The World Bank (hereby "The Bank") intends to finance the assignment/services described below under a Trust Fund managed by The Bank.

The Bank is attempting to initiate a different dimension towards public financial management reform, through widespread citizens' awareness of the issue. This would be carried out through the implementation of a communication campaign under a donor funded program called Strengthening Public Expenditure Management Program (SPEMP). The main objectives of the communication campaign are:

- Ensure that the importance of efficient and transparent public financial management for improved service delivery is better recognized by citizens
- Promote citizens' awareness of their right to know how their tax money is spent
- Ensure that SPEMP is widely recognized for its potential contribution to public resource management in Bangladesh.

Tasks of the selected firm

The assignment will develop an innovative and exciting communication strategy based on the draft strategy developed by the World Bank and implement the strategy to achieve the program objective. The consultant will conduct the assignment in 2 phases that does not necessarily be consecutive:

Phase 1: Fine tuning of communication strategy for SPEMP

Phase 2: Implementation for the communication strategy

- Identify and prioritize the outreach target audience groups and respective optimal communications mechanisms;
- Define precise performance indicators for the outreach effort
- Implement communication campaign
- Launch a general mass media campaign
- Evaluate the impact of communication campaign

The World Bank now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the above mentioned services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). The Expressions of Interest (EOIs) will be reviewed on the basis of the following to prepare a shortlist:
