

# Amend insulting provision in UP law 2009

Demand BUPF leaders

The central leaders of Bangladesh Union Parishad Forum (BUPF) at a meeting here yesterday demanded amendment to a provision in Union Parishad Law 2009, which they said was against the spirit of empowering the local government body.

The law contains the provision for suspending a union parishad chairman by the district administration if he or she (chairman) is sued by someone and the case is accepted by the court.

They said the UP chairmen are elected people's representatives and the provision in the law is insulting to the people's mandate, the BUPF leaders said.

They demanded that the government amend the provision immediately for strengthening union parishads. Otherwise, they threatened to challenge the provision in the court.

## UP chairman held for 'kidnapping' member

Police yesterday arrested Chairman of Charbaghdanga Union Parishad (UP) and two others from Puraton Bazar in the town on charge of kidnapping a UP member of the same union.

Police also rescued Altaf Hossain, from the house of an alleged kidnapper.

The arrestees are Joynal Abedin, 42, acting chairman of Charbaghdanga union, Hazrat Ali, 38, member of the same union and Aminul Islam Tipu, 44, of Shibtola in the town.

Ahsanul Haque, Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Sadar police

station said, all nine members of Charbaghdanga UP submitted applications on December 6 to the upazila nirbahi officer (UNO) bringing allegations of irregularities and corruption against the chairman in distributing vulnerable group feeding (VGF) rice allotted for November.

They also brought no-confidence motion against Joynal and the UNO office fixed date for hearing of the charges on December 13.

Sources said, the chairman somehow managed three members of the union including applicant Altaf Hossain and took undertaking from them that they would not back no-confidence move against him

during hearing at UNO office. But Altaf eventually fled to Godagari upazila of Rajshahi and took shelter at one of his relative's house.

The chairman went to Godagari and brought Altaf to Chapainawabganj town and confined him to a room at Shibtola so that he cannot join the hearing at the UNO office.

When Altaf's family members came to know it they informed police. Police raided Shibtola early yesterday and rescued Altaf from alleged kidnapper Aminul Islam's house.

Altaf Hossain later yesterday lodged a case against eight people including Joynal Abedin on charge of kidnapping him.

## Student strike at Ctg vet university continues

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and General Students Parishad continued class boycott at Chittagong Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (CVASU) for the second day yesterday.

They enforced indefinite class boycott on Saturday demanding immediate removal of Vice-Chancellor Dr Nitish Chandra Debnath for his alleged involvement in corruption and on some other demands.

Leaders and activists of BCL and the parishad took out a procession and then held a rally on the campus yesterday morning.

Addressing the rally, parishad convener Kamol Kanti Majumder accused the VC of indulging in corruption and nepotism in appointing teachers and employees and barring BCL from holding political programmes on campus.

"We have submitted a memorandum to President Zillur Rahman, also the chancellor of the university, through the district administration and sent copies of it to the education minister, fisheries and livestock minister and Chittagong City Corporation (CCC) mayor demanding resignation of the vice-chancellor," Kamol said.

He also told the rally that Mayor ABM Mohiuddin Chowdhury expressed solidarity with their demands.

They also pressed for reducing admission fees, appointing first class holders as teachers for the university, building a sheaheen minor on the campus, naming the male hall after Master Da Surya Sen and the female hall after Pritilata Waddedar, increasing internship allowance, introducing re-examination system, building a dormitory for the interns, publishing the results within 15 days after examinations and putting an end to corruption and nepotism.

When contacted, VC Nitish Chandra Debnath said, "They started class boycott without coming to me with any of their problems they now demand to solve."

## Armed robbers loot houses

Muslimnagar under Dakkhin Keraniganj police station early Saturday.

Police said, a gang numbering 12-14 stormed into the house at Alam, a contractor of the Roads and Highways Department, and looted the house on Saturday.

An armed gang took away valuables worth Tk 10 lakh from a London expatriate's house at Kuchai village in Dakkhin Surma upazila in Sylhet, according to UNB.

Police said, masked robbers, numbering 7-8, stormed into the house of Shoibor Rahman at about 2:30am and took the house inmates hostage at gunpoint.

Later, they decamped with the booties, including Tk 2 lakh in cash, 2,000 pound sterling, 20 tolas of gold ornaments, mobile phone sets and valuable clothes.

Nurnnesa Khanam, wife of Shoibor, filed a case with Dakkhin Surma police station.

Later, police detained Hossain Ahmed Rubel, 20, son of Atar Ali, Nazrul Islam, 30, son of Moyra Miah and Tuhin, 22, son of Ostar Ali of the village suspecting their involvement in the robbery.

Civil surgeon Dr Safar Raj Khan Chowdhury said, the robbers attacked the ambulance on the way to Lama Upazila Health Complex at around 5:30 am.

The gun-toting robbers forced the ambulance driver to stop the vehicle at Fashiakhali and looted Tk 7,000, a cell phone and a sucking machine used for clearing cough from throats of patients.

## Class boycott at BL College, clash at Rangpur medical

Students of Khulna BL college went on indefinite class boycott yesterday while 20 students were injured in a clash at Rangpur Medical College (RMC) on Saturday night.

Critically injured Pulok, Selim, Uzzal, Shuvo, Pabon, Tanvir and Sufian have been admitted to RMC on Sunday.

Students of Government BL University College yesterday started boycotting classes and all examinations for an indefinite period demanding registration of 62 students of the college, reports UNB.

Sources said, the clash started about 11:00 pm at Pinnu Hostel and continued till 1:00 am between Tamim and Sajib groups. It spread to two other hostels, they added.

The clashing activists damaged at least seven rooms of their rival groups at Pinnu, Mukta and Zia hostels of RMC.

Tamim alleged that Sajib along with outsiders attacked his supporters without any provocation while Sajib blamed Tamim and his men for the attack.

Contacted, RMC principal Dr Azizul Islam said, the clash followed misunderstanding between two groups of students. The situation is returning to normalcy, he added.
