

Education of Dalits stressed to establish their rights

Speakers at a programme yesterday stressed the need for education to empower the Dalits and establish their rights with a view to creating a society free of discrimination.

Jatiya Dalit Sammiloni 2009, a get-together of the oppressed people of the society, was held yesterday on the occasion of World Dignity Day, which is a few days before World Human Rights Day.

Jointly organised by Bangladesh Dalit Forum and Action Aid Bangladesh in asso-

ciation with Bhumijo Foundation, Dharitri Foundation and Research and Development Collective (RDC), the programme was held at the Public Library in the city.

The Dalits are being deprived of their basic human rights for years after years, said Dhaka University Vice Chancellor Prof AAMS Arefin Siddique while inaugurating the two-day programme.

Education can change the mindset of the people and again it is education that can help the Dalits get recognition in the society, he added.

Speaking as the chief guest, Finance and Planning Minister AMA Muhith said a nation cannot attain development until its projects include every backward segment of people.

So, the Dalits, who constitute four percent of the total population, should get due attention, he added.

Country Director of ActionAid Bangladesh Farah Kabir declared that her organisation would provide scholarships for the Dalits studying in public universities from next year.

She also urged the private

organisations to help the Dalits regarding small entrepreneurship.

Jannat E Ferdousi, adviser to Bangladesh Dalit Forum, urged the government to formulate a law that would have a provision to hand punishment to the people who show discriminatory mentality and practice racism.

Kanailal Rabi Das, convener of Bangladesh Dalit Forum, Prof Mesbah Kamal, chief advisor to Bangladesh Dalit Forum, and Manzur Rashid, Theme Leader, Action Aid Bangladesh also spoke at the programme.
