Flood follows rain

At least 15 villages in the district and a few areas of the town were inundated due to two days of continuous rain. About 300 families were marooned in the flash flood. The most affected villages are Khalpara, Nayabosti, Collegepara, Fakdanpur, Mohammadpur, Hathadpara and Munshirhat under Sadar upazila, Shaguni under Pirganj upazila, Shindurna village under Ranishankoil upazila. Rivers Tangan, Kulik Dhepa and Shenua swelled and overflowed their banks affecting aman and vegetable fields on hundreds of acres.

Charge framing date

Sylhet Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal Judge Md Mahub-ul Islam on Wednesday set October 18 for charge framing in the case filed for bomb attack on veteran AL leader Suranjit Sengupta's public meeting. All the accused were produced before the tribunal. AL activist Abdul Wahid, 45, was killed and about 30 others sustained injuries when the bombs were hurled on dais just before the end of the meeting in Derai upazila headquarters in Sunamganj on June 21, 2004. Suranjit escaped unhurt as he along with other leaders got down from the dais moments before the attack. The CID on December 14, 2008 filed charge sheet against Mufti Abdul Hannan and 6 others of Huji for the attack. Later, the sensational case was transferred to the Divisional Speedy Trial Tribunal.

Record rainfall

The season's highest rainfall here in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning caused sharp rise in the water levels in all the rivers in northern districts. The Teesta crossed its danger mark at Dalia point in Nilphamari. Water Development Board (WDB) recorded 234mm rainfall at Dalia in Nilphamari, 221mm at Kawnia in Rangpur, 106mm at Rangpur, 121mm at Kurigram, 192mm at Chilmari, 182mm at Panchagarh, 130mm at Gaibandha and 130.5mm at Dinajpur during the period till 6am.

Statue recovered

A precious touchstone idol of Lord Krishna was recovered from Bonogram Rajbari area yesterday. Sources said a team of police chased two suspected smugglers in Bonogram Rajbari area. At one stage, they fled the scene leaving behind a 8.50 kg idol of Lord Krishna. The value of the idol was estimated at Tk 8 crore by the officials. The members of the law enforcing agency brought the idol to Bagerhat police station.

Woman strangled

A day labourer allegedly strangled his wife at Sonakandi village in Raupura in Narsingdi on Wednesday. Police said, the incident took place when victim Zohora Khatun, 30, locked in a quarrel with husband Mostafa who returned home late at night. Immediately after Mostafa strangled his wife, locals detained him and handed him over to police. Zohora's uncle Zonab Ali filed a murder case.

Fugitive convict arrested

A joint team of police and Rab early yesterday arrested in the capital Babul Bepari, 30, of Shibchar who was convicted in murder, robbery and arms cases and was on the run. Shibchar police station officer in-charge Abdul Jalil said, a team of police from Shibchar went to Dhaka and arrested Babul during a joint raid in Jatrabari Dayaganj area. Babul was brought to Shibchar police station for interrogation. He is a son of Hakim Bepari of Ram Rayerkandi village under Umedpur union.

Motor worker electrocuted

A motor worker was electrocuted on Wednesday near Thakurgaon bus stand while working at a garage. The victim was identified as Dharendra Nath Barman, 42, son of Kotkotu Barman of Akcha village under Sadar upazila. Locals said, at about 9:00am when Dharendra Nath was working at Prodip's garage, he came in contact of a live wire. His co-workers rescued him and rushed him to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital where the on-duty doctor declared him death.

Threat to stop admission test

The students of folklore department of Rajshahi University (RU) yesterday threatened to stop admission test of the department scheduled for October 14 as the department was not put under the Social Science Faculty. They boycotted their scheduled classes and examinations and locked their classrooms and staged a sit-in in front of the arts building to press their demand. They met RU Proctor Prof Chowdhury Zakaria and threatened to disrupt the admission test if their demand is not met before October 14.

Withdraw false cases, arrest attackers

Agitating Patuakhali journalists demand

Patuakhali journalists yesterday formed a human chain in front of the local press club demanding removal of the officer-in-charge of Galachipa Police Station, withdrawal of four 'false' cases filed against two journalists in Galachipa and arrest of the perpetrators of September 9 attack on journalists.

Wearing black cloth masks, over 50 journalists of different print and electronic media took part in the one hour-long human chain that ended at noon.

Earlier on Wednesday, local journalists submitted separate memorandum to the prime minister, minister for home affairs and information minister through Patuakhali deputy

commissioner on the same issue.

The journalists will observe 'pen breaking programme' at Patuakhali Press Club on the same issue tomorrow.

On September 9, Mufti Salahuddin of RTV, Abu Taher Bappa of Banglavisian, Sankar Lal Das of the Daily Prothom Alo and ABC Radio, Khondokar Delwar Jalali of Channel One and Hanjala Shihab of Diganta TV came under attack at Haridevpur ferry point.

The journalists, working as Patuakhali district correspondents of the respective media, were on their way to different places in Galachipa upazila for professional duty.

Later four false cases were filed against two journalists in Galachipa.

Embittered villagers' lesson for a thief

Hundreds of people of Dangarhat village in Dimla upazila on Wednesday attacked and demolished the house of a thief who had turned a nuisance to villagers through rampant stealing and hemp trade.

The notorious thief, Fazlu, 42, became a nuisance as he was involved in stealing corrugated iron sheet of local primary school, farmers' shallow pump machines and cattle, villagers' household goods, even ducks and chickens, villagers said.

