#### Another BDR man dies

A member of Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) died at Jessore Combined Military Hospital early yesterday four days after he reportedly attempted to commit suicide by taking poison at Sainik Lines in Khulna.

With the death of Nayek M Rafique Miah, 42, the number of deaths of BDR members has risen to 67 since the BDR mutiny on February 25-26.

BDR Public Relations Officer Md Muhasin Reza said Rafique of Battalion-23 took poison on January 2 evening. He was soon rushed to Khulna Sector Sick Bay and then transferred to the CMH in Jessore where he died yester-

Rafique hailed from Tangail and was suffering from bipolar disorder, BDR officials said.

#### Moudud warns of movement

BNP leader Moudud Ahmed yesterday said his party would be forced to take to the streets if the prime minister compromises with India over gas and water issues.

Terming the Awami League government inefficient, he said that the AL has failed to ensure human rights and improve the law and order situation.

The AL government has to face criticism, as they failed to run the country properly, Moudud said at a roundtable on 'One year of grand alliance government: Expectations and outcome' organised by the National Youth Forum at the National Press Club in the city.

In a written speech, Dr Md Golam Rahman Bhuiyan, chairman of Bangladesh Manabadhikar and Samaj Unnayan Sangstha, said the AL government has totally failed to fulfil its election pledges.

### 95pc youths with disabilities unemployed

Speakers tell discussion

Speakers at a discussion yesterday said almost 95 percent of the youths with disabilities are sitting idle without any employment opportunities.

The country's overall national development would not be possible without mainstreaming this huge segment of population, saidthespeakers.

They were speaking at a discussion on 'Development of the disabled population - what the Youth Development Directorate should do', organised by the National Grassroots Disabled Organisation (NGDO) in association with Action on Disability Development (ADD) in the city yesterday.

Presenting the keynote paper, NGDO Training Officer Saifur Rahman said the women with disability are the worst sufferers adding that they are not only suffering from disability, but they are also being discriminated against their male counterparts.

"Therefore, everyday living is synonymous with struggle and hardship for more than 45 lakh women (with disability) in the country," he said.

The speakers pointed out that despite containing 10 percent of the total population of the country, only 0.10 percent of the national budget is allotted

for their development activities. Speaking as the chief guest, Director General of the Youth Development Directorate (YDD) Fakhrul Islam said a positive attitude should be developed towards the people with disability.

Many young people with disabilities throughout the country are taking part in the training programmes organised by the YDD, he added.

Fakhrul said he would take initiatives to help more young people with disabilities to effectively participate in the training programmes and become self-sufficient.

They also demanded a special quota system in the training programmes for youths with disabilities along with special loan facilities with easy terms and conditions.

YDD Director of Training Al Amin Chowdhury, City Welfare Project Welfare Officer Sitara Yasmin and ADD Finance Controller Golam Mostafa also spoke.
