM Khairul Alam Chowdhury said.

Admitting manpower crisis in the hospital, he said they are maintaining the 250-bed hospital with facilities for 100 beds only.

Diarrhoea started spreading in Pabna district after the Eid-ul-Fitr.

A woman died and over 100 people were affected with diarrhoea in Ishwardi upazila of the district during the last one week.

Tornado lashes ten Gaibandha villages

Tornado yesterday morning lashed 10 villages of three upazilas in the district damaging a large number of dwelling houses and a few educational institutes.

At least 35 people were injured as houses collapsed and uprooted trees fell on many. Power supply remained snapped in the affected areas.

The most affected areas are Balatta, Nandir vita, Supereer

vita, Beradanga, Boali Khamar Boali, Schooler Bazar under Gaibandha Sadar upazila, Gopalcharon, Nayan Sukh under Sunderganj upazila and Pashchim Salua under Fulchhari upazila.

According to a preliminary estimate, the tornado destroyed or damaged around 290 dwelling houses in the affected areas.

Volunteers have rescued many injured villagers and took them to local health complex.

Bring culprits to book, journals' memo to PM

Patuakhali journalists yesterday submitted memorandum to the prime minister, the home minister and the information minister through Patuakhali deputy commissioner demanding immediate arrest of the attackers on journalists in Galachipa on September 9.

They also demanded removal of the officer-in-charge of Galachipa Police Station for failure to take action against the perpetrators.

Patuakhali Press Club President Nirmol Kumar Rakshit and Secretary Kazi Shamsur Rahman led a team of journalists to hand over the memoranda to the DC.

Earlier a protest meeting held at Patuakhali Press Club on Monday evening took week long movement programme including submission of memorandum, forming human chain, holding protest meeting and breaking pens.


On September 9, Mufti Salahuddin of RTV, Abu Taher Bappa of Banglavisun, Sankar Lal Das of the daily Prothom Alo and ABC Radio, Khondokar Delwar Jalali of Channel One and Hanjala Shihab of Diganta TV were on their way to different places in Galachipa upazila for professional duty.

As the journalists, working as Patuakhali district correspondents of the respective media, reached Haridevpur ferry point

at noon, a gang attacked them and tried to snatch cameras, mobile and note books from Salahuddin and Bappa.

Three other journalists managed to cross the river and took shelter inside Galachipa Police Station.

Threatened by criminals, the journalists had to stay at the police station for two hours until a team from Patuakhali Rab camp rescued them.

Showcouse on Shibir leader

They also threatened to paralyse the campus as the proctor tried to prevent them from holding the rally on the campus. The notice signed by proctor Prof Chowdhury Zakaria asked the Shibir leader to explain the matter within seven days.

2 held on rape charge

Police on Tuesday night arrested two youths on charge of raping a 7-year-old girl at Nayakandi village under Shivalaya police station. The arrestees are Suja, 16, and Samej, 20, of the village. Victim's father earlier filed a case with the police station against the two youths alleging that Suja took her daughter to his house four days ago. There he raped the girl while Samej kept watch by standing outside the door, he said. Officer in-charge of Shivalaya police station Moniruzzaman said the rape victim was being treated at Manikganj Sadar Hospital.

Online registration

Rajshahi education board will introduce online registration system for the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinees. It is being started 'on experimental basis' at 15 colleges of eight districts, said the board's chairman Dipakendranath Das. "We will go for the total online registration from the next year," he said. College employees who will do the job will undergo training from October 14, he added. The 15 colleges that have been selected are Rajshahi New Government Degree College, Rajshahi Government City College and Rajshahi Cadet College, Naogaon Government College, Chapainawabganj Government College and Adina Government Fazlul Haque College, Rani Bhawani Government Women's College, Kadirabad Cantonment College in Greater Rajshahi districts. The other colleges are -- Pabna Cadet College, Pabna Government Women's College, Sirajganj Rashiduzzoha Government Women's College, Bogra Cantonment Public School and College and Government SR Women's College and Joypurhat Women's Cadet College and Joypurhat Government Women's College.

4 pushed back to Myanmar

Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) on Monday pushed back four more Myanmar nationals through Chakdhala frontier point. Sources said police rounded up the Myanmar nationals from Baishari under Naikhyongchhari upazila of the hill district of Bandarban on the same day. Later, BDR pushed back Mohammad Younus, 25, Abul Hussein, 20, Mohammad Shaker, 27, and Syed Ahmed, 45, all hailing from Bushidong under Akiash district of Myanmar. They had entered Bangladesh through different border points illegally.

Young man electrocuted

A poultry farm employee was electrocuted at Charhijuli village in Manikganj Sadar on Tuesday night. Victim Shariful Islam, 25, hailed from Bhayat village under Tarash police station in Sirajganj district. Ashraf, an employee of Ali Poultry told journalists that the farm owner connected an electric line with the fence of the farm to save it from thieves. Shariful was killed on the spot when he came in contact of the fence at night. Police recovered the body and sent it to Manikganj Sadar Hospital for autopsy.
