

FIRE INCIDENTS IN PABNA, SYLHET

6 godowns, 20 shops gutted

A devastating fire gutted at least six jute godowns at Raipur village in Sujaganar upazila on Monday night.

The origin of fire could not be known till filing of this report.

Sources said, at least 1600 maunds of jute were damaged in the godown fire.

Being informed, fire fighters from Pabna fire station rushed to the spot and brought fire under control after several hours of hectic effort.

The devastating fire damaged goods worth Tk 50 lakh, the godown owners claimed.

In Sylhet, at least 20 shops were gutted in a fire at Kupar Bazar in Goainghat upazila early yesterday, reports UNB.

Sources said, the fire

originated at a shop at about 2:30am and soon raged through the adjoining shops. Reason behind the fire could not be known immediately. The shop owners claimed that the damage caused by the fire could go up to Tk 1 crore.

Locals said, fire-fighting units could not reach the remote spot because of inaccessibility.

Our Staff Correspondent in Khulna adds: A fire at the state-run Crescent Jute Mill (CJM) at Khalishpur in the city damaged waste product worth Tk 10 lakh.

The fire originated from electric short circuit, said the mill's project director Mujibar Rahman Mallick. Five fire fighting units doused the fire in three hours of hectic effort.

39 Rohingyas held in Cox's Bazar for intrusion

Police raided different places in Cox's Bazar town over the last two days and arrested 39 Rohingyas who entered the country illegally.

The law enforcers also recovered 30 rickshaws from the arrested Rohingyas and yesterday produced them in Cox's Bazar Judicial Magistrate's Court that sent them to jail.

Officer-in-Charge (OC) of Sadar Police Station Propid Das said several thousand Myanmar Rohingyas are staying in different parts of the town and getting involved in different professions.

They pull rickshaws and work in hotels and restaurants and also as day labourers, he said, adding that most of them are involved in criminal activities in the town.

The OC further said action will also be taken

against those who are sheltering the Rohingyas.

Police said three separate cases have been filed with Sadar Police Station against the arrested Rohingyas on charges of entering Bangladesh illegally.

POLICE ASSAULT CASE 17 acquitted of charges in Khagrachhari

Khagrachhari chief judicial magistrate's court yesterday acquitted all 17 including district Awami League secretary Zahidul Alam of charges of assault on police.

The other accused were Rafiqul Alam, Didarul Alam, Mujibur Rahman, Islam Uddin, Barun Karmakar, Sultan Ahmed, Abdus Sattar, Yusuf Mia, Muslim Uddin, Sattar Mia, Arun Karmakar, Kartik Dey, Monir Ahmed, Tayeb Ali, Sanjit Dhar, Nur Hossain Chowdhury.

Chief judicial magistrate Mohammad Ikhtiarul Islam Mollik pronounced the verdict. Twenty witnesses were cross-examined during the trial.

According to the case, the aforesaid people were sued on charge of attacking on-duty police with deadly weapons and injuring five policemen on March 31, 2001.

The then officer-in-charge of Khagrachhari Sadar police station G M Harun filed a case against the 17 on the same day.

20 injured as BCL, Shibir lock in clash in Sylhet

Twenty people including a teacher of Sylhet Agricultural University (SAU) were injured in a clash between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Islami Chhatra Shibir yesterday.

Of the injured, 10 were admitted to Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College and Hospital while others treated at the university medical centre.

The clash erupted as a BCL man was beaten up by Shibir activists following an argument on trifling matter at the dining hall in the morning.

Assistant professor Sultan Ahmed of department of microbiology also sustained injuries during brickbats.

The BCL activists forced the Shibir activists out of the campus at about 12:00 noon.

They then vandalised about 20 rooms in Saifur Rahman Hall and in another dormitory.
