Turning Bangladesh into most adaptive country big challenge

Transforming Bangladesh, now the most vulnerable to climate change, into the most adaptive country within the next 10 years is the biggest challenge ahead, speakers at an environ-

mental conference said yesterday. Terming the Copenhagen climate change summit a collective failure, they said still Bangladesh has opportunities to lead the vulnerable countries and building capacity is a must to do that.

The first plenary session of the 3rd National Environmental Conference of Bangladesh Paribesh Andolon (Bapa) was held at Osmani Memorial

Auditorium in the city. State Minister for Environment and Forest Hasan Mahmud presented a keynote speech at the conference on 'Climate Change, Copenhagen Conference and Future Tasks for Bangladesh'.

The protesters, reportedly supporters of JCD General Secretary Amirul Islam Alim, also burnt effigies of Tuku and Milon accusing them of forming the new committee by copying the signature of BNP Chairperson Khaleda Zia.

The 171-member central committee of the organisation was declared on Thursday night.

A good number of posts in the new committee have been distributed in exchange of money to leaders who are married and involved in services and business and are no more students, alleged the aggrieved leaders.

They also vowed to prevent Tuku and his followers from entering Dhaka University campus and demanded expulsion of Tuku and punishment to Milon.

A number of dedicated leaders of the organisation have been deprived of posts in the committee following conspiracy by Tuku and Milon, they added.

Earlier on Saturday, supporters of Alim beat up three CD leaders, who are loyal to Tuku, and chased Alim's men out of the campus.




