

Timeless Baul songs in an urban avatar

Soulful renditions by Bangla and Jazmin

Featuring moving renditions of Baul songs along with a blend of Jazz and Blues, the concert at Amazon Club (Gulshan) on February 19 evening was a treat for contemporary music lovers.

Popular band Bangla, along with the American group Jazmin, performed at the event.

Bangla took the stage first. The band started with "Allah Bolo Monrey Pakhi, Mawla Bolo" -- a devotional Lalon song. "Nodi Jaye Sagorer Kho(n)jey", a Bangla original, was next. The song

highlighted the band's forte and devo- Marley's "Stir It Up". tion towards folk music.

Bangla is one of the pioneering contemporary bands that have generated a mass interest in Lalon's songs among the young music enthusiasts. So far the band has released two albums featuring several Lalon numbers.

At Amazon Club, Bangla's performance was predictably dominated by Lalon songs. Songs like "Guru Prem Korbi Jodi" and "Torey Na Dekhiley Mori" that the group performed at the concert are little known to young music fans. Bangla's effort to introduce a wide range of Lalon songs to youngsters should be appreciated, expressed some in the audience.

Another noticeable aspect was that the members of the band frequently changed their instruments. During Anusheh's rendition of "Nodir Kul-er Lagi Ami Kandi", Kartik, who was playing lead guitar so far, took a break. Buno, who mainly plays bass, took the lead guitar, while Arnob (usually on acoustic guitar) played bass. Anusheh was on mandira.

Bodhi and Ratul -- both members of the Indian band Taaltantra -- joined Bangla during their performance. Kangalini Sufia also took the stage and sang a couple of songs, including her ≤ classic, "Buri Hoilam Tor Karoney".

Seth Blumberg, lead guitarist and vocalist of Jazmin, joined Bangla towards the end of their performance. After Bangla's performance, other three members of the American band -- Armando Cepeda (bass guitar and vocals), Jesse Charnow (drums) and Leo Dombecki (keyboard and saxophone) -- jointed Seth. Their first performance was an instrumental that was dominated by Leo's saxophone.

The troupe rendered some of their original numbers and also covered popular songs like Bob

Using their roots and training, Jazmin fuses Blues, Soul, Jazz, and Indian Classical elements to craft their sound. The troupe of multi-talented musicians has performed at some major festivals such as Montreux Jazz Festival, New Orleans Jazz and Heritage Festival and Chicago Blues Festival.

Shadhona -- a centre for advancement of South Asian music and dance-- along with the event management group Carnival arranged the programme.

"Baul n' Beyond" today

Today, an international event titled "Baul n' Beyond" will be held at the Hall of Fame, Bangabandhu International Conference Centre. Shadhona and Carnival has arranged the event. Bauls from Kushtia, including Rob Fakir, Alauddin Biswas and Baul Shafi Mandal, along with Kangalini Sufia and bands Bangla (Bangladesh), Taaltantra (India) and Jazmin (USA) will perform at the concert.

The goal of the event is to understand the Baul philosophies through a musical journey.

The two-hour-long concert will start at 7pm. Tanmoy Bose, eminent Indian tabla player and leader of the band Taaltantra, is conducting the musical. The event will feature folk, classi-

cal, jazz and contemporary music. The event is supported by JAAGO Foundation. Lubna Mariam of Shadhona informed that though the organisation has been so far promoting classical music, from now on it would work to revive Baul songs.

After discussion, Panchagarh Kabita Parishad held a programme titled "Bojrakanthey Uccharon", featuring solo and group recitations.

Artistes of District Shilpakala Academy staged a cultural show titled "Ekush Amar Ahankar". Highlight of the event were patriotic songs.

On the first day, a good number of enthusiastic people thronged the fair premises. Two new books -- a novel "Bhalobashar

Onek Rong" and poetry "Birangana" -- were launched at the fair. Around 35 stalls have been set up at the fair, which will continue till February 25.

Discussions, cultural programmes, competitions and plays would be held every evening at the fair premises, according to organisers.


Musical programme "Bhashar Gaan" on Banglavision


