

Rival smugglers in Lalmonirhat clash: 5 injured

Five people were injured in a clash between two groups of smugglers at Kumar Tari village in Mogholhat border area yesterday.

The injured are Rashed Miah, 32, Rouf, 26, Jamal, 35, Makbul, 30, and Rashidul Islam, 33, all residents of Mogholhat under Sadar upazila. The injured were treated at local clinics.

Locals said, the clash ensued between Rashed and Jamal groups when some members of Jamal group attacked Rashed's men.

They further said Rashed group had been controlling smuggling at Kumartari border village since long. The Jamal group wanted to oust Rashed group and take control of smuggling in the area.

Construction of perimeter wall stops for fund crisis

the arrangements did not change.

As cracks were found in the round perimeter wall in 1998, it was marked as 'unfit' for protection.

To ensure security of the jail, authorities decided to construct a 1,382-feet long and 16-feet high perimeter wall around the previous one.

But after construction of only 600 feet (on south-east, south and south-west sides) of the new perimeter wall at a cost of around Tk 33 lakh in fiscal year 2006-2007, the work has remained suspended for want of fund.

The jail with capacity for 200 inmates sometimes has to accommodate more than double people including convicts, accused and under-trial detainees, jail

sources said.

"Cracks have developed in the perimeter wall of Kurigram Jail. It has also become slanted at places. Thirteen militants including JMB leader Motin Mehedi and mutiny-accused 34 BDR men are now in this jail. Considering security matters, extra police forces have been deployed. The remaining work for constructing the new wall should be completed shortly," said Jailer-in-Charge Md Al Amin.

An estimate letter was sent to the chief engineer of Rajshahi Division for completing construction of the remaining portion of the perimeter wall of Kurigram district jail, said Md Asaduzzaman, sub-assistant engineer of PWD.



Robbers kill one, mob kills robber in two incidents

One person was killed and three others were injured as robbers opened fire on the villagers in Rajnagar upazila under Moulvibazar district yesterday while a robber was killed and another injured in mob beating in Narshingdi town the same day.

In Moulvibazar, a gang of robbers entered the house of Wathir Ali, an expatriate in a Middle East country at Gondageshugul village under Rajnagar upazila early yesterday. Hearing screams of Wathir's family members, neighbours rushed to the spot and cordoned off the house, reports our correspondent.

In the face of resistance, the gang opened fire, killing a villager named Dudu Miah, 35, on the spot and injuring three others--Nanu Miah, 35, Shahru Miah, 18, and Hannan Miah, 27. They are undergoing treatment at upazila health complex.

Villagers, however, caught one of the gang, Jamal Miah, of Haldigul village and handed him over to the police, while the others managed to flee.

Following a case filed by Wathir Ali with Rajnagar Police Station, the law enforcers yesterday arrested two other members of the

gang-- Kajol Miah, 30 of Haldigul village and Sanjoy Dutta Chayon, 30, of Lalapur village under the upazila.

In Narsingdi, a robber was beaten to death and another injured by a mob in Bhagdi area of the district town early yesterday, according to UNB.

The deceased was identified as Hasibul Hasan Shanto, 20, son of Insan of Nilphamari district. The injured, Aziz, 22, son of Alkas of Sherpur district, was admitted to Sadar Hospital.

Police said Hasibul along with his eight accomplices entered the house of shoe trader Yusuf in Dutta Para area at around 2:30am and looted Tk 60,000 in cash, gold ornaments, mobile phone sets and one television set from the house.

In the morning, Hasibul and Aziz went to a shop in the district town to sell the looted goods. But the shop owner on suspicion informed the local people.

On information, locals rushed to the shop and caught the two. They beat them up, leaving Hasibul dead on the spot and injuring Aziz seriously.

Police rushed to the spot and recovered the body. They rescued injured Aziz and sent him to the hospital.

HSTU students block road, damage buses

Students of Haji Mohammad Danesh University of Science and Technology (HSTU) on Sunday put up barricade on Dinajpur-Panchagarh highway and vandalised buses protesting beating up of three fellows by the transport workers.

Sources said, the three students of the university came to the campus by a bus from Sayedpur at about 4:00pm. At one stage, conductor of the bus picked up a quarrel with the students over bus fair.

Later, they beat up the three students taking them to a nearby bus terminal.

As the news spread on the campus, the angry students of the university barricaded the highway for two hours from 7:00pm. They also damaged three running buses.

Work resumes at Sunamganj quarry as strike called off

Collection of sand and stones resumed in Fazilpur quarry under bordering Tahirpur upazila of Sunamganj district yesterday after 10 days of strike enforced by sand and stone traders in protest against extortion.

Leaders of the traders' organisations decided to withdraw their strike after Sunamganj deputy commissioner on Sunday evening assured them of taking action against illegal toll collectors.

Tahirpur upazila nirbahi officer and two executive magistrates along with a team of police and BDR members on speedboats went to the area to monitor the situation.

Steps are being taken to collect government revenue properly and stop illegal toll collection, said the officials.

Movement of all kinds of boats also remained suspended since October 3 as Fazilpur Sand and Stone Traders Association, Rakti Nodi Nou Paribahan

Samity, Jadukata Nodi Barki Sramik Kalyan Samity and Durlobpur Bali-Pathor Byabosayee Sangstha enforced the strike in protest against illegal toll collection by some organised groups.

The groups, involved in illegal toll collection at five points, claimed themselves as men of two ruling party lawmakers, said several traders.

About 30 thousand labourers went jobless as extraction of sand and stone from the huge quarries remained suspended while no boat plied on the 23-kilometre long river due to the strike.

Earlier on October 3, traders and labourers formed a human chain and held a protest rally protesting the indiscriminate extortion.

They also gathered in front of Sunamganj deputy commissioner's office and handed over a memo to him on October 6.

At a protest rally on Friday, leaders of the traders' organisations demanded immediate withdrawal of a 'false' case filed against them.
