

CORPORATE BRIEFS

PRIME INSURANCE The company has said its unaudited net profit in the third quarter to September 2009 stood at Tk 17.09 million with EPS at Tk 9.96.

DHAKA BANK The bank has said its unaudited net profit in the third quarter to September 30, 2009 increased to Tk 559.02 million with consolidated EPS Tk 26.27 from Tk 502.35 million and Tk 23.61 (restated) respectively in the same quarter a year ago.

JUTE SPINNERS The company has said its unaudited net profit in the first quarter to September 30, 2009 dipped to Tk 1.17 million with EPS at Tk 6.86 from Tk 1.43 million and Tk 8.40 in the same period a year earlier. Its accumulated loss stood at Tk 4.23 million on September 30, 2009.

NATIONAL TEA The company has said its unaudited net profit in the third quarter to September 30, 2009 rose to Tk 39.23 million and EPS at Tk 59.43 from Tk 28.95 million and Tk 43.87 respectively in the same period a year ago.

DULAMIA COTTON The company board has recommended 2 percent cash dividend for public shareholders other than sponsors for the year 2008-2009. Its AGM will be held at noon on December 26 at its factory premises at Dagonbhuyan in Feni.

MODERN DYING The company has said its unaudited net profit in the first quarter to September 30, 2009 stood at Tk 0.19 million with EPS at Tk 1.40.

World oil prices rose slightly on Wednesday as traders awaited the latest weekly snapshot of US energy inventories, analysts said. New York's main contract, light sweet crude for delivery in December, added 30 cents to 79.35 dollars a barrel.

Brent North Sea crude for December delivery gained 41 cents to 77.91 dollars per barrel in London trading. The US government's Department of Energy will later publish a report on American crude oil stockpiles for the week ending November 6.
