IFIC BANK

The bank has said it credited the stock dividend for the year 2008 to the respective shareholder's BOA Accounts on November 9, 2009.

ANWAR GALVANISING

The SEC has sought clarifications from the company and M/s. Rahman Mustafiz Haq & Co, statutory auditor of the company, regarding SEC's observations on the audited financial statements of the company for the year to June 30, 2009.

STANDARD BANK

The bank said its unaudited net profit stood at Tk 470.17 million with EPS at Tk 17.78 at the end of September 2009 from Tk 334.96 million and Tk 12.67 (restated) respectively a year ago.

POPULAR LIFE INSURANCE

The company said its board decided to increase the total fund size of 'Popular Life 1st Mutual Fund' from Tk 100 crore to Tk 120 crore.

EBLSTMF

The fund has reported net asset value (NAV) of Tk 10.75 per unit at market prices and Tk 10.64 at cost prices against face value of Tk 10.00 on the close of operation on November 5.

Oil prices recovered Monday, climbing back above 78 dollars after falling at the end of last week in reaction to a surge in US unemployment figures.

New York's light sweet crude for delivery in December jumped 1.04 dollars to 78.47 dollars a barrel.

Brent North Sea crude for December delivery gained 1.03 dollars to 76.90 dollars.

Both contracts closed lower Friday after data showed the US unemployment rate had jumped to 10.2 percent in October as 190,000 jobs were shed.
