

Two more arrested for alleged links to Bithar murder

Police arrested two people in connection with Khulna City Corporation (KCC) ward councillor Shahid Iqbal Bithar murder at a house in Natore town at midnight on Monday. The arrestees, Ferdous Hossain Hiru and Rajiv alias Tony, are on the criminal list of the Special Branch of Khulna Metropolitan Police. The law enforcers led by Sub-Inspector Tipu Sultan of the Detective Branch of KMP

raided Asha villa and arrested the two. Asha villa belongs to Havildar Noor Alam of Natore Railway Police station. Ferdous and Rajiv had been staying there since murder of Bithar. Bithar, also a leader of Jubo League central committee, was gunned down on the night of July 11 at Musalmanpara under Khulna Sadar Police Station. With the two, the total number of people arrested in connection with Bithar murder

now stands at 16. According to AC (DB) Abu Sayem of KMP, Ferdous and Rajiv were arrested following a confessional statement given by Buruj during interrogation on remand. Apart from their involvement in Bithar murder, Ferdous and Rajiv were also wanted in advocate Manjurul Imam and Journalists Manik Saha and Humayun Kabir Balu murder cases. They were also wanted in havildar Akram Hossain murder case filed with Sonadanga Police Station in 2002.

Bajitpur, Nikli observe hartal

One wants to be district, the other opposes inclusion in Bhairab while protests continue in Katiadi

People of Bajitpur upazila yesterday observed a half-day hartal to press their demand for upgrading the upazila to a district while Nikli people observed a day-long hartal protesting inclusion of the upazila in the proposed Bhairab district. In Bajitpur, shopkeepers kept their shutters down, educational institutions were closed and attendance at banks and government offices was thin during the hartal called by Zilla Bastabayan Parishad. Vehicles were off the roads and bus services from upazila headquarters to other parts of the country remained halted for six hours from 6:00am to 2:00pm. People from all walks of life gathered at the upazila headquarters in the morning and took out a procession. They later joined a rally at Bajitpur rail station with Upazila Chairman and Convener of Zilla Bastabayan Parishad advocate Sheikh AKM Nurunnabi in the chair. The speaker urged the government to declare Bajitpur a district. Otherwise, they threatened to launch a tougher agitation programme. People of Nikli upazila observed a day-long hartal yesterday protesting inclusion of their upazila in the proposed Bhairab district.

Shops and educational institutions, banks, insurance and government offices remained closed during the hartal. Hundreds of people from all unions assembled at Nikli upazila headquarters and held a protest rally in front of upazila parishad office with Upazila Chairman Md Iqbal Hossain in the chair. Upazila AL President Md Ishakh Bhuiyan, General Secretary Saiful Islam, upazila

BNP President Matiur Rahman, Upazila Parishad Vice-Chairman Hafiza Khatun and UP Chairman Burhan Uddin addressed the rally. Meanwhile, hundreds of people of Sarachar and Manikkhali under Katiadi upazila yesterday staged a demonstration at Sarachar and Manikkhali rail stations protesting inclusion of Katiadi upazila in the proposed Bhairab district. The agitating people put up

barricades on rail tracks, disrupting train services. Kishoreganj-bound inter-city Egarosindur express train, Bhairab bound Isha kha train and Chittagong-bound mail train remained stranded at the stations for around three hours, causing sufferings to the passengers. A protest rally was also held at Katidadi bus stand yesterday with Katiadi Poursava Mayor Tofazzal Hossain Khan Dilip in the chair.

Four get life in Tangail for Jewel murder

A court here on Monday sentenced four people to life term imprisonment in sensational Tangail terror Jewel murder case. Judge ATM Mesbaudoula of special sessions judge court delivered the verdict in a crowded courtroom. He also fined the convicts Tk 10,000 each, in default, to suffer six months more in jail. The convicts are Tota Miah and Nannu Miah of Kakanata village in Dhanbari upazila and Mozammel Hossain and Motalab Miah of Bhadurir Char village in Gopalpur upazila in the district. The court, however, acquitted four other accused as the allegations brought against them were not proved. They are Mokhesur Rahman, Mona Miah, Safiqul Islam and Mohammad Hossain. According to the case, centering enmity over control of a fish farm, the convicts murdered Jewel, then a top terror on police list in Tangail, at Balibhadra village in Dhanbari upazila on August 4, 1999. Victim's elder brother Saker Hossain filed a murder case with Dhanbari police station accusing eight people a day after the killing.

