## Transfer order of principal sparks protest

Students of Rajshahi Government College enforced a wildcat strike on the campus yesterday demanding cancellation of the transfer order of Principal Dr Ali Reza Muhammad Abdul Mazid.

The students under the banner of Students' Movement Council (Chhatra-Chhatra Sangram Parishad) observed a token hunger strike from 8:00am to 1:00pm after putting the administrative building under lock and key.

They also locked the main gate of the college and barred the teachers, staff and students from entering different departments and holding classes and examinations.

Several students said Principal Abdul Mazid has created a congenial academic atmosphere on the campus and undertook different development activities during the 15 months of his tenure.

"We will go for indefinite strike if the transfer order is not cancelled immediately," said Md Badsha Alam, the first joint convener of the Students' Movement Council.

Alam, also joint convener of the college unit of Jatiya Chhatra Samaj, said they started protest programmes on October 25 when the principal received official order for transfer to Chapinawabganj Government College.

Dinajpur Education Board Chairman Dr Md Sanaullah has now been appointed as the principal of Rajshahi Government College.

"Student leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League, Chhatra Moitree and Jatiya Chhatra Samaj expressed solidarity with the strike as the students want Principal Abdul Mazid to continue here," said Aksaruzzaman, another joint convener of the council, and general secretary of Rajshahi City unit of Chhatra Moitree.

Standing near the agitating students on the campus, Dr Abdul Mazid told this correspondent, "Students are protesting spontaneously with withdrawal of my transfer. I was waiting for retirement within a year but a local Awami League leader who is favouring Sanaullah played role for the unexpected transfer only 15 months after my joining here."

"I renovated the college Shaheed Minar for the first time, introduced suitable meal at the female students hostel, freed the campus from smoking and grazing of domestic animals, and controlled movement of motorcycles and bicycles," he said.

Principal Mazid showed copies of recommendation letters sent to the education ministry by ruling grand alliance lawmakers Fazle Hossain Badsha and Omar Faruk Chowdhury for cancelling his transfer order.

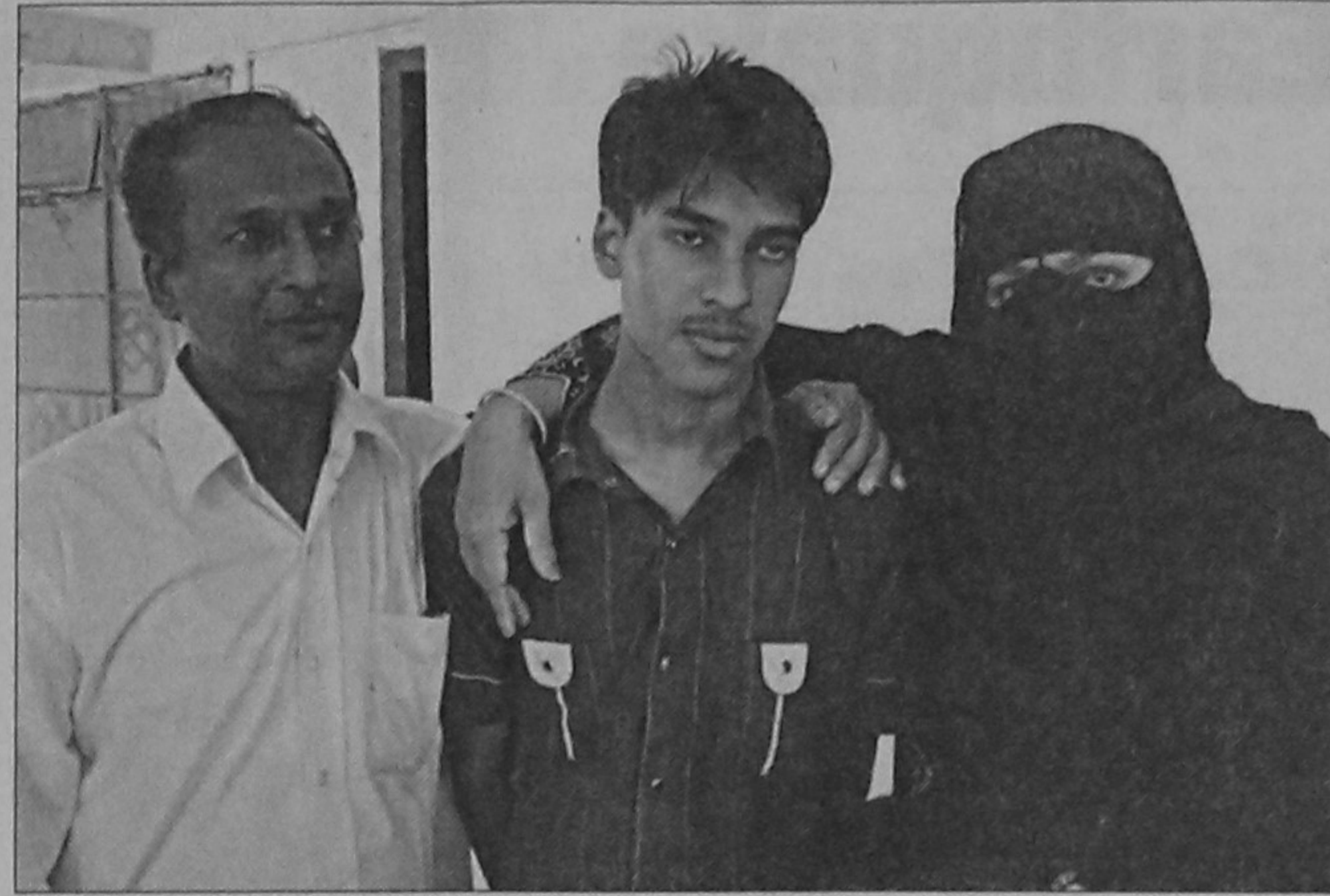

## Appoint hajj guides who know 'local' language

### Moulvibazar pilgrims demand

Hajj pilgrims here have demanded appointment of hajj guides who know the local language of the district. They also sent a letter to the religious affairs ministry requesting to replace the appointed guides.

