

Man kills his 2 kids, hurts mother, wife

A man hacked to death his two children and injured his mother and wife critically at Matiabandha village in Madhyanagar upazila of Sunamganj district Monday evening.

The victims were identified as Ershadul, 4, and Saleha, 6, children of Abdus Salam of the village.

Locals said, Abdus Salam, 35, chopped his family members with a sharp weapon leaving his son and daughter killed on the spot and

injuring his wife and mother.

His mother Suna Bhanu, 70, and his wife Ramesha, 30, were rushed to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital in a critical condition.

As neighbours rushed to the scene, Salam shouted and told them that he had killed his son and daughter. Locals caught Salam and informed police about the brutal killing.

Police arrested Salam but could not say anything about the reason behind the killing.

Four more Bogra Shibir activists arrested

Police yesterday arrested four more activists of Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) in connection with Sunday's violent clashes at Government Azizul Haque University College.

Police said, they raided different areas at night and rounded up Mizanur Rahman, 22, from Jaminagar and Rizvi, 17.

Zahurul Islam, 17, and Hamidul Islam, 20, all students of Shah Sultan College, from Latipur Colony.

They were shown arrested in the case filed against them on charge of campus violence, they added.

Police said, during the raid they picked up five people including one Ariful Islam, 25. But Arif was later released.

Earlier on Sunday night, two Shibir men - Ismail Hossain, 24, and Anwarul Islam, 22, were picked up from Shahid Akhtar Ali Moon Hall soon after filing of the case.

At least 18 students were injured as the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League and Islami Chhatra Shibir locked in a violent clash at the college on Sunday.

BCL on Sunday night filed a case against 150 Shibir members in connection with the clash that led to indefinite closure of the college.

Concern at Ctg vet university situation

Agitating Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and General Students' Forum and Teachers' Association of Chittagong Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (CVASU) on Monday held separate press conferences on the present campus situation involving the vice-chancellor of the university.

The association leaders at the conference at Chittagong Press Club (CPC) at around 4:30pm expressed deep concern and resentment over round-the-clock sit-in programme by students at the entrance to the residential area of teachers, officials and employees of the university.

They alleged that a few number of students under the banner of BCL and general students' enforced indefinite agitation programme from December 13 to create chaos on the campus and apart from keeping the vice-chancellor (VC) confined to his residence they were harassing the other teachers and officials in different ways.

The teachers also alleged that the agitating students took away the keys of the gates of all buildings of the university leaving its properties unsafe.

They urged the ministers concerned, local lawmakers and Chittagong city mayor to help resume the academic activities of the university.

Teachers' Association Convener Prof Goutam Das read out the written statement at the conference where other leaders were also present.

