Australian Development Scholarships (ADS)

The Australian Agency for International Development (AusAID) is pleased to announce that we are now receiving applications from qualified individuals for ADS places for Intake 2011.

The goal of the scholarship program is to help meet the human resource development needs of developing countries. Australia Awards also play an important role in fostering and sustaining Australia's relations in the Asia-Pacific region.

Be informed that for the 2011 intake, the ADS application process is open now. **The deadline for application submission is 16 May 2010.**

ADS places are targeted for the candidates from the following institutions only:

- Government of Bangladesh*
- ICDDR,B

*Candidates from all Government departments such as autonomous, public service commission, corporate and constitutional institutions are also eligible to apply for ADS. However, public university employees are not eligible to apply for ADS.

General Prerequisites for Scholarships

- You must be a Bangladeshi citizen who is less than **40 years old** at the time of application;
- Your university level qualification must be equivalent in standard to an Australian **Bachelor degree**;
- You must have at least **two** years of work experience relevant to your nominated field of study. Selected field of study cannot be changed later;
- Your overall IELTS score must be at least **6.5**, with no individual band less than 6. IELTS test date must not be earlier than 30 November 2008.

Announcement for the Australian Development Scholarships (ADS) 2011 Intake for Indigenous Candidates from the Chittagong Hill Tracts.

Chittagong Hill Tracts Development Facility, United Nations Development Programme (CHTDF, UNDP) in collaboration with Australian Government is pleased to invite applications for Australian Development Scholarships 2011 Intake from indigenous candidates of Chittagong Hill Tracts (CHT) who are committed to contribute to the development of CHT. The purpose of ADS-CHT program is intrinsically and overtly to enhance the human resource capacity of CHT and to create 'Young Leaders/Professionals' who will play important roles in planning, managing and implementing development and governance initiatives in CHT. This kind of special intervention is very essential to promote development & confidence in such a post-conflict area like CHT.

Scholarship Conditions:

- At least Fifty percent of the scholarships will be awarded to female candidates.
- Applications from physically challenged people will be considered favorably.
- Preference will be given to those who have not previously been awarded any scholarship abroad.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Age:**
 - Must be less than 40 years old at the time of application for the Masters degree courses.
 - Must be less than 30 years old at the time of application for the Bachelor degree courses.
- Academic:**
 - **For Bachelor Degree Courses:** Completion of a minimum Higher Secondary Certificate/ 'A' level. Preference will be given to the candidates who have minimum 60% marks/CGPA 2.5 in their 1st year exam of undergraduate studies in any university/institution.
 - **For Masters Degree Course:** Must have completed a University level qualification which is at least equivalent in standard to an Australian Bachelor degree. Must have at least two years of work experience relevant to the field of study applying for. Candidates with high level academic results in one or more university level degrees are encouraged to apply.
 - Must have minimum 2nd division/class and/or minimum GPA 3.0 (out of 5.0) in SSC & HSC level and/or GPA/CGPA 2.25 (Out of 4.0) in Bachelor/Honors/Masters level examinations.

Female candidates are especially encouraged to apply for the ADS-CHT scholarship. Candidates with no prior credentials/degrees from abroad will be considered favorably.

(c) **Field of Study:** An applicant can chose/select only one field of study from the list provided below and it cannot be changed once the applicant has been short-listed.

Study level	Field of Study
Bachelor	Agricultural Science (Horticulture, Fisheries, Veterinary etc.), Communication & Media Studies, Development Studies, Environmental Science/Natural Resource Management, Education (Early Childhood / Primary /Inclusive /TESOL/ESL etc), Forestry, Tourism & Hospitality Management, Petroleum & Mining Studies.
Masters	Agricultural Sciences (Horticulture, Veterinary etc.), Development Studies, Education (Leadership and Management /Inclusive /Special Education/ESOL/ESL etc.), Environmental Science & Management (Climate Change), Forestry, Gender Studies, Human Rights, Peace & Conflict Studies, Public Health (Tropical Medicine/Nutrition), Public Policy and Management.

(d) English Language Proficiency:

Candidates are expected to have strong English Language Skills. Candidates must note that IELTS (Academic module) score requirement by Australian Universities is:
- Overall 6.5 (at least 6.0 in all individual bands) for Masters level and
- Overall 6.0 (at least 6.0 in all individual bands) for Bachelors level.

All candidates are encouraged to apply with valid IELTS score. However, CHTDF, UNDP will arrange IELTS exam for **short-listed candidates only** (if necessary).

(e) All candidates must be citizens of Bangladesh and have valid passports.

(f) The Following candidates are not eligible:

- Applicants who are not indigenous persons of CHT origin.
- If an applicant is holding or has been nominated to receive another scholarship.
- If applied for permanent residency in Australia or is a permanent resident of Australia.
- Be married to/or a defector of, or engaged to be married to a person who holds or is eligible to hold an Australian or New Zealand citizenship or permanent resident status.
