

5 Bangabandhu killers hanged

Govt goes for execution 14 hours after review petition rejected; bodies sent to their village homes with police escort

Five condemned killers of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman were hanged early today at Dhaka Central Jail amid

The death sentences of the five were executed around 14 and a half hours after the Appellate Division dismissed their pleas to review the Supreme Court verdict that confirmed capital punishment to 12 former army officers including the five petitioners on November 19 last year.

> January 31. "Sultan Shahriar Rashid and Syed Farooq Rahman were the first to walk the gallows at 12:05am. They were handcuffed and their heads were covered in black hoods in the final minutes to midnight," Dhaka Deputy Commissioner Zillar Rahman told The Daily Star soon after he walked out of the jail premises around

It's quiet execution

The dark alleys to the Dhaka Central Jail looked empty with a few policemen standing at regular gaps. At the jail gate, media men had just started crowding. A little later, security men

started pouring in. By now, the road to the jail was made offlimits to most people. As the clock neared mid-

night, five ambulances pulled in to carry the bodies of the five Bangabandhu killers.

The whole place was now teeming with Rapid Action Battalion and police personnel.

34 yrs for justice Bloodbath

It has taken over 34 years to ensure justice since August 15, 1975 heinous killing of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.

A dark cloud that has been looming over the nation since that day was partially removed early this morning with the executions of five of the 12 condemned killers.

The incidents of August 15, 1975 constitute the darkest part in the history of Bangladesh's politics, as the episode introduced bloodbath as a means of regime change in the country. Completion of the trial of Bangbandhu killing case and

implementation of the verdict will remain in the history of the judiciary as an example of how many hurdles justice might have to cross before being served. The looming darkness deepened further in the form of the

Indemnity Ordinance, which was introduced by Khandaker Moshtaque Ahmed and then given constitutional legitimacy by Lt Gen Ziaur Rahman, to protect the killers of Bangabandhu and obstruct justice. No government took initiatives to ensure justice for the kill-

ing of the country's first president until Sheikh Mujib's own party Awami League came to power in 1996 under the leadership
