Al-Qaeda denies killing civilians

Pakistan's Prime Minister Yousuf Raza Gilani said the army has finished its operation against the Taliban in the South Waziristan tribal region but may now pursue militants in another area along the Afghan border.

Gilani said yesterday that the army had driven the Taliban out of South Waziristan, a key battleground in the nation's fight against the Islamist insurgency and the government is discussing taking the battle to Orakzai tribal region.

Al-Qaeda denied on Saturday that it was behind a series of bombings in Pakistan that have killed hundreds of civilians, saying in a new English-language video that such attacks were un-Islamic.

US-born al-Qaeda operative Pakistan's military has Adam Gadahn, who commonly delivers the organization's English messages, said the extremist network was being framed by the US and Pakistani intelligence services for the bloodshed.

Blackwater denies covert help

CIA Director Leon Panetta has cancelled a contract with the former Blackwater security firm that allowed the company's operatives to load missiles on Predator drones in Pakistan.

Panetta cancelled the contract earlier this year and the work is being shifted to government personnel, a person familiar with the contract said Friday. The person spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss the classified program.

Blackwater is now known as Xe Services. A spokesman was not immediately available for comment on the contract cancellation. The New York Times first reported the contract's existence in August.

The CIA's Predator program targets senior al-Qaeda operatives and Taliban in Pakistan's tribal area along the border with Afghanistan, but the agency has never publicly confirmed its role in the operation.

Since Jan. 28, 2008, there have been at least 67 suspected US missile strikes into Pakistan, according to Pakistani intelligence officials and witnesses interviewed by The Associated Press after the contract came on the heels each strike.

There was a fresh strike Tuesday, according to Pakistani officials. The target of that attack was identified Friday by a U.S government official as Saleh al-Somali, a senior al-Qaeda operations planner.

US intelligence has concluded that al-Somali was responsible for the terror group's operations outside the Afghanistan-Pakistan region, reaching into activities in Africa, the official said, and is suspected of being involved in plotting attacks against the United States and Europe. The official spoke on condition of anonymity to discuss covert operations.



Jailed US man in Myanmar in 'poor health'

A jailed US citizen, on a protest hunger strike for more than a week in military-ruled Myanmar, was not able to appear in court because of poor health, his lawyers said yesterday.

Myanmar authorities have accused Myanmar-born Kyaw Zaw Lwin of entering Myanmar to stir up protests by Buddhist monks, who led pro-democracy demonstrations in 2007 that were bru-

tally suppressed by the junta. Arrested in September, he was charged with forgery and violating the foreign currency exchange act.

One of his lawyers, Kyi Win, said he was told by the judge that his client did not appear at a court session Friday because of "poor health." The session was adjourned for a week.
