


The 11th Dhaka International Film Festival was inaugurated on January 14 at the Main Auditorium of National Museum. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated the festival. Seventeen films including two Bangladeshi films, from Asia and Australia, are competing for the top prize at the ongoing festival. Organised by Rainbow Film Society, the festival is being held at the National Museum and Central Public Library premises.

In her speech, Prime Minister announced that the government would set up a modern film institute and formulate a National Film Policy for development of the country's film arena, according to the government news agency UNB.

"Appropriate steps will be taken for repealing the existing Film Society Control Act, if necessary," Hasina said at the inaugural.

The Prime Minister requested filmmakers, cultural activists and people from all walks of life to remain alert so that ill elements could not intrude into the Bangalee culture in any way. Information Minister
