



Remembering Camellia Parvin

Painter Camellia Parvin's first death anniversary was observed on October 19. Born and raised in Rangpur, she was a student of Oriental Department, Faculty of Fine Arts, University of Dhaka. She completed her BFA and MFA from the institute. Parvin could also sing very well. She married noted cartoonist Shishir Bhattacharjee in 1990. The artist passed away last year at the age of 43.

On the occasion of her first death anniversary, a discussion programme and art exhibition was held at Gallery Chitrak, Dhanmondi. Parvin's teachers, relatives, friends and well-wishers were present at the programme.

each other for 7/8 years. Her simplicity and generosity made the relationship deeper over the years. We have not only lost a gifted painter, but also a genuinely caring human being."

After the programme, the late artist's daughter Srabonti along with her father, Shishir Bhattacharjee, invited the guests to the gallery where an exhibition featuring Parvin's paintings was on.

As an oriental painter, Camellia Parvin had delved deep into human relationships, emotions and romanticism. Her works are lively and take the viewers to a dreamy world. Feminine subjects often got focus in the artist's works.

The fourth such programme was held at Shaheed Zia Auditorium, National Museum, Shahbagh, Dhaka under the banner of 'Share with Innocence IV', organised by the students' association HANS. There is a general belief that autistic children are mentally retarded; in actual fact they are intelligent and require special care to

ensure their development, conveyed the speakers, calling for a mass campaign to ensure the rights of such children.

Students from SWID Bangladesh (Ramma Branch), Autism Welfare Foundation, Beautiful Mind, Caring Glory, Kalyani, School for Gifted Children and Society for the Welfare of Autistic Children rendered songs, performed dance and staged recitation at the cultural programme attended by the parents of autistic children and teachers of the specialised schools. The gifted children revealed their amazing talents, as for
