



Rajshahi Theatre is holding a weeklong drama festival at Rajshahi Medical College auditorium to celebrate its silver jubilee.

The festival drew local theatre enthusiasts who crave quality shows.

"Visitors queuing up for shows is quite rare in this city," said Ahsan Kabir Liton, a cultural activist and senior member of Ritwik Film Society. He added that theatre is mostly Dhaka-centric but the audience in Rajshahi are just as keen on performing arts as in the capital.

### Mock court of "Bon Bibi"

A mock court of 'Bon Bibi' (locally known as the goddess of forests) was set up at Nil Dumur, an adjoining bazar to the Sundarbans in Shyamnagar upazila. This was held to bring rich nations to trial for their role in contributing to global warming which was destroying the Sundarbans' forests and making them vulnerable to the disastrous impact of climate change.

A cultural function was also held at the same venue to create awareness about the impact of climate change on agriculture, economy, geography and bio-diversity of Least Developed Countries (LDCs).

The trial began when the Judge Bon Bibi (Sajeda Khatun) took a seat, set up on the image of a Tiger in the court at noon.

As the proceedings began, the complainants Kawsar Ali Moral, Shefali Begum and Shahabuddin alleged that the forests were a source of livelihood for them until now but due to climate change the valuable resources had been destroyed and they could no longer earn their livelihood from them.

They alleged that due to climate change, storms and upsurge of water from the Bay hit the coastal belts, the flora and fauna of the forest, which were gradually being destroyed due to heavy salinity. Trees are dying in the forest and animals including tigers and

deer are facing acute scarcity of food and shelter, they alleged. They maintained that the rivers and canals in the forest were drying up due to heavy deposits of silt on the rivers and canals

bed due to the impact of climate change. They demanded punishment of the rich nations.

The court ordered rich nations to compensate the LDCs for the havoc wrought by their irresponsible attitudes to climate change and the environment.

Several hundred woodcutters, fishermen and honey collectors from nearby villages were present at the trial.

Among others Satkhira DC Abdus Samad, Shyamnagar Upazila Chairman and Vice-chairman Abdul Bari and Shilpi Rani Mridha respectively, UNO Dilip Kumar Banik were present.

Depart, an art quarterly, made its debut on January 3 at Dhaka Club. On the occasion of the launch of the journal, eminent Indian painter K.G. Subramanyan was present as chief guest while noted educationist Professor Zillur Rahman Siddiqui attended as special guest. Both addressed the significance of proper art criticism and its varied aspects.

The programe featured a performance conceived by visual artist Ronni Ahmmed. The performance was presented by Reetu A Sattar, a theatre activist.

Kazi Anisul Moquit is the publisher and chairman of the editorial board of Depart. Mustafa Zaman is the editor of the journal. The English journal publishes features by writers from Bangladesh. The colour publication is rather uncommon when it comes to size.

The first issue of the journal includes Rabindranath Tagore's "Man the Artist" (Tagore delivered the lecture in 1930 at Baroda). Syed Jamil Ahmed, a noted theatre personality and scholar, has written on Bengali folktales. Mustafa Zaman's "Quamrul's Frontier:

Inheritance and Modernity Remapped" touches many facets of Quamrul's works and life. Depart's first issue also includes an interview of Farhad Mazhar, a noted poet,

scholar and a leading member of the Nayakrishi Andolon. The interview highlights Mazhar's thoughts on Lalon and his philosophies. Other write-ups include reviews of art and

photography exhibitions that would surely help the readers be aware of the cultural activities in the city.




