

A six-day long (starting from December 5) exhibition of clay jewellery is now on in Tangail.

Artist Shahidul Islam of Savar has arranged the exhibition at Bindubashini Govt. Boys High School auditorium in the town. The display features 300 clay jewellery items, highlighting traditional and modern designs.

A keen audience, particularly women, thronged the venue to check out the necklaces, chains, earrings, bracelets, bangles as well as other items and showpieces.

Shahidul's designs are inspired by traditional Nakshi Katha, Mughal hand fans, motifs on the walls of Kantaji temple, Lokhi Shora of Manikganj, as well as local herbs, flowers and birds.

Shahidul has studied indigenous Bangladeshi, African and Australian designs. A

graduate from the Faculty of Fine Arts, Dhaka University, Shahidul has also done portraits of Mawla Bhasani, Preetilata Waddedar and other icons which occupy a pride of place at Jahangirnagar University.

Tangail Deputy Commissioner (DC) M Bazlu Karim Chowdhury inaugurated the exhibition. He lauded Shahidul for holding the exhibition, which highlights traditional designs.
