**Request of Expressions of Interest**

For: Management Support Consulting (MSC) Services

The People's Republic of Bangladesh intends to apply for financing from the World Bank (WB), Asian Development Bank (ADB), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA), and Islamic Development Bank (IDB) towards the cost of the Construction of Padma Multipurpose Bridge Project, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for various consultant services. BBA is already in the process of selecting the Construction Supervision Consultant (CSC) who will be responsible for overall project management and on site supervision (Engineer's role under the FIDIC Agreement). BBA intends to engage another consulting firm as Management Support Consultant (MSC), essentially in an advisory role, to help BBA effectively perform its role as the "OWNER/EMPLOYER". In this capacity the MSC are expected to assist BBA, inter alia, in the following management functions: i) Project management including coordination, reporting, monitoring of progress and plans etc, ii) Budgetary and financial management, iii) Review of quality control and quality assurance plan, iv) Reviewing payment certificates if required, v) Contractual advice and settlement of disputes, claims, vi) Implementation of the social safeguard plans (environment, resettlement etc), vii) Training of BBA staff and viii) Design and management of a Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Program for socio-economic aspects of PMBP. The consultancy assignment would be about for five years starting early 2011.

PMBP is a large complex project. The main components of the project are: (i) a two level bridge of steel truss with composite concrete upper deck of around 6.15 km long with a 4-lane divided highway on the upper level and a single track railway line at the lower level including transition structures mainly viaducts; (ii) 2 toll plazas and service areas; (iii) about 12 km of 4-lane approach road, 2.00 km viaducts, culverts, small bridges, underpasses, service roads, service areas for construction management and tourism in post-construction phase; (iv) about 16 km of major river bank protection/training work in the form of Guide Bunds and falling aprons; and (v) about 5 resettlement (RS) sites. This is a multipurpose project and the bridge is to carry a high pressure gas mains, high voltage electric power lines and telecommunication line in addition to the road and railway. The estimated cost of the project is around US\$ 2400 million. The engineering design and procurement of contractors for PMBP is currently being carried out by an international consulting firm engaged by the Bangladesh Bridge Authority. The award of contracts for construction is expected to start towards the end of 2010. The works may be procured in more than 3 packages, which are still indicative and are to be finalized in consultation with potential financiers.

Bangladesh Bridge Authority of the Ministry of Communications now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the Management Support Services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (e.g. brochures, descriptions of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc). Consultants may associate with other firms to enhance their qualifications, and, if association, should mention whether the association is in the form of "joint venture" or "sub-consultancy". It is preferable to limit the total number of firms in an association including the Lead Firm to 4 (four).

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers* May 2004 (Revised October-2006).

Interested consultants are requested to submit 1 (one) original and 3 (three) copies of EoI to the address of the Project Director, PMBP given below.  (iii) Availability of appropriate skills among staff. (List of relevant professional staff and their qualifications and relevant experiences);
