## EC to ask DCC for action

The Election Commission (EC) yesterday decided to ask Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) to take action against those who illegally pasted posters on walls in the capital, apparently launching campaign for DCC polls.

Many aspirants for the posts of DCC mayor and councillors pasted such posters greeting city dwellers on the eve of Eid-ul-Azha. The long due polls might be held in March-April next year.

The posters were not printed and published lawfully as those do not carry the names of printer, publisher and place of printing in violation of the Printing Presses and Publications (Declaration and Registration) Act, 1973, EC officials said.

Those who did all this committed a punishable offence, they mentioned.

The 1973 act provides that one may be punished with fine not exceeding Tk five thousand or with simple imprisonment for a term not

exceeding six months, or with both for violating it.

"We have decided to send a letter to Dhaka City Corporation mayor to take action against these unauthorised activities," Election Commissioner Brig Gen (retd) M Sakawat Hossain told journalists after an EC meeting that took the decision.

Talking to The Daily Star, a senior EC official said they would send the letter in a day or two. Copy of the letter would be sent to the home ministry.

## TV channels urged to use sign language in news

Speakers at a view exchange meeting yesterday called on the government and private television channels to introduce the use of sign language in prime

time news programmes for the hearing-impaired people.

The National Forum of Organisations Working with the Disabled (NFOWD) organised the meeting at the National Press Club in the city.

BTV has already started using sign language in its 5pm news, but it is not enough, said NFOWD President Khandakar Zahurul Alam.

Only one private TV channels using sign language in their news

programme, but the other private TV channels are not showing much interest in it, he added.

Representatives of different organisations urged the authorities concerned to take steps to ensure the use of sign language

on television in order to establish the right to know for the hearing-impaired people.

NFOWD Secretary General Zawaherul Islam Mamun and Director Dr Nafisur Rahman also spoke.

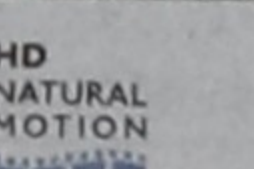
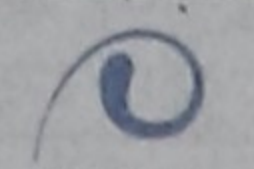
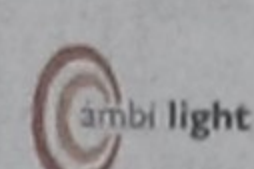