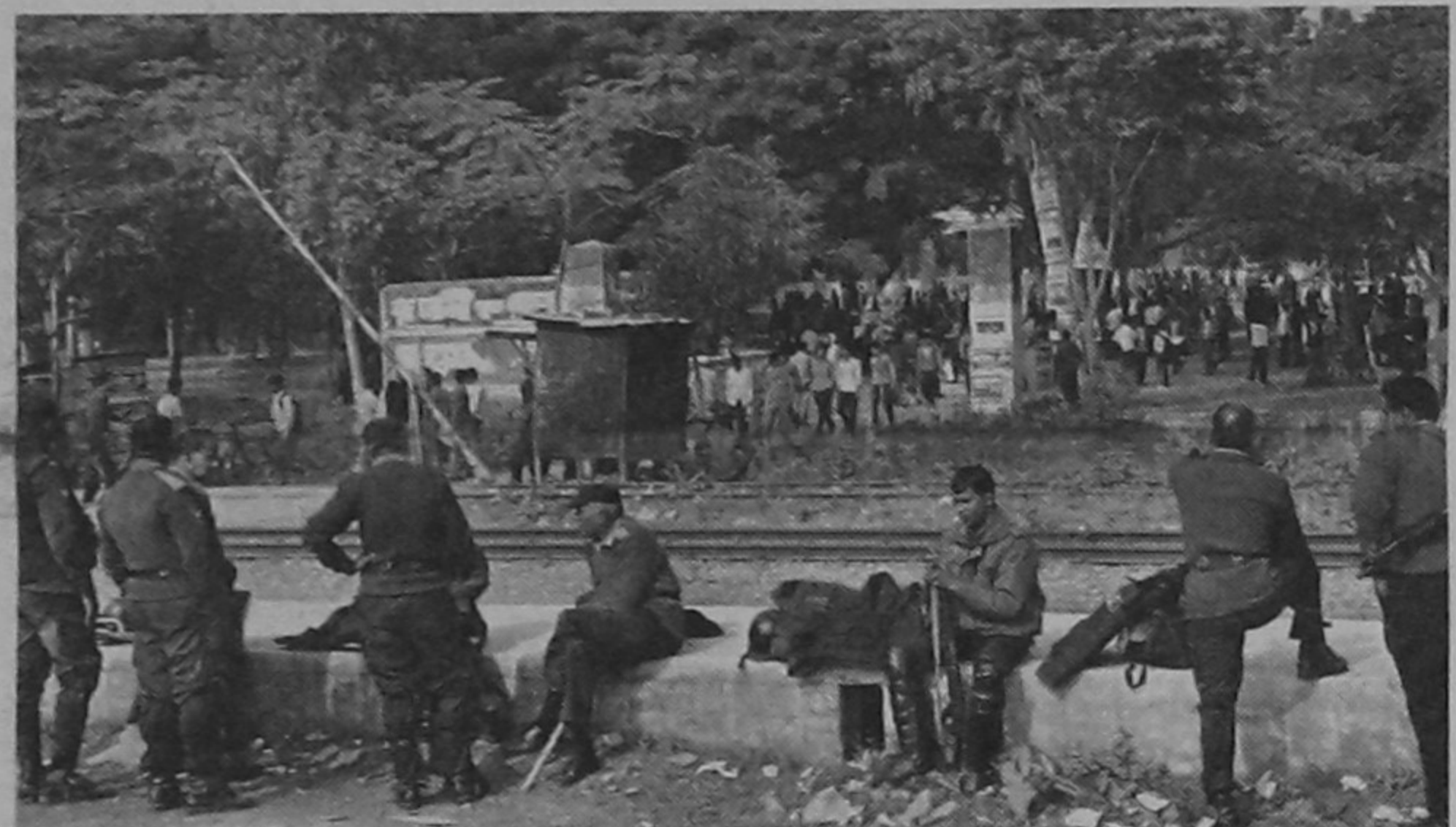
At one stage of the conference, Basic and Social Science Faculty Head Prof Shahnaaj Sultana opposed the statements of the Teachers' Association leaders and branded them as VC's loyalists.

She accused the VC of indulging in corruption and nepotism in appointing teachers and employees of the university and urged all to save the university.

The agitating BCL and Students' Forum held its press conference at the same venue at 12:30pm and reiterated the demand for removal of the VC for his alleged involvement in corruption.

The forum leaders said their agitation will continue until the VC is removed. The forum's Convener Kamol Kanti Majumder read out the written statement at the conference.

BCL and General Students' Forum enforced indefinite strike at CVASU from December 13 to press home their several demands including removal of the VC. On the following day, the authorities closed the university for an indefinite period and postponed the admission test scheduled for December 24.

Rival BNP men foil party programme, lock in clash

BNP-JCD clash injures 15

Ten BNP men were injured in a factional clash in Mymensingh yesterday while 15 including a policeman hurt as BNP and JCD locked in a clash in Gaibandha on Sunday.

Our Correspondent in Mymensingh reports: At least 10 BNP activists were injured in a factional clash over holding an orientation programme for the BNP upazila and municipal units at Phulbaria upazila headquarters yesterday.

Following the clash, the orientation programme scheduled to be held at a community centre was postponed, police said.

According to police, former BNP lawmaker engineer Shamsuddin Ahmed organised an orientation meeting for the BNP upazila and municipal units at a local

community centre. But Phulbaria upazila parishad chairman Principal Anwar Hossain Badsha, also a district level BNP leader, called another meeting at the same venue at the same time.

When the meeting called by Shamsuddin was on, the supporters of Badsha allegedly pelted brick-bats at the venue triggering clashes between the two rival groups.

Police rushed to the spot, lobbed six teargas shells and charged batons to bring the situation under control. Ten injured in the clash were treated at local clinic.

Our Correspondent in Gaibandha reports: At least 15 people including a policeman were injured as the BNP and JCD activists in Palashbari upazila clashed on Sunday evening.

The clash followed a dispute over celebrating recent

election of Khaleda Zia and her eldest son Tarique Rahman as party chairperson and vice-chairman.

Police and witnesses said Palashbari BNP organised a rally to congratulate the two leaders but it was strongly opposed by a section of upazila JCD leaders and activists. Following altercation, the BNP and JCD men locked in chase and counter chase and exchanged brickbats.

Police rushed to the spot to bring the situation under control. Sub-inspector Mizanur Rahman sustained head injury during the brickbat.

At a stage, police resorted to baton charge to disperse the clashing groups. Besides the SI, 14 others were injured in the incident.

Police also picked up Anwarul Islam, president of Palashbari upazila JCD.