Three BM College students jailed for abduction

A Barisal court on Monday sentenced three students of Government BM College to two years rigorous imprisonment (RI) in an abduction case. The convicts are Swapan Kumar Debnath, 22, Sajib Kazi, 23 and Biplob Sarder, 25. They were tried in absentia. First Additional District and Sessions Judge Siddikul Arefin Chowdhury pronounced the judgment and fined the convicts Tk 1,000 each, in default, they are to suffer another month in jail. According to prosecution, the students abducted their classmate Aji Roy from Kalbil village under Ujirpur upazila of Barisal for a ransom of Tk 50 thousand on April 21, 2006 while he was going to college. They took Aji to different places in Barisal city and tortured him. Police raided different areas in the city and rescued Aji from Nupur Hotel in front of Kotwali Police Station the same day. Aji filed a case with Kotwali Police Station against Swapan and three of his accomplices the following day. After investigation, Sub-Inspector (SI) Swapan Kumar

Jhenidah recalls great martyr Hamidur today

The 38th death anniversary of Birshreshtha Hamidur Rahman will be observed today at the memorial complex built in honour of the great martyr of Liberation War. Teachers of Hamidur Rahman Degree College and staff of Birshreshtha Sipahi Hamidur Rahman Smriti Jadugar O Pathagar at Hamidnagar have made all preparations to observe the day in a befitting manner. The programmes beginning with placing of wreaths at his portrait at 11:30am will include Qurankhwani, milad mahfil, discussion meeting and feeding the destitute, said Amiruzzaman Shanti, convener of the observation committee. People from all walks of life will attend the programmes. Hamidur Rahman, while serving in the then East Bengal Regiment in 1971, joined the Liberation War. He embraced martyrdom during a fight with the Pakistani occupation forces on Dhali frontier in Sreemongal under Sylhet on October 28. In recognition to his bravery and sacrifice for freedom of the motherland, he was posthumously awarded the highest gallantry award Birshreshtha after the country's independence. Born in 1954 at Khordkhalishpur village in Moheshpur upazila of Jhenidah, Hamidur Rahman was the second among his brothers and sisters. The village has been renamed Hamidnagar and Birshreshtha Sipahi Hamidur Rahman Smriti Jadugar O Pathagar was established there in 2007 to keep memory of the great hero alive in the mind of the future generation. The government should take proper initiative to observe death anniversary of the great hero, said Hamidur Rahman's younger brother Fazlur Rahman.

Patient's death due to alleged neglect sparks protest

A patient died at Khagrachhari Adhunik Sadar Hospital yesterday allegedly due to wrong treatment by the doctor and negligence of nurse. Mohammad Siraj Mia, 27, son of Tota Mia of Maidda Nagar under Panchhari upazila in Khagrachhari district, was admitted to the hospital at 3:15am yesterday as he had been suffering from malaria for the last few days, said the patients' relatives. The on-duty doctor gave him oxygen support as he had breathing problem. As the oxygen line opened accidentally at about 4:00am, the patient's relatives went to nurse Anita Chakma but she did not come to help, said the patient's relatives. As the patient's condition deteriorated, an injection prescribed by Resident Medical Officer (RMO) Dr BK Tripura was pushed to his body at around 9:00am and he died five minutes later, said the patient's relatives and a few patients of the nearby beds. Nurse Anita Chakma and hospital guard Swapon man-

handled Siraj Mia's father-in-law Mohammad Safiqul Islam and wife Mukta when they protested the 'wrong treatment and negligence', they said. Hearing the news, about 50 relatives of the deceased patient gathered in the hospital, chanted slogans demanding punishment to the responsible doctor and other staff. Asked about the matter, RMO Dr BK Tripura denied the allegation of wrong treatment and negligence and said the patient had died of 'respiratory failure'. Asked by journalists to show the prescription given by him, Dr Tripura said the patient's relatives had torn it. He, however, said he has served a show cause notice on nurse Anita Chakma for her 'misbehaviour' with patient's relatives. Civil Surgeon Dr Abu Taher told the reporters that he formed a three-member inquiry committee headed by Dr Sanjib Tripura. Two other members are Senior Health Education Officer Mamong Marma and Senior Nurse Kanon Barua. "I shall take stern action if the doctor and nurse are found guilty," he said.

Student's body exhumed 70 days after burial

Police on Tuesday exhumed the body of a female student of Independent University of Dhaka for a second autopsy 70 days after she was buried at Hatimkhan graveyard in Rajshahi. Sub-Inspector Shahidul Islam of Tejgaon Police Station with the help of Boalia police exhumed the body of Faria Fahruj Badhon, 21, in presence of Magistrate Zahid Hossain Siddique at 12:30pm. The body was sent to Rajshahi Medical College

Hospital for a second post-mortem examination, said Shahidul Islam, also the investigation officer (IO) of the case. Badhon died in Dhaka on August 16 and was buried in Rajshahi after autopsy at Dhaka Medical College Hospital. The first autopsy report said Badhon died from hanging and police later submitted the final report, terming it a suicide. Badhon's mother Shamima Yasmin challenged the final report in a Dhaka court that passed the ordered for a second autopsy.