Two hajj goers Ruhul Amin and Abdur Rahim Majumdar told this correspondent yesterday that the ministry recently appointed two persons- Abdul Latif Hawladar of Pirojpur district and Atiqur

Rahman of Faridpur district- as guides for the pilgrims of Moulvibazar district.

They came to the district on October 17 to attend a training programme on pilgrims from Moulvibazar.

Many pilgrims alleged that guide Abdul Latif is an elderly person and has old age ailments. He cannot talk properly because of age. On the other hand, guide Atiqur Rahman speaks in Faridpur's accent which is not understandable to Moulvibazar pilgrims.

Ruhul Amin and Abdur

Rahim said the Islamic Foundation had prepared a list of eight hajj guides for Moulvibazar on the basis of merit and experiences. Maolana Syed Muhi Uddin, Pesh Imam of Moulvibazar Dewani Mosque and Maolana Syed Shamsul Islam, Pesh Imam of Moulvibazar Court Mosque, secured first and second positions. But the Islamic Foundation finally appointed Abdul Latif Hawladar and Atiqur Rahman as guides for Moulvibazar pilgrims, they said.

## JSD-Inu splits in Magura

## Sad death of 2 principals

The principal of Saidpur Cantonment Public School and College in Nilphamari district died after falling from a four-storey under-construction building of the institution while the principal of Saidpur Adorsha Girls' School and College committed suicide on Friday.

Lt Col Moniruzzaman, 50, principal of Saidpur Cantonment Public School and College, slipped to the ground from the top floor of under-construction four-storey building 'Natan Kuri' when he was supervising its work at about 12:30am on Friday, said Saidpur Police Station Officer-in-Charge Ismail Hossain.

He was hurriedly taken to the Combined Military Hospital at Saidpur where the on-duty doctor declared him dead.

The principal's death cast a pall of gloom in the area as he was very popular with the students, teachers and guard-

ians for his outstanding success in making Saidpur Cantonment Public School and College as one of the best institutions in Rajshahi division.

An unnatural death case was registered with Saidpur Police Station the same day.

The principal of Saidpur Adorsha Girls' School and College, Touhafa Begum, 49, committed suicide by hanging herself with her scarf from the ceiling fan at her room on Friday morning.

Sources said she had disagreement with a few members of the managing committee of the institution as problem over some official papers could not be solved.

She was serving as the principal with good reputation from the beginning of the institution, locals said.

"Primary investigation shows it to be a suicide. An unnatural death case has been lodged with Saidpur Police Station in this connection," Saidpur Police Station Officer-in-Charge Ismail Hossain said.

At least 50 female students of Rangpur Carmichael College were food poisoned on Friday night.

The critically sick students were admitted to Rangpur Sadar Hospital. They are Nasima Begum, Elina Rahman, Munni Begum, Gulshan Ara, Roushan Ara Begum, and Ismat Jahan. Rest of the students were released after first aid.

The victims said they reside at Shaheed Jononi Jahanara Imam Hostel of Rangpur Carmichael College. The hostel authorities on Thursday night held a programme to observe the founding anniversary of the hostel and arranged a feast on the occasion.

After the dinner on Thursday, a huge quantity of food became excess. The left over food was served at launch on Friday, said Nasima Begum.

## Man gets life for killing wife, another for rape

A man was jailed for life in Bogra on Tuesday for killing wife while another was convicted in Gaibandha on Thursday for violating a teenage girl.

A court in Bogra on Tuesday jailed for life Meherul Islam, 31, son of Mokhesur Rahman Manik of Dakkhin Para village in Dhupchachia upazila for killing his wife in 2006, reports UNB.

The court also fined him Tk 25,000, in default, to suffer one year more RL.

According to the prosecution, Meherul used to press his wife Joyrab Khatun to involve in extra-marital affairs. As she turned down his proposal, Meherul started torturing her.

On the night of August 24, 2006, Meherul picked up a quarrel with Joyrab over the issue and at one stage murdered her at his rented house at Moddhyha Palsha in the town.

Our Correspondent in Gaibandha reports: One person was sentenced to life term imprisonment yesterday for violating a teenage girl in 2006. Judge Md Moniruzzaman of Gaibandha Woman and Child Repression Prevention Tribunal-1 also fined rapist Moku Mia of village Pachim Bashhati under Sundarganj upazila, Tk 10,000, in default, to suffer six months more in jail.

According to the prosecution, on May 27, 2006, Khadija Begum went to a relative's house leaving daughter Arifa Akhter Arshida, 14, alone in her home. Accused Moku Mia of the same village entered the house and violated Arifa.
