Repression on Dalits or lower caste people has increased in Jessore and Jhenidah recently, creating panic among the Dalit community living in the two districts.

Members of the Dalit community are being tortured and killed regularly, but the law enforcement agencies are not paying heed to their pleas for protection, community members said at a press conference at Dhaka Reporters Unity auditorium.

In the last two months, two Dalits were killed and attacks were also made on Dalit colonies in Jessore and Jhenidah, they said.
