

# WEALTH THRU' ILLEGAL MEANS ACC files 16 cases in Dec

Anti-Corruption Commission (ACC) filed 16 cases and also submitted 80 charge sheets in December last year against 179 people on charges of amassing wealth beyond their known sources of income, misappropriation of money and deceit or counterfeiting.

releasing a total of 42 people. Those who were exempted from the charges in the report include former state minister AKM Faizul Haque as he died, ex-lawmaker Shahiduzzaman and former chairman of Proshika Dr Qazi Faruque Ahmed, says a press release yesterday.

The cases filed were against 32 people, including former Khulna mayor Sheikh Tayebur Rahman and Managing

Director of Jamuna Fertiliser Company Ltd Enayet Ali.

In the charge sheet, the anti-graft body accused 147 people, including government officials. The accused include former executive engineer of Water Development Board AKM Ali Azam, ex-lawmaker Shahjahan and owner of National Development Corporation Khandker Abul Bashar.

# UZ to be made functional in three months

Ashraf tells British counterpart

BSS, Dhaka

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Syed Ashraf Islam yesterday said the upazila (UZ) system would be made functional within March, insisting his visiting British counterpart that Bangladesh is moving towards a stronger local government system than any time before.

"It is now crystal clear to people that an uninterrupted democracy is the root for the country's development. And this development must be initiated from local levels," Ashraf told John Denham, British secretary of state for communities and local government, at a local hotel.

Denham is now on a two-day visit to Bangladesh.

State Minister for LGRD and Cooperatives Jahangir Kabir Nanak, Local Government Secretary Manzoor Hossain and British High Commissioner to Bangladesh Stephen Evans were also present.

Ashraf said the government has taken a number of steps to strengthen the local government system and has already made a balance of power between members of parliament (MPs) and upazila chairmen.

Steps have also been taken to make a fair distribution of power between the lawmakers and upazila parishad, he added.

The government, the minister said, wants to give the local government bodies more and more power and auton-

The inquiry committee, formed to investigate illegal recruitment of 1,105 staffs and other irregularities in National University (NU) during the tenure of the BNP-led alliance government, submitted its report to the vice chancellor (VC) yesterday.

Prof Abu Sayed Khan, convener of the committee and also pro-VC, handed over

the report to VC Prof Quazi Shahidullah.

The committee sources said the report will be placed to the syndicate and the syndicate will decide the next course of action.

The report will also be submitted to the parliamentary standing committee on education ministry soon, they added.

advertisement during the tenure of the BNP-Jamaat government.
