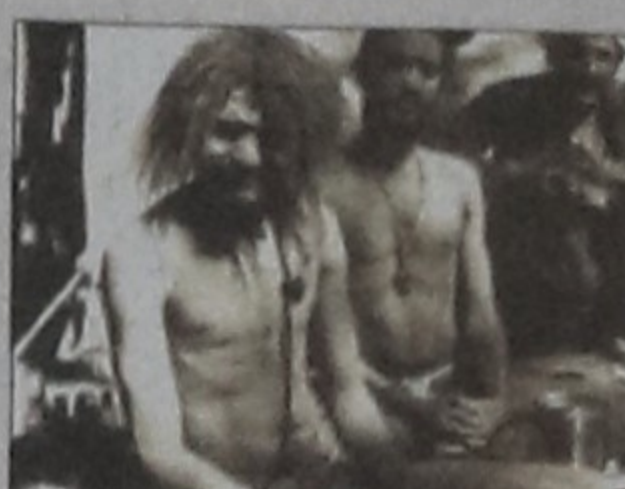

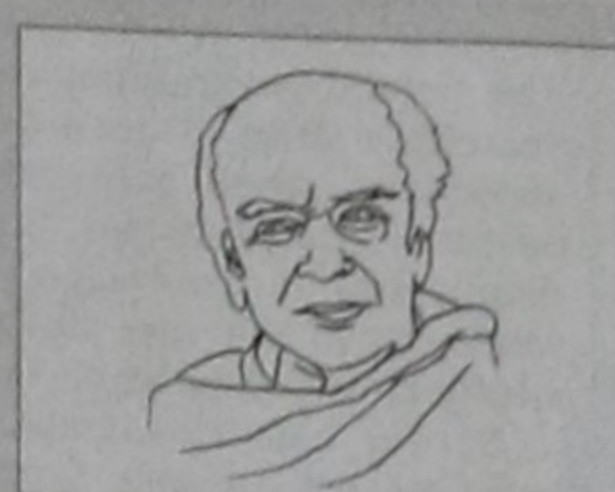

Pabna Victory Fair ends

Freedom Fighters honoured

A weeklong Victory Fair ended in Pabna recently. The speakers in one voice demanded the trial of the war criminals to honour the values and sacrifices of Liberation War. The fair included a discussion, cultural programmes and honouring of ten Freedom Fighters posthumously.

Lawmaker of Pabna-4 constituency Samsur Rahman Sharif Dilu chaired the concluding programme at Pabna Town Hall premises. Secretary of Sector Commanders' Forum (SCF) Lieutenant General M Harunur Rashid Bir Pratik was the chief guest.

Rashid said, "It is our duty to impart the authentic history of the Liberation War to the young. The younger generation are the future nation-builders so they should forge ahead with the spirit of the Liberation War."

Among the speakers were the lawmaker of Pabna-3 constituency Mohammad Makbul Hossain; SCF leader of Rajshahi Division, Mohammad Saidur Rahman;

former lawmaker Jannatul Ferdous; prominent educationalist and former principal of Pabna Government Bulbul College, Professor Mohammad Nurunnabi; President of Shammilito Shangkritik Jote, Pabna, Abdul Matin Khan and secretary of

the fair organising committee Proloy Chaki.

The ten valiant Freedom Fighters honoured posthumously were Principal Abdul Goni; Nurul Kader Khan (the Deputy Commissioner of Pabna during the Liberation War); martyred intellectual Dr. Fazle Rabbi; former MP Abdur Rob Boga Miah; martyred Advocate Aminuddin; Language Movement veteran and Freedom Fighter Aminul Islam Badsha; former MP Ahmed Rafique; Freedom Fighters Rafikul Islam Bakul and Iqbal Hossain and martyred school teacher Maulana Kasim Uddin.

Four other prominent Freedom Fighters were also accorded a reception: Advocate Golam Hasnayan, Advocate Amjad Hossain, Ranish Maitray and Wazi Uddin Khan.

Later the artistes of Awami Shilpi Goshthi and Rabindra Sangeet Shammilon Parishad, Pabna staged a cultural programme featuring music, dance, poetry recitation and more. Among the artistes, Phoolrenu Das, Abul Hashem, Shandipa and Habibullah led the cultural programme.

