

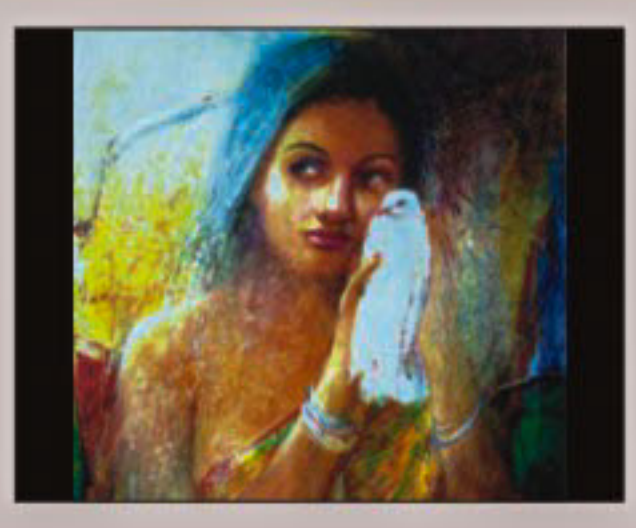

Rokeya Sultana is a painter and printmaker. She studied printmaking at Shanti Niketan. Sultana holds exhibitions of her works regularly. Sultana's latest solo exhibition, titled "The Mystique Empire", is now on at Bengal Gallery of Fine Arts, Dhanmondi. Works at the exhibition traces her creative exploration. In her student days, Sultana had done some noteworthy watercolours. Her themes are quite simple. She tries to highlight the liaison between humans and nature. Nude, semi nude figures and elements of

nature are common features in most of her works. Vivid colours are a dominant aspect in her works. Some of her works also involve unfamiliar forms and shapes. Her images intensely capture the earthly essences. At one point of her career, Sultana concentrated on figures and delineated the complexities of human lives. Sensual lines and expressive colours are prime characteristics of her creations. Her fascination with various forms gradually created a crammed atmosphere on her canvas. At the exhibition, Sultana has worked in mixed media, gouache and

tempera. Her emphasis is on lines, figures and colours. Some of the lines, crisscrossed over forms and shapes, are difficult to comprehend. A number of her works beautifully articulate marine life, stars and more with a matured use of tone. The minimal use of curves and lines draw attention to her progressive vision. Her works convey a poetic essence of life in blue, yellow and crimson. Some of her images -- showing women with turtles, snakes, starfish and snails -- allude to the fact that women are a part of nature. The exhibition at Bengal Gallery will continue till March 2.

"The Threaded Resort": Eye on garment workers

Exhibition jointly organised by Spanish Embassy and ULAB

The Embassy of Spain and the University of Liberal Arts Bangladesh (ULAB) hosted a student-produced multimedia exhibition on the empowerment of women in the Bangladeshi readymade garment industry on February 18, 2010 at the Radius Centre, Bay's Galleria, Gulshan, says a press release. Entitled "The Threaded Resort," the exhibition was inaugurated by Dr. Shirin

Sharmin Chaudhury, state minister for Women and Children's Affairs, and the Spanish Ambassador Arturo Pérez Martínez.

The exhibition -- continuing at the ULAB lobby from February 22 to 25 -- is segmented into three parts: documentary screening, photo exhibition and case study display.

Fourteen students from the ULAB course "Introduc-

tion to Political Thought", conducted the research under the direction of their instructor, Dr. Rathana peou van den Heuvel. Around 150 women were interviewed during the three months of active research. As the students encountered the women, they were faced with a different reality, new for a Bangladeshi undergrad. This exhibition reflects the struggles, or rather journeys,

of these spirited women. The Embassy of Spain sponsored the study and exhibition, as the bulk of the Spanish Development Cooperation in Bangladesh relates to gender equality. Spain is one of the leading countries in the garments industry. It is the Spanish Embassy's view that such industrialisation needs to include a social, ethical and human component.