Fazlu also ran hemp trade, adding to deteriora-

tion of social environment in the village.

Villagers said earlier on several occasions they asked Fazlu not to disturb their peace but to no effect.

There were several cases against the thief in Dimla Police Station but the thief so far escaped any major action.

When contacted, Balapara union parishad Chairman Tabibur Rahman said, "I had forbidden the villagers to do such act but they did not listen."

Dimla Police Station Officer-in-Charge Shawkat Hossain said, "I have heard the incident. If owner of the demolished house comes to file a case, it will be recorded."

Two die of diarrhoea in Pabna

70 more hospitalised

Two people died of diarrhoea on Tuesday and Wednesday while 70 more diarrhoea patients were admitted to Pabna General Hospital in 24 hours from Wednesday to Thursday afternoon as diarrhoea situation has further deteriorated in the district.

Affected with diarrhoea, Yunus Ali, a police constable of Faridpur Police Station in Pabna, died on Tuesday night in Faridpur upazila while Morjina Begum, 55, a resident of Pabna town, died on Wednesday night in Pabna General Hospital, said an official of district health department.

"We are monitoring the situation and several medical teams are working in the diarrhoea-affected areas. Most of the diarrhoea patients are from Pabna municipality area," said Pabna Civil Surgeon Dr AHM Khairul Alam Chowdhury.

Notorious 'Blacker' Shamsu arrested

Detective Branch (DB) of police arrested a most notorious criminal of the south-western region from Kalibari Road in Khulna city Wednesday evening.

The arrestee, Shamsul Alam alias Blacker Shamsu, 50, of Rajapur village under Rupsha upazila of Khulna district faces several cases filed with different police stations in Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira and Jessore districts, said Md Abu Sayem, assistant commissioner (DB) of Khulna Metropolitan Police.

There are specific charges of smuggling and hoarding of rice and sugar, illegal trade of arms, explosive substances, drugs, gold, Indian clothes and cosmetics against Shamsu, said the police official.

He is also a harbourer and financier of a group of armed cadres of Janajuddho faction of outlawed BCP, police said. DB police was interrogating him at the KMP headquarters when this report was being filed.

Shamsul, who started working as a tailor on Helatala Road in Khulna city in 1985, joined the gang of foodgrain lifters of Khulna skid ghat

under notorious criminal Ershad Shikder (hanged in a murder case).

Shamsu took up the charge for smuggling of rice, arms, Indian clothes, spices, explosive substances and cosmetics after Ershad Shikder was arrested on August 11, 1999.

He went into hiding after Ershad Shikder was hanged on May 10 in 2003 in connection with murder of a Jubo League leader.

Arrested several times by Rapid Action Battalion and police since 2004, Shamsu managed to get bail from courts allegedly due to weak investigations by police.

A home ministry meeting held on April 30 in 2003 listed him as a notorious smuggler and hundi trader.

Factional Feud AL stops its activities in Galachipa

Patuakhali district unit AL has suspended all party activities in Galachipa for next one month to avoid a factional feud there.

District AL unit took this decision at a meeting held at the party office on Tuesday night with Ismail Hossain, vice president of the unit in the chair.

Sources said, Galachipa AL is now divided into two separate factions, one led by lawmaker Golam Mowla Roni and the other by upazila unit AL president also upazila parishad chairman Harun-or-Rashid.

Both the factions are now carrying out party activities separately. On Monday night, the faction led by Harun-or-Rashid declared lawmaker Golam Mawla Roni 'unwanted' in Galachipa for his alleged involvement in 'anti-party activities'.

The same day, in a separate meeting the Golam Mawla faction 'dismissed' Harun-or-Rashid from his post for alleged indiscipline. They also selected Rezaul Kaim, vice president of Galachipa unit AL as acting president.

The Government of the People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA), and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payment under the contract for hiring of some National IT Specialist for the Central Bank Strengthening Project (CBSP) to facilitate automation in the area of Banking & Treasury, Enterprise Resources Planning, Data Warehousing, Office Automation, Intranet, and CIB Online etc.

The RDBMS Specialist for Data Warehousing will be responsible for the oversight and implementation of the data warehouse system as specified in the vendor's proposal to meet the requirement of BB.

The main objective and scope of work is to act as the individual responsible for project management and implementation of the data warehouse system, taking delivery of the system on behalf of Bangladesh Bank and coordinating work between Bangladesh Bank and the selected vendor and will report to the Project Director (CBSP). The selected specialist will work for a period of 12 (twelve) months that may be extended by mutual agreement.

The RDBMS Specialist for Data Warehousing should be minimum graduate in Science/Business/IT related subjects and must have experience in implementing and managing large database and data warehouse systems preferably in the financial market; must have knowledge of data warehouse systems including data mining, data extraction, data modelling, data transformation, data marts, database administration, data integrity, security and business intelligence; must also have the ability to work with entities external to the Bangladesh Bank such as commercial banks and financial institutions, extensive IT project management experience and planning skills and working knowledge of IT audit requirements for automated systems. The applicant must have at least ten years experience (including experience in senior management position) in the field of IT and data warehouse systems implementation, management and support.

The Bangladesh Bank now invites eligible individual specialist to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested specialists must provide information to substantiate that they are qualified to perform the services (description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills etc).

The specialist will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank borrowers, January 1997 (revised September 1997, January 1999 and May 2002).