Memorial programme for Naib Uddin and Nowazesh Ahmed

Marking the deaths of Naib Uddin Ahmed, a pioneering photographer of the country and his brother Dr. Nowazesh Ahmed, a scientist, researcher, photographer and a naturalist, a memorial programme was held at the training gallery of Alok Chitra Shilpi Sangsad (Ashis) here on December 19 evening. Ashis organised the meeting. The late Naib Uddin was the founder president of Ashis.

Naib Uddin died of old age ailments at the Comfort Hospital in Dhaka on December 14 at the age of 90. He left behind three sons,

relatives, friends, colleagues and well wishers.

Ashis president Md. Nawab Ali chaired the meeting. It was addressed among others by former Vice-Chancellor of Bangladesh Agricultural University (BAU) Dr. Shah Mohammad Faruq; Advocate Anisur Rahman; Prof. Lutfur Rahman Khan and Advocate Wazidul Islam.

The former Chief Photographer of BAU, Naib Uddin Ahmed worked here from 1961 to 1993 and during the Liberation War he shot many photographs that became rare documents of our national history, said the speakers. Both Naib Uddin

Ahmed and Dr. Nowazesh Ahmed earned national and international recognition for their excellence, they added.

Later a short film titled "Nakkhatra" on the life of Naib Uddin was screened. The exhibition of photos by the

master photographer drew an enthusiastic audience.

BAU Vice-Chancellor Dr. M.A. Sattar Mandal, condoled the death of

Naibuddin Ahmed and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul.

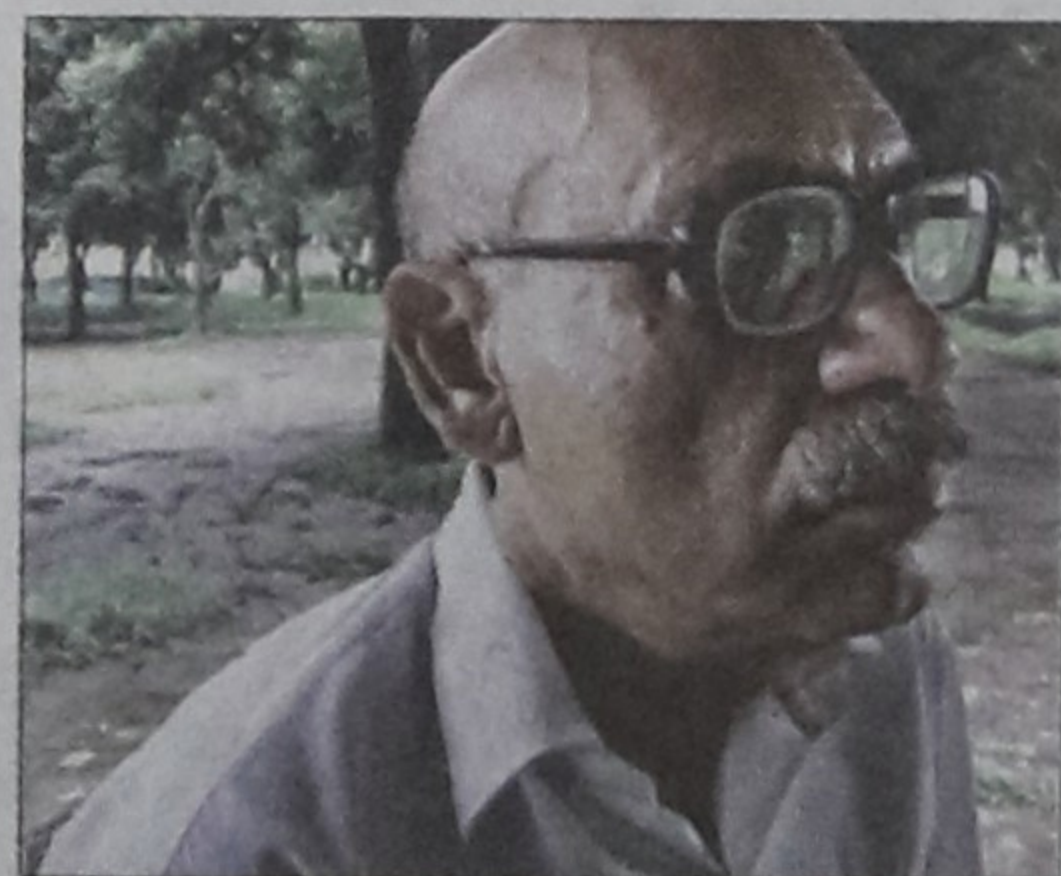
