Nadal, Henin on course

Defending cham-

pion Rafael Nadal has won his thirdround match at the Australian Open, beating Philipp Kohlschreiber of Germany 6-4, 6-2, 2-6, 7-5.

Second-seeded Nadal, who beat Roger Federer in last year's final at Melbourne Park, broke Kohlschreiber's serve in the 11th game of the fourth set Friday. He held serve to take the match, closing with a forehand winner at Rod Laver Arena.

Kim Clijsters of Belgium suffered a humbling third round defeat.

Clijsters, one of the favourites to win the title, was blasted off court by 19th seeded Russian Nadia Petrova 6-0, 6-1 in only 52 minutes, shocking the large crowd who had come to cheer her on.

Earlier Friday, Justine Henin staged another memorable comeback to advance in her first Grand Slam out of retirement, beating No. 27 Alisa Kleybanova 3-6, 6-4, 6-2 in the third round.

Facing two break points at 1-3 in the second set, it seemed as if Henin's dramatic win over Olympic gold medalist and fifth-ranked Elena Dementieva on Wednesday had sapped too much energy. After all, it was only the seventh match for the seven-time Grand Slam winner since she returned from 20 months off the tour.

But Henin managed to hold that game, hitting the lines with her groundstrokes instead of just missing them, and in the next game converted her first break-point chance against Kleybanova. As soon Henin found her range, the match was as good as over.

Former No. 1-ranked Andy Roddick was challenged all the way in a 6-7 (4-7), 6-4, 6-4, 7-6 (7-3) win over Feliciano Lopez. He next will play 2007 runner-up Fernando Gonzalez of Chile, who was backed by a noisy Chilean contingent in stifling conditions on Showcourt 2 as he beat Kazakhstan's Evgeny Korolev 6-7 (5-7), 6-3, 1-6, 6-3, 6-4.

Britain's Andy Murray had a 7-5, 6-1, 6-4 win over Florent Serra of France and will next face American John Isner, who fired 26 aces and hit 73 winners in a 6-1, 4-6, 7-6 (7-4), 7-6 (7-5) victory over No. 12 Gael Monfils of France.

On paper, it was an upset, although 24year-old Isner who was given the last seeding for the tournament after Frenchman Gilles Simon withdrew went into the match with a two wins and only one loss against Monfils.

The winner of the Murray-Isner match is likely to face defending champion Rafael Nadal in the quarterfinals. Nadal had a night match Friday against Philipp Kohlschreiber of Germany.

Roddick broke Lopez in the third game of the second set and the ninth of the third set, serving out at love both times.

Henin, unranked and playing on a wild-card entry, had a momentary lapse in the deciding set when Kleybanova broke her serve, but otherwise dominated the last 10 games.

Only two nights earlier, Henin had to save set points to finish off Dementieva in a tiebreaker, drawing on the experience of losing in similar circumstances to Kim Clijsters after holding match points in the Brisbane International final on Jan. 9.

That was Henin's first tournament since she quit while holding the No. 1 ranking in May 2008. In what is shaping as the Belgian quarter, Henin now must beat Yanina Wickmayer to have a chance at a quarterfinal against Kim Clijsters.

Wickmayer, who is ranked No. 16 but unseeded because she was under a suspension since overturned for breaching the World Anti-Doping Agency's "whereabouts rule" when direct entries closed for the Australian Open advanced 6-1, 6-7 (4-7), 6-3 over Sara Errani. She needed painkillers for back pain against Errani and said she'd need treatment before facing Henin.

Second-seeded Dinara Safina had an easier third-round match, advancing with a 6-1, 6-2 victory over Britain's Elena Baltacha in her first match on Rod Laver Arena since her lopsided loss to Serena Williams in last year's final.

Safina, a three-time Grand Slam finalist, will have a more difficult assignment next round against fellow Russian Maria Kirilenko, who beat Italian Roberta Vinci 7-5, 7-6 (7-4). Kirilenko had an upset win over 2008 champion Maria Sharapova in the opening round.

Former No. 1-ranked Jelena Jankovic was upset 6-2, 6-3 by No. 31 Alona Bondarenko.

IPL opener shifted to Mumbai

The opening match of the Indian Premier League in March has been shifted out of Hyderabad due to ongoing protests over the proposed creation of a new state, a top official said on Friday.

The match between defending champions the Deccan Chargers and the Kolkata Knight Riders, which was due to be held in Hyderabad on March 12, will now be played in Mumbai, IPL commissioner Lalit Modi told reporters.

Hyderabad, the capital of Andhra Pradesh state, has seen unrest over the past few weeks after the federal government announced in December that the region would be carved in two to create a separate state of Telangana.

Protesters on Thursday disrupted a Twenty20 cricket match organised by the Deccan Chargers franchise in Hyderabad.

