

At least 35 people have been injured in clashes over disputed land in Manikganj and Thakurgaon.

Officer-in-Charge of Shibalaya police station Moniruzzaman told UNB that there was a longstanding conflict between two groups - one led by Rashid and another by former UP member Moti-over ownership of land in the char.


