NSU-in-Brief

North South University, the first private university in Bangladesh, was established more than a decade ago by a group of nthropists, industrialists, bureaucrats and academics. The government of Bangladesh approved the establishment of North South University in 1992 under Private University Act (PUA) 1992. The university was formally inaugurated on 10 February 1993 by the then Prime Minister of Bangladesh. The honorable President of the People's Republic of Bangladesh is the Chancellor of NSU. The Board of Governors, which provides the overall policy guidelines of the University, is headed by its Chairman. Mr. M.A. Kashem is the Current Chairman. Mr. Iftekharul Alam was the Founder Chairman. Mr. M. Immediate Past Chairman. Mr. Azim Uddin Ahmed, A.B.M Kamal Uddin Khan (deceased), Mr. Mohammed Shajahan, Mr. M. A. Hashem, Mr. Ragib Ali, Mr. Benajir Ahmed and Mrs. Rehana Rahman were the subseuent Chairmen. The other Members of the Board are Dr. Roushon Alam, Mr. Yussuf A. Harun, Mr. S. M. Kamaluddin, Mr. A. S. F. Rahman, Mr. M. A. Kalam, Mr. Abul Kashem, Mrs. Yasmin Kamal, Dr. Junaid Kamal Ahmad and Mr. Mahabubar Rahman. The Porichalona Porshod (Syndicate) is the second highest body. It runs the administration of the University within the policy guidelines provided by BOG. The Porichalona Porshod consists of BOG members, Vice Chancellor, Pro Vice Chancellor, Treasurer, and Chairman of Deans' committee.

Vision: The vision of North South University (NSU) is to become a leading university and a center of excellence in higher education in South Asia. It aims to attract brilliant students, scholars, researchers and scientists from all countries particularly from those in the South Asian region. Currently, NSU offers Bachelor's and Master's degrees in 26 subjects (14 Bachelor's degrees and 10 Master's degrees). Additional programs are under preparation in consultation with collaborating universities and NSU's International Advisory Board. The university follows the American system with all its distinctive features-semesters, credit hours, letter grades, one examiner system and so on. Its curricula, when first introduced, were reviewed by relevant departments of University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign, and University of California at Berkeley, USA, and duly approved by University Grants Commission. The academic programs are continually updated and adapted to meet the local needs Since joining NSU in 1993, Dr. Hafiz G A. Siddiqi, the current Vice Chancellor, provided leadership in improving,

expanding and diversifying various academic programs. NSU now has 207 core (fulltime) and 142 part-time faculty memsers. Core faculty members teach roughly 73% of the courses offered. All faculty members have higher degrees from reptable foreign universities, with over 90% holding degrees from British, American, Australian and Canadian Universities. Visiting faculty from foreign universities including US, Canadian and Australian universities also teach at NSU. It is very elective in recruiting teachers and admitting students. Its current student enrolment is about 10,000 NSU has three Institutes and one Center: (i) Institute of Development, Environment and Strategic Studies (IDESS) (ii) The Institute of Modern Languages (iii) Confucius Institute, and (iv) Center of Information & Communication Technolog

Library: NSU Library is consisted of six floors with 60,000 sq. ft. floor areas. This is the first fully automated library in Sangladesh, using customized software. Its on-line database provides full access to all users, releases auto email information and facilitates navigation and reservation of books from distant NSU work stations through LAN and Internet. The number of books is over 37,000 and is continuously increasing. It subscribes to over 10 thousand online research journals and 46 print versions and 61 magazines and numerous dailies from home and abroad. The library has a good number of CD-ROM databases, CD books and audio-video cassettes. Facilities include online and reports journal browsing, internet browsing, down loading/copying and CD Rom database browsing, etc. There is an active cyber corner for students with

Electronics, Digital Electronics, Telecommunications, Microprocessor and VLSI Laboratory: North South University ha a good number of Laboratories with most modern equipment such as Analog and Digital Trainers, Signal Generators and Function Generators, Oscilloscopes, multi-meters and Electronics components, Single-board Microcomputers, VLSI Laboratory with CPLD, FPGA and ASIC systems, Wireless Transmitters and Receivers, Fiber-Optics Communications. Analog and Digital Modulation Equipment, Advance Digital Communication Systems, I & II and Digital Signal Processor. Computer Laboratories: The Computer Laboratories of North South University provide the best possible services to the university community through general purpose laboratory and other specialized laboratories (such as Network Laboratory,

Database Laboratory and General Purpose Laboratory) consisting of around 350 Pentium 4 (Dell & HP) 50 Thin Clients (Sunray 100) and 10 high computational Sun workstations (Sunbalde 150) and all are connected though Local Area Network (LAN) with Fiber-Optic & UTP cables. NSU Campus at a Glance: Founded on 5.5 acres of beautifully landscaped area, this impressive state-of-the art campus with all modern amenities and facilities of an urban university is likely to stand out as an extraordinary architectural landmark of Dhaka. The campus is designed to serve at least 10,000 students. Built according to a master plan carefully designed by a panel of internationally renowned architects, the complex is divided into three major units: the seven-storied administrative building with the offices of the Board of Governors, the Vice-Chancellor, the Pro VC, the Registrar and the Deans is at the centre; it is flanked by two ten-storied structures- the North Academic Building (NAC) housing the Schools of Business, Arts & Social Sciences and the Confucius Institute and the South Academic Building (SAC) where the Schools of Engineering & Applied Sciences as well as the School of Life Sciences are located.

The total available floor space is 1.2 million sq. ft. divided into 99 class-rooms, lecture theatres, exam halls and 35 departmental and faculty offices of various sizes. Generous portions of space have been allotted to the library, labs, auditorium, cafeterias and other facilities for the students and the academic and non-academic staff. Brand new office and classroom furniture of the finest designs will equip the campus. There are three basement levels providing an ample parking space for 650 vehicles. There are 2050 computers in 17 computer labs for the use of the students, the faculty members and the office staff most of which are provided with Internet facilities. Wireless connectivity ensures fast and hassle-free excur-




