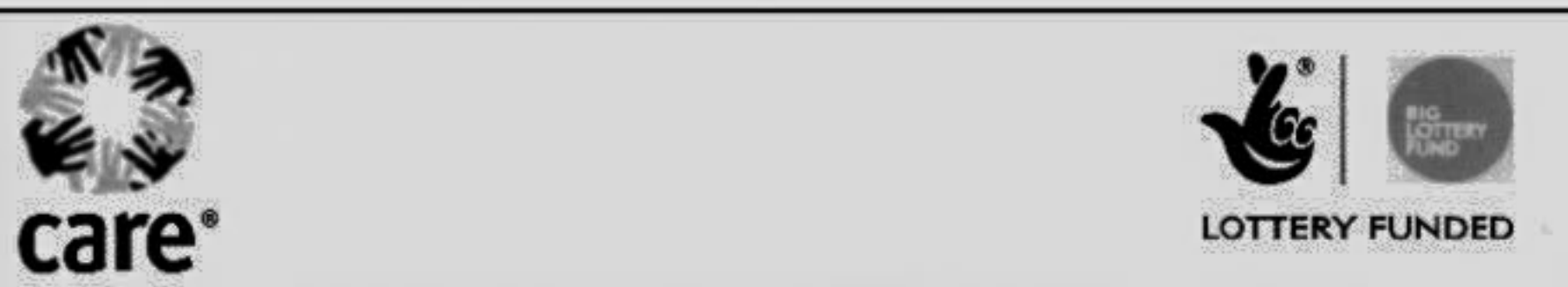
## CAREER OPPORTUNITY AS DIRECTOR

Enhancing Mobile Populations' Access to HIV & AIDS Services Information and Support (EMPHASIS)

CARE International UK (CIUK) is implementing a multi-country programme to reduce the vulnerabilities to HIV & AIDS of mobile populations crossing borders of Bangladesh and Nepal to and from India. EMPHASIS is a 5-year (August 2009 – July 2014) programme funded by the Big Lottery Fund UK (BIG), the largest distributor of the United Kingdom National Lottery funding. BIG is responsible for giving out half the money raised for good causes by the National Lottery. To implement the project, CIUK works in partnership with CARE Country Offices in Bangladesh, India and Nepal. A Regional Secretariat to oversee the project has been established in Nepal. A central feature of the programme is research to inform project design as well as evidence-based advocacy on reducing vulnerability to HIV & AIDS among mobile populations.

The implementation of the research will be carried out by national research institutes in India, Nepal and Bangladesh. Although for logistical reasons, separate research institutes in each of the three countries will be hired, the methodology used in the three countries will be as similar as possible in order to ensure comparability and to assist joint analysis. Various mechanisms will be put in place to facilitate this comparability, including a joint start-up workshop and joint analyses and dissemination workshops.

This call for EOIs is for research institutes in India, Nepal and Bangladesh interested in carrying out the baseline research.

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## The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Bangladesh

The Institute of Chartered Accountants of Bangladesh (ICAB) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the World Class Institute of the Accountancy profession- the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales (ICAEW) under the Twinning Project financed by the World Bank and implemented through the Ministry of Commerce GOB. The Twinning Project resulted in the adoption and introduction of a new curriculum for ICAB in line with the ICAEW curriculum. It also suggested certain reforms in the governance and operations of ICAB. As part of implementation of the reform proposals ICAB is looking to recruit and fill up the posts of Director - Learning & Professional Development and Director -Technical. The ICAB is in the process of implementing the new curriculum and training of teachers engaged in coaching the Chartered Accountancy students are in progress on the new ICAB Curriculum under the Twinning Arrangement between ICAB and ICAEW. Subsequent upon execution of the MoU, the ICAB members will be eligible to become members of the ICAEW subject to fulfillment of certain conditions.

ICAB is a member of International Federation of Accountants (IFAC), International Accounting Standards Board (IASB) International Accounting Standards Committee (IASC), Confederation of Asian and Pacific Accountants (CAPA) and South Asian Federation of Accountants (SAFA).

The ICAB was established under the Bangladesh Chartered Accountants Order 1973 (President's Order No.2 of 1973) as an autonomous body under the Ministry of Commerce GOB to regulate and guide the profession of the accountants and matters connected therewith in Bangladesh. The ICAB is looking for self-motivated, proactive and experienced candidates for the positions of Director - Learning & Professional Development and the Director -Technical having requisite qualifications in the respective fields. ### We are Looking for ...

**Director - Learning & Professional Development**  
The candidate to be eligible should either have a PhD specialized in Accounting and Financial Reporting with teaching experience in foreign/local reputed universities along with specific experience in Accounting education OR be a Chartered Accountant OR have an MBA/Masters Degree from a reputed foreign/local University with major in Accounting with substantial exposure in Accounting Education and Research.

**Major Responsibilities:** The candidate shall be responsible to implement the new curriculum of the ICAB designed as a part of the Twinning Arrangement between ICAEW & ICAB. S/he must also work to assist the Board of Studies of the Council ICAB for developing methodologies of imparting education and training to the students under the new curriculum and recommend to the Executive Director, Council -ICAB, regarding the overall development strategy and policies of ICAB on learning and professional development. The applicant will modify the existing study manuals and model answers for each level of the Professional Examination and will organize seminars and workshops for the ICAB members and panel teachers on the new developments in education and training. The applicant will assist ICAB in procuring professional books and study materials and is also expected to maintain liaison with Colleges & Universities in Bangladesh for improving the qualification and education on the accountancy profession. The applicant must maintain a close liaison with the Central Bank, Securities and Exchange Commission, Dhaka and Chittagong Stock Exchanges, Registrar of Joint Stock Companies and Firms, National Board of Revenue, Banks and Financial Institutions, Industrial and Commercial Houses, International Federation of Accountants (IFAC), International Accounting Standards Board (IASB), Confederation of Asia Pacific Accountants (CAPA) and South Asian Federation of Accountants (SAFA) and other organizations and sensitize the ICAB members of changes in International Financial Reporting Standards and International Standards on Auditing, and the Statement of Membership Obligations (SMO) prescribed by the IFAC.
