All veterinarians should have a thorough knowledge of poultry diseases and an understanding of veterinary epidemiology, veterinary virology (especially AI) and vaccination, and the ability to communicate in English. 

Two bomb-like objects recovered at Chandpur

Police recovered two bomb-like objects from Kalibari Railway Station in Chandpur town yesterday morning.

Police cordoned off the railway station after recovering the devices at about 10:00am.

Panic gripped the district town following the incident ahead of verdict in Bangabandhu murder case.

Police picked up three people, including a beggar, for interrogation.

Chandpur police superintendent (SP) Krishna P Roy told journalists that two

bomb-like objects were recovered from a polythene bag kept under a bench in front of the ticket counter of the station.

The SP said, they are waiting for the army bomb experts to examine those today. He said, the bomb-like objects were put in a water-filled bucket for safety.

Quoting the beggar, officer in-charge (OC) of Chandpur model police station Abdul Kaiyim said, one Lengra Jalal put the polythene bag under the bench and left the place.

On information, station master Shafiqur Rahman informed police.

9 hurt as police, villagers clash in Habiganj

Nine people, including six policemen, were injured in a clash between police and villagers over snatching an accused from police at Mirnagar village in Madhabpur upazila Tuesday.

Witnesses said, villagers attacked on police and tried to snatch away one Masuk Mia when he was being taken to custody after arrest in a robbery case.

Later, a fierce clash ensued between the villagers and police that left six policemen and three villagers injured.

Sources said, the three


locals were injured as police fired nine shots.

The injured policemen are sub-inspector (SI) of Madhabpur police station Alamgir Hossain, assistant sub-inspector (ASI) Rashedul Alam Bhuiyan, constables Khaled Mahmud, Alauddin Al Azad, Monirul Islam and Hasan Mashud Parvez.

The injured were first admitted to the upazila health complex and later shifted to Sadar hospital.

Police later detained 38 people from the village in connection with the incident.
