The Government of Bangladesh (GOB) is implementing "Services for Children at Risk" (SCAR) Project under the Disability and Children-At-Risk project with assistance from the World Bank. The project is being implemented by the Department of Social Services under the administrative guidance of the Ministry of Social Welfare. At the project level procurements are handled by the Department of Social Services.

The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA Credit No. 4481-BD) toward the cost of the SCAR project and intends to apply a portion of this credit to eligible payments under this contract.

The Director General, Department of Social Services, Agargaon, Dhaka now invites Expression of Interest (EOI) for providing services as Procurement Specialist to support the project implementation unit (PIU) for all procurement under SCAR.

Qualification and experience:

- The Procurement Specialist shall be Masters in Economics/Statistics/Finance/Business Administration or Bachelor in Engineering or other relevant subjects.
- At least 8 (eight) years of work experience as Public Procurement Specialist, experience in preparation of procurement plans, bidding documents, RFPs and evaluation reports. In depth knowledge of technical, commercial and legal aspects of procurement in development projects, financed by government and the World Bank would be essential.

The main tasks of the Procurement Specialist shall be to:

- (1) Procure goods and services of the project and sub-projects (if necessary) within the time framework of DPP following PPA-2006 and PPR-2008 and World Bank guidelines.
- (2) Preparing bidding documents, request for proposals, bid/proposal evaluation reports, etc.
- (3) Providing operational advice on concepts, policies and procedures for international and local procurements matter.
- (4) Providing assistance on procurement matters of the project.
- (5) Closely monitoring the procurement activities.
- (6) Working out training plan and liaising with other capacity building consultants.
- (7) Preparing quarterly procurement monitoring reports (PROCMOR) and other tasks as per the contract.
- (8) Responsible to Project Coordinator, PIU of the implementing agency.
- (9) Facilitate training for procurement related personnel of procurement procedure of PPA-2006 and PPR-2008 and World Bank guidelines.

Duration of the assignment:

Total duration of the assignment is estimated to be about one and half year.

Reporting:

The Procurement Specialist will work under guidance of Director General, Department of Social Services and National Project Director, SCAR Project.

Employed interested persons are advised to apply through proper channel.

The Procurement Specialists will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's guidelines, Selection and Employment of Consultants by the World Bank Borrowers and also in accordance with PPR-2008.
