# India, KSA seal ties with Riyadh Declaration

Five agreements also signed

In what is a clear reflection of an emerging strategic partnership, visiting Indian Prime Minister, Dr Manmohan Singh, and Saudi Arabian monarch King Abdullah Bin Abdul Aziz signed the historic Riyadh Declaration at Grandoise Al Rawdah Palace on Sunday.

Before the event, the Indian Prime Minister was formally received by King Abdullah and was also bestowed with a special honour called Shaish. The Crown Prince, Sultan bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud, had received this rare honour before Dr Singh.

Earlier India and Saudi Arabia signed five agreements on Sunday after extensive delegation-level talks between the two countries.

#### Palestinian state crucial for ME stability: Manmohan

India's Prime Minister Manmohan Singh said yesterday that an independent Palestinian state was key to Middle East stability and called on arch-foe Pakistan to "act decisively" against terror-

"There is no issue more important for peace and stability in the region than the question of Palestine," Singh told members of the Saudi Shura Council, the kingdom's appointed consultative body, in Riyadh.

"For far too long the brave people of Palestine have been denied their just, legitimate and inalienable rights, including most of all the establishment of a sovereign, independent and viable Palestinian state," he said.

Singh, on the third and final day of a state visit to Saudi Arabia, also said that good relations with India's neighbour Pakistan hinged on its actions against terrorism.

# Attacks kill 4 Nato soldiers,5 Afghan civilians

Four Nato soldiers were killed in Afghanistan yesterday, the military said, taking the number of foreign troops killed this year to 105 and more than double those killed in the first two months of 2009.

A suicide car bomber attacked a Nato convoy yesterday outside the major southern Afghan city of Kandahar, killing one Nato service member and five Afghan civilians, officials said.

The attacker waited in a station-wagon taxi near a bridge between the airport and city that Nato troops regularly check for explosives, said Inhamullah Khan, an Afghan army official at the bombing site. The assailant then detonated the bomb as the convoy crossed the bridge in the morning, tossing a military vehicle into the ravine below, Khan said.

The attack killed one Nato service member, said Maj Marcin Walczak of the Polish Army, a spokesman for the international military coalition. He did not provide the nationality or any other details.

Two soldiers died "in an indirect fire attack" in western Afghanistan and a third in "a small arms attack" in the south, the Nato-run International Security Assistance Force (Isaf) said in a

The Interior Ministry confirmed five civilian deaths in a statement. Three of the civilians who died were in a car that had pulled over nearby to wait for the convoy to pass, Khan said.

Speaking to AFP by telephone from an undisclosed location, Taliban spokesman Yousuf Ahmadi claimed responsibility for the attack and alleged that militants had killed 11 foreign soldiers.

### Key leaders of Pak Taliban killed or captured: Army

Omar's spokesman, top operative arrested

ANI, Peshawar/ Karachi

A Pakistani general has claimed that key leaders of the Pakistani Taliban have been killed or captured in an onslaught of frontier ground and air attacks.

"The militant command and control centres and their caches have been dismantled or captured," Major General Tariq Khan, one of the coun-

try's most experienced commanders in the frontier war with the Taliban, told The Times.

"The kind of hits the leadership has taken, the casualties they have taken, the TTP (Pakistani Taliban) is no longer significant. It has ended as a cohesive force. It doesn't exist any more as an umbrella organisation that can influence militancy anywhere," he added.

# India concerned over 42 terror camps in Pakistan

Defence Minister AK Antony on Sunday said India is concerned about the 42 terror camps existing across the border even after Mumbai terror attacks and Pakistan's

Speaking during the Operation Vayu Shakti 2010 programme organised here, Antony said: "Our real concern is existence of terror camps intact across the border after 26/11 attack. There are 42 terror camps. And there has been no serious effort to

Commenting on the recent Foreign Secretary level talks between India and Pakistan, Antony said that India's decision to hold talks was a conscious decision and the country's concerns have been conveyed through it to Pakistan.