"The first match of the IPL's new season will now be held in Mumbai on March 12," said Modi. "The opening match and the gala dinner the previous evening are very important for us.

"People from all over the world are coming and we are going to make sure that everything is in order. We don't want to take any chances.

"There are no changes to other matches, everything looks fine."

Hyderabad were due to host the seven home matches of the Chargers.

Two weeks ago, an influential right-wing Hindu party in Mumbai warned that it would try to stop Australian cricketers playing in parts of India because of attacks on Indians living Down Under.

The International Cricket Council on Thursday ruled that New Delhi will remain a venue for the 2011 World Cup despite a pitch fiasco late last year. An one-day international between India

and Sri Lanka was abandoned after 23.3 overs on December 27 due to what match referee Alan Hurst said was an "unfit" wicket at the Ferozeshah Kotla Stadium. An ICC investigation, the findings of which were released on Thursday, ruled that the

"pitch prepared for the above match was dangerous and should therefore be classified as 'unfit". But the governing body accepted a plea from the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI)

The pitch consultant will oversee the remedial work needed to make the Kotla wicket fit to holdWorldCup matches, an ICC release said.

The ICC's general manager David Richardson and chief match referee Ranjan Madugalle studied video footage of the match, and examined the reports of the match referee and the BCCI before reaching a decision.

"We understand that turf pitches, by their very nature, are not and cannot be expected to always behave predictably and that an occasional delivery of unexpected steep bounce, while not ideal especially for limited-overs

cricket, is part of the game," Richardson said in a statement.

"In this instance, however, we are of the view that the frequency of the misbehaving deliveries (on average just more than one every three overs) and the excessive degree of variation had the potential to inflict serious injury to the batsmen.

"Therefore the pitch that was prepared for the above match was 'dangerous' and should therefore be classified as 'unfit'.

"We acknowledge and endorse the decision by the BCCI not to schedule any international cricket at the ground prior to the end of 2010, which is consistent with our own finding. "While the pitch was unfit for international

cricket, it is also worth bearing in mind that it is the first time the Feroz Shah Kotla pitch has been rated as unfit." ICC chief executive Haroon Lorgat said he

was confident the Kotla pitch will return to international standards by the time the World Cup came. "We are confident that there is ample time

for the necessary remedial work to be carried out ahead of next year's ICC Cricket World Cup," said Lorgat. "It is important now that the work should be

carried out and domestic cricket played on the pitch to make sure it returns to the standards required for high-level international cricket. "Let's not forget, this ground is one of the world's iconic venues and it's imperative it

IPL snub ignites Indo-Pak row

A perceived snub to Pakistani players by the glitzy Indian Premier League has sparked a diplomatic spat between the great rivals, for whom cricket is No Pakistani player was bought by the eight

Indian clubs during an auction on Tuesday for the third edition of the league despite the Pakistan team being the reigning world champions in the Twenty20 format of the tournament. The omission has triggered widespread protests in Pakistan with effigies of IPL chief Lalit

Modi being burnt on the streets of Lahore amid condemnation from politicians and threats of boycotts from other Pakistani sports teams. Indian Foreign Minister SM Krishna was drawn into the maelstrom Thursday, denying that

suggestions from IPL franchises that Pakistani players may have been refused Indian visas. "The government has nothing to do with IPL, on selection of players and various exercises that are connected with it," he said.

In Pakistan, retaliatory steps saw a parliamentary delegation cancel their trip to India and a scheduled visit by the Pakistani kabaddi (traditional tag wrestling) team was called off.

"I agree this is a private event, but Pakistani players being excluded without any reason and without looking at the background is unfair," the chairman of the Pakistan Cricket Board, Ijaz Butt, toldAFP.

Foreign office spokesman Abdul Basit told the pick the players they want. After all, it is their newspaper Dawn "it is clear from what we heard money," Srinivasan told the Hindu newspaper from the Indian High Commission that the deci-

sion to not include Pakistani players was influenced by variables extraneous to sports."

India and Pakistan have fought three wars since their independence in 1947 and tension spiked in 2008 when militants killed 166 people in an attack on Mumbai. New Delhi pointed the finger at a Pakistan-based Islamist group.

India cancelled a scheduled cricket tour of Pakistan after the Mumbai attacks, breaking a sequence of bilateral Test series held on each other's soil every year from 2004 to 2007.

In a further setback, the International Cricket Council withdrew Pakistan's right to host matches in next year's Cricket World Cup, following the Lahore terrorist attack in March on the visiting Sri Lankan cricket team.

Pakistan's matches were instead shared among co-hosts India, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh. The third season of the lucrative IPL, which features the world's top players in eight teams

owned by rich businessmen and Bollywood stars, will be held in March and April this year. One franchise official, who preferred to remain unnamed, told AFP that he was not surprised that

"We were not sure if they would get visas and we did not want players who won't be available," he said. "Besides, there is also the security issue. No one was willing to take a chance."
