

Khaleda writes to ACC for graft charge details

BNP Chairperson and Opposition Leader Khaleda Zia yesterday requested the Anti-Corruption Commission to inform her of the details on the allegations regarding Zia Charitable Trust and construction of Bhairab Bridge.

Khaleda made the request through two separate letters to the ACC issued by her lawyer barrister AM Mahbub Uddin Khokon.

The ACC had issued a notice upon Khaleda on February 15, requesting her to reply by February 24-25 where and when it should question her regarding the allegations.

In a letter yesterday, Mahbub Uddin Khokon said the ACC has no jurisdiction to

ADP slashed by 6.6pc

Power sector gets cut for poor implementation

The revised Annual Development Programme (ADP) has been reduced by 6.6 percent from the original ADP bringing its size down to Tk 28,500 crore due to failure in implementation.

The Awami League-led government increased the original ADP by 33 pc from the last one and set its size at Tk 30,500 crore to meet the huge demand for public investment.

The revised ADP was approved yesterday in a National Economic Council (NEC) meeting at its auditorium with Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in the chair.

As the cash budget support increased in the revised ADP, the share of foreign resources has been made 58 percent (Tk 16,500 cr), which was

51 percent in the original ADP.

The cash budget support increased by 48 percent and stood at Tk 5,180 crore which is mostly provided by the Asian Development Bank and the World Bank.

In the revised ADP, fund of the foreign-aided projects has been slashed by 12 percent (Tk 11,300 crore) due to their failure in implementation.

The government's policy is to reduce the number of projects and lay more emphasis on implementation. But in the revised ADP, the number of projects is 1,058, which was 886 in the original one.

Meanwhile, 464 projects have been kept without allocation in view of allocating fund to SEE PAGE 15 COL 4

EC talks quick redemarcation

The Election Commission and LGRD ministry, at a meeting yesterday, discussed redemarcation of Dhaka City Corporation wards in the shortest possible time before the next DCC election, to reduce the huge population disparity among them.

The current voter list with photographs shows DCC ward no 6 has as many as 1.5 lakh voters while ward 73 has only 11,213.

Ward 14 has 1.1 lakh voters, ward 2 has 96,883, and ward 22 has 92,620, while ward 71 has 14,312, ward 78 has 15,644, and 80 has 17,618, exhibiting similar disparities.

DCC currently has 90 wards, and on average more than half of the population of each ward are registered voters, according to EC officials.

The population disparity among the wards increased enormously due to their boundaries not being redemarcated for a SEE PAGE 15 COL 4
