On December 8 in 1971, several areas of the country including Moulvibazar, Brahmanbaria, Patuakhali and Chuadanga districts were freed from the Pakistani occupation forces.

Freedom fighters fought quite a few battles against Pakistan forces at different places of Moulvibazar district during the Liberation War.

In the battle at Dholoi Border outpost under Kamalganj upazila, Sipahi Hamidur Rahman sacrificed his life to save his fellow freedom fighters.

After the independence, Hamidur Rahman was awarded the country's highest gallantry award 'Birshrestha' along with six other war heroes.

On December 2, freedom fighters and Indian allied forces attacked the Pakistani Army base at Shamshernagar Airport, forcing the occupation army to retreat towards Moulvibazartown.

The final victory in the district was won on December 8 after a fierce battle at Baratila in which 127 men of Indian allied forces were killed.

However, people of Moulvibazar are unhappy as construction of the martyred freedom fighters' memorial near Monu Bridge in the town is yet to be complete.



Following the Pakistani army's crackdown on March 26 in 1971, the freedom fighters gave a good lesson to the invaders at Shamsher Nagar airport in Moulvibazar district. The Pakistani soldiers had to retreat to Sherpur.

In Sherpur, situated on the bank of Kushiara river, two platoons of the Pakistani army of the Punjab regiment made their base with machine guns, 3-inch mortars and Chinese rifles.



Kushtia Barta editor sued on libel charge

An assistant editor of a weekly, also a contractor, has filed a defamation case against editor, publisher and chairman of the editorial board of a daily newspaper in Kushtia.

Nurul Islam Chand, assistant editor of weekly Kushtia Barta, filed the case against Gazi Mahbub Rahman, editor and publisher of daily Ajker Alo, and Sufi Faruk, chairman of the editorial board of the

Nurul Islam Chand, also vice-president of Consumers Association of Bangladesh (CAB) Kushtia unit, filed the case with the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court here on Sunday.

In the case statement, December 25.

Chad alleged that the daily published three reports against him in its November 12, 13 and 25 issues. The reports were not based on facts and published only to tarnish his image, Chand said.

Chand further stated that he went to the newspaper office and requested Editor Gazi Mahbub Rahman and Chairman of the Editorial Board Sufi Faruk to publish rejoinders on the news items. "They turned down my request and threatened to publish more reports against me," he alleged.

The court asked the authorities concerned to investigate the matter and submit report within


